THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four Postseason games, sweeping Toronto in two games at Target Field during the AL Wild Card Series last week, followed by a split of the first two games of the ALDS against Houston over the weekend...today, the Twins will host the Astros for Game 3 of the ALDS at Target Field...the series will continue tomorrow with Game 4 in Minneapolis.

♣ Twins are 18-19 all-time in Minnesota during the Postseason, going 3-4 at Met Stadium, 13-10 at the Metrodome and 2-5 at Target Field.

♣ Three wins this Postseason already marks the Twins most since 2002, when they won three of five against the A's in the ALDS and won one of five against Anaheim in the ALCS.

TWINS LIFTOFF IN HOUSTON: The Twins beat the Astros on Sunday night by a score of 6-2 in Game 2 of the ALDS...Pablo López (2-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with six hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...López joined Jack Morris (G7-1991 WS vs. ATL) and Johan Santana (G1 - 2004 ALDS at NYY) as the only pitchers in Twins history (since 1961) to pitch at least 7.0-plus scoreless innings in a Postseason game...the offense recorded 10 hits and was led by Carlos Correa, who went 3-for-4 with a walk, two doubles and three RBI...kyle Farmer recorded his first career Postseason hit with a second inning two-run homer...Minnesota went 2-for-6 with runners in scoring position after entering the game 2-for-22 with RISP in their previous three during the playoffs.

The victory was Minnesota's first in the Division Series since a 2-0 win at New York-AL in Game 1 on October 5, 2004.

THE RUNNING MEN: The six runs scored by the Twins on Sunday marked their most in a Post-season game since a 7-6 12-inning loss on October 6, 2004 at New York-AL (ALDS - G2)...it marked their most in a non-extra-inning Postseason game since an 11-2 victory on October 5, 2002 vs. Oakland (ALDS - G4)...Minnesota has scored 15 runs through four Postseason games, averaging 3.8-per-game...entering this Postseason, the Twins had scored a total of five runs in their previous four playoff games, dating back to Game 2 of the 2019 ALDS.

WIN-NESOTA: The Twins are 2-0 through two Postseason home games after sweeping the Blue Jays in two games during the AL Wild Card Series from October 3-4...a win today would give the Twins their first home victory in the Division Series round since an 11-2 win at the Metrodome in Game 4 vs. Oakland on October 5, 2002.

◆ The Twins finished the regular season with a home record of 47-34 (.580), the fourth-most home wins in the AL and eighth most in baseball...after the All-Star break, they went 21-12 at Target Field for a .536 winning percentage, trailing only Texas (.639 — 23-13) for highest home win % in the AL in that span...Minnesota's 47 regular season wins at Target Field this season were the third most in the Target Field era (since 2010), trailing their totals from 2010 (53-28) and 2018 (49-32).

TWINS-'STROS: The Twins are 5-3 against the Astros this season over eight regular and Postseason games...they have gone 3-2 at Minute Maid Park at 2-1 at Target Field.

₱ Carlos Correa has hit just .216 (8-for-37) with 14 strikeouts against his former team in 10 regular and Postseason games, but has gone 5-for-8 with one walk, three doubles and three RBI in his last two games during the ALDS.

₱ Notable individual numbers vs. Houston this season (regular and Postseason): Alex Kirilloff is 5-for-13 (.385) with six walks (.600 0BP)...Ryan Jeffers is 7-for-18 (.389) with a double, a home run and four RBI...Willi Castro is 5-for-14 (.357) with two walks (.438 0BP)...Christian Vázquez is 4-for-10 (.400) with three RBI and two walks (.500 0BP)...Byarmer is 8-for-21 (.381) with two home runs, six RBI and one walk (.409 0BP)...Donovan Solano is 8-for-21 (.381) with five RBI and three walks (.458 0BP).

POSTSEASON PER-4-MER: In 83 career Postseason games, Carlos Correa has hit .285 (90-for-316) with 19 doubles, 18 home runs, 63 RBI, 37 runs scored, 31 walks, a .356 on-base percentage and an .872 OPS...through four Postseason games this season, he is 8-for-15 (.533) with three doubles, four RBI, a .588 on-base percentage, a .733 slugging percentage and a 1.322 OPS.

◆ Sunday night's three RBI gave Correa 63 Postseason RBI for his career, passing Derek Jeter (61) and David Ortiz (61), tying him with David Justice for third on baseball's all-time Postseason RBI list...his three filts Sunday night gave him 90 career Postseason knocks, now 10th-most in baseball history, passing David Justice (89) and David Ortiz (88).

