**18 THURSDAY, MARCH 28 at KC**

**THE TWINS:** Today the Twins will play the 17th of 35 scheduled Grapefruit League games (unofficially opened the spring schedule against the University of Minnesota on February 23)...eight more games will be played at Lee Health Sports Complex and nine games will be played on the road...today the Twins will trek north to play the Atlanta Braves in North Port, followed by the long journey to Lakeland on Tuesday to face the Detroit Tigers.

**Jersey of the Day:** Spotted in the stadium stands during yesterday's Twins-Nationals game, a befuddled fan seems to have gotten their sports confused, wearing Kylian Mbappé Paris Saint-Germain kit to the match...also spotted, a slightly more on-theme white pinstriped Doug Mientkiewicz jersey.

**TWINS FALL TO NATS:** The Twins lost to the Washington Nationals, 7-3, yesterday afternoon at Lee Health Sports Complex...Pablo López (0-2) was the starter and took the loss, allowing four runs (2 ER) on five hits, with no walks and three strikeouts...top pitching prospect David Festa made his spring debut and worked 1.0 scoreless inning in relief, with one hit allowed and one walk...Max Kepler hit his second homer of spring, a two-run shot in the fourth inning, and Manuel Margot went 2-for-3...the Twins went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position and left four men on base.

**TWINS AND BRAVES:** The Twins and Braves are playing each other for the third of six meetings this spring...Twins are 1-1 against the Braves so far; Atlanta shut out the Twins 5-0 at CoolToday Park on February 29 and Minnesota won, 4-3, on March 4 at Lee Health Sports Complex, part of a split-squad day...they will travel back to North Port for one more game (March 25) and host the Braves for two games (March 22 and 26)...last spring the Twins went 1-4 against the Braves during spring training, their only win coming in Fort Myers on February 28...these two met during the regular season for three games at Truist Park as Minnesota was swept from June 26-28...Minnesota will host the Braves in 2024 for three games from August 26-28, which will be their first trip to Target Field since August of 2019.

**THERE'S A "NEW" SHERIFF IN TOWN:** Chris Paddack is making his fourth career spring training appearance in a Twins uniform today...his first start was on February 23 in the unofficial Home Opener against the University of Minnesota, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, one walk and two strikeouts...also worked 2.0 scoreless innings with one strikeout against the Braves in North Port on February 29 and took the loss against the St. Louis Cardinals in Jupiter on March 5...Paddack never appeared in 2022 spring training with Minnesota because he was acquired via trade with San Diego the night before Opening Day...in 2023 spring training, he was recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow...after rehabbing most of the 2023 season, he made his return on September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL; he exited the bullpen and as he was approaching the infield dirt, the umpires called for the tarp and a 50-minute rain delay transpired...Paddack went straight to the dugout and did not pitch in the game but was officially in the box score...he made two more official regular season appearance then made two appearances in relief during the Postseason.

**HE'S BAAAAACCKKKK:** Edouard Julien is back in the lineup today as the designated hitter, after getting plunked on the right hand on Friday in Bradenton...is 8-for-19 (.421) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, one walk, one stolen base, six runs scored and a .789 on-base percentage in eight games...in 2023, hit .263 (89-for-338) with 16 doubles, one triple, 16 home runs, 37 RBI, 64 walks, three stolen bases, 60 runs scored and an .839 OPS in 109 games for the Twins...ranked second among all MLB rookies in on-base percentage (.381, minimum of 350 plate appearances) and walks-per-strikeout (0.50), fourth in batting WAR (1.7), fifth in wOBA (.369) and runs created-per 27 (6.14), third in OPS+ (132.8), eighth in overall WAR (3.0), ninth in slugging percentage (.459) and 12th in batting average (.263).

**FAST WILLI:** Willi Castro is in his second spring training with the Twins...is hitting .500 (9-for-18) with one home run, one RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored in seven spring games so far...he was an invite to 2023 spring training and made the club's Opening Day roster, spending all season with Minnesota...in 2023, he set a career high with 33 stolen bases, which also led the team and ranked fourth in baseball (38 attempts)...most stolen bases for a Twin since Ben Revere stole 40 in 2012...posted a 86.8 stolen base percentage, seventh best in baseball...played seven different positions defensively...played 54 games (33 starts) in leftfield, 45 games (29 starts) in centerfield, 41 games (23 starts) at third base, 10 games (4 starts) at second base, eight games (1 start) at shortstop and four games (2 starts) in rightfield...also pitched three times.
