$\Phi$ Minnesota will start the regular season on Thursday with the first of three games in four days against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
LAST GAME RECAP: The Twins lost to the Nationals on Thursday afternoon in West Palm by a score of 9-8...Cole Sands was the starter, allowing four runs on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched...Daniel Duarte pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief and Kody Funderburk pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief...the offense recorded 13 hits, two coming from Alex Kirilloff and Kyle Farmer....Kirilloff drove in two of the runs, giving him six RBI on the spring, while his two hits in four at-bats improved his spring batting average to .324 .

THE SHERIFF'S IN TOWN: Chris Paddack is making his fourth "official" spring training start tonight...he opened the exhibition schedule with an unofficial start against the Golden Gophers on February 23...Paddack never appeared in 2022 spring training with Minnesota because surgery the bullon and as he was approaching the infield dirt the umpires called fo the tap and 50 -minute rain deay transpired Paddack went straight to the dugout and did not pitch in the game but was officially in the box score....he made two more official regular season appearance then made two appearances in relief during the Postseason.
