LAST TIME OUT: Ryan did not factor into the decision in his last start, an 8-4 Twins win over Los Angeles AL on September 24 at Target Field...allowed three runs on four hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in just 4.0 innings of work, his shortest start since also going 4.0 in his start in the second game of the doubleheader on September 7 at New York-AL.

 Owns a .133 (10-for-75) opponent batting average in four September starts, tops in the majors (min. 75 AB).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his team-leading 12th win of the season on September 18 at Cleveland, a 3-0 Twins shutout victory – the only game Minnesota won in that series...tossed 7.2 shutout innings and allowed three hits and two walks, with five strikeouts...became the second Twins starting pitcher this season to work in the eighth inning, alongside Dylan Bundy on June 18 at Arizona (8.0 IP)...also became the first Twins starting pitcher with 7.0-or-more scoreless innings in consecutive starts since Martin Pérez from May 1-6, 2019 (8.0 IP vs. Houston and 7.0 IP at Toronto).

- K KING IN WAITING: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 143 strikeouts on the season. Lie is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015.
   Ryan currently has the fourth-most single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), trailing only lim Hughes (164 in 1914) Doc Avers (148 in 1914) and Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006)...he currently ranks second in Twins history (1961-present), behind only Liriano and is one strikeout away from tying him for the Twins single-season rookie record. æ
  - Ryan enters today first in the American League and third among major league rookies this season in strikeouts, behind Atlanta's Spencer Strider (202) and Cincinnati's Hunter Greene (156).

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE. Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26, becoming the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below)...he enters today leading all major league rookies in wins, with 12.
 Ryan's 12 wins this season are tied with Jesse Crain (2005), Scott Diamond (2012), Francisco Liriano (2006), Glen Perkins (2008), Mark Redman (2000) and Kevin Tapani (1990) for third most in a single season by a Twins rookie, behind only Jim Hughes (16 in 1975) and Roger Erickson (14 in 1978).

  In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
  In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