◆ In 27 career Division Series games, Correa has hit .317 (32-for-101) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 32 RBI, a .405 on-base percentage, a .634 slugging percentage and a 1.039 OPS...in his last 10 DS games, he is hitting .486 (17-for-35) with five doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, nine walks, a .591 on-base percentage, an .886 slugging percentage and a 1.477 OPS.

◆ Correa's teams are 23-9 all-time in the Postseason when he drives in at least one run.

STARTER STRENGTH: Through four Postseason games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 3-1, 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP, 4 ER) with opponents hitting .253 (20-for-79), two home runs, to go 3-1, 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP, five walks and 18 strikeouts.

POSTSZN TO THE MAX: Max Kepler has reached safely in seven-consecutive Postseason games and in nine of 10 in his career...he enters today with a four-game hitting streak in the Postseason, dating back to Game 1 of the ALWCS vs. Toronto...he has eight walks, compared to five hits in 41 career Postseason plate appearances (.317 OBP).

The Kepler is 4-for-15 this Postseason after entering 2023 1-for-18 in six previous playoff games.

PACK THE PARK: Today and tomorrow's games at Target Field have been anounced as sellouts...fans are encouraged to continue checking back at twins.com/postseason should more ticket inventory become available...for the two-game ALWC Series games vs. Toronto last week, the Twins drew 38,450 and 38,518 (both sellouts) for a total of 76,968.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first career Postseason win in Game 2 of the 2023 American League Wild Card Series on October 4 vs. Toronto...pitched 5.0 shutout innings and allowed five hits, with two walks and six strikeouts in a 2-0 Twins' victory...picked off Vladimir Guerrero Jr. at second base to end the top of the fifth inning, becoming the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history with a pickoff in the Postseason, joining Jim Merritt on October 9, 1965 (World Series Game 3) and Frank Viola on October 25, 1987 (World Series Game 7)...also became the third pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to allow at least five hits and no runs in a Postseason start, joining Jack Morris on October 27, 1991 in Game 7 of the World Series (10.0 IP, 7 H) and Johan Santana on October 5, 2004 in Game 1 of the ALDS (7.0 IP, 9 H).

AGAINST HOUSTON: Gray is facing Houston for the third time this season and for the 13th time in his career...is 4-4, 3.03 ERA (77.1 IP, 26 ER) with 25 walks and 65 strikeouts in his previous 12 appearances in the regular season...did not factor into the 7-5 Twins' victory in his last start against the Astros on May 29 at Minute Maid Park; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits, with three walks and three strikeouts...allowed an RBI ground-ball double play to Kyle Tucker in the fourth inning...exited the game in the seventh inning after allowing a double to Tucker and walking José Abreu...relieved by Brock Stewart who allowed a single to Mauricio Dubón to load the bases and surrendered a grand slam to Jose Altuve (2 runs charged to Gray).

4 Has not earned a win against Houston since September 8, 2015 when he led the Oakland Athletics to a 4-0 win at Oakland Coliseum after pitching 7.0 shutout innings and allowing five hits, with two walks and four strikeouts...is 0-2, 4.46 ERA (34.1 IP, 17 ER) with 16 walks and 32 strikeouts in his last six starts.

POSTSEASON PROWESS: Gray is making his sixth career Postseason start today...is 1-2, 2.39 ERA (26.1 IP, 7 ER) with 14 walks, 24 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average in his previous five starts (1 Wild Card, 3 Divisional Series and 1 Championship Series)...is 0-2, 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER) with 10 walks and 14 strikeouts in three previous Divisional Series starts.

40 owns the fifth-lowest ERA in Postseason games since 2013 (min. 5 GS), trailing Madison Bumgarner (1.22), Ian Anderson (1.26), Stephen Strasburg (1.46) and Marco Estrada (2.16)...also owns the seventh-lowest opponent slugging percentage (.293).

FAMILIAR FOE: Gray started in Game 4 of the 2017 American League Championship Series vs. Houston as a member of the New York Yankees; did not factor into the 6-4 Yankees' win after pitching 5.0-plus innings and allowing two runs (1 earned) on one hit with two walks and four strikeouts...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings...walked George Springer to lead off the sixth inning and exited the game after Josh Reddick reached first on a catcher's interference...relieved by David Roberston who allowed a bases-clearing double to Yuli Gurriel (2 runs charged to Gray).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper, sinker and cutter against righties, while favoring his fastball, curveball and changeup against lefties....recorded four strikeouts off his sweeper, one off his curveball and one off his fastball in his last start on Orther A vs. Toponto, here's a look at his reporting (regular caseon + Desteason).
