Faced Kansas City three times in 2023, going 3-0, 2.66 ERA (20.1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 21 strikeouts...threw first career complete-game shutout in most recent start vs. Royals on July 5, 2023, striking out 12 and walking none (4 H) at Target Field.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Posted a 7.07 ERA (14.0 IP, 11 ER) with two walks and 14 strikeouts in four 2024 Grapefruit League starts...made final spring appearance on Saturday, March 23 in exhibition vs. Red Sox minor leaguers (Double-A), throwing 53 pitches in 4.0 innings...scheduled Grapefruit League start the previous day was canceled due to rain.

OPENING DAY HONORS: Made first career Opening Day start in 2023 on March 30 at Kauffman, pitching 5.1 shutout innings, with two hits allowed (Perez single, Isbel double), three walks and eight strikeouts, earning the victory in a Twins 2-0 win...López will become the 13th different Twins pitcher to start consecutive Opening Days, joining Camilo Pascual (1963-64), Jim Perry (1970-71), Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Dave Goltz (1977-79), Jerry Koosman (1980-81), Frank Viola (1985-86, '88-89), Kevin Tapani (1993-94), Brad Radke (1996-97, '99-05), Johan Santana (2006-07), Carl Pavano (2011-12), Ervin Santana (2016-17) and José Berrios (2019-20).

RULING THE ROYALS: Owns a 2.70 ERA (26.2 IP, 8 ER) and 0.975 WHIP with 33 strikeouts in four career starts vs. Kansas City...made first Kauffman Stadium appearance on Opening Day in 2023, fanning eight and allowing no runs in 5.1 innings, earning victory as Twins won, 2-0...defeated Kansas City again April 28, 2023, lasting 6.0 innings despite allowing six earned runs on eight hits (4 XBH) with one walk and seven strikeouts...threw first career complete-game shutout July 5, 2023, striking out 12 Royals and walking none in 5-0 victory...Kansas City hit .194 (14-for-72) with a .577 OPS in 20.1 innings vs. López in 2023.

- Faced Kansas City once with Miami, yielding two runs over 6.1 innings but losing, 3-0, in September 6, 2019 start at Marlins Park.
Was the only MLB pitcher to earn three wins vs. Kansas City in 2023.

AWAY FROM HOME: In 2023, made 16 starts each at home and on the road...posted a 4.21 ERA (98.1 IP, 46 ER) with 25 walks, 123 strikeouts and a .236 opponent batting average at Target Field, compared to a 3.10 ERA (95.2 IP, 33 ER) with 23 walks, 111 strikeouts and a .236 opponent batting average on the road...allowed a .326 batting average on balls in play at home, compared to .302 on the road...yielded 34 extra-base hits (20 2B, 3 3B, 11 HR) at home, 21 (6 2B, 2 3B, 13 HR) on the road...posted a 1.78 ERA with 31 strikeouts in his first four road starts of 2023.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2023, left-handed hitters slashed .271/.328/.426 in 407 plate appearances vs. López, while righties slashed .205/.254/.342 in 394 plate appearances...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 87.8 mph, hard-hit percentage of 36.3 and batting average on balls in play (BABIP) of .343, compared to righties' 86.4 mph, 33.8 percent and .279 BABIP.

Tied with Luis Castillo for third-lowest opponent batting average vs. righties (min. 350 batters faced), trailing Blake Snell (.176) and Zack Wheeler (.194).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in 2023, per Baseball Savant...primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...threw 33 sweepers on May 27 vs. Toronto (37.5% usage), his most in any start last season...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal.

- Acquired from Miami on January 20 along with prospects José Salas and Byron Chourio.
Threw 5.1 scoreless innings and won Opening Day start March 30 at Kansas City.
Signed four-year extension April 21, keeping him under contract through 2027 season.
Tossed first career complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts vs. Kansas City on July 5.
Selected to first All-Star team, pitching a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts in AL defeat.
Completed 6.0-or-more innings in five consecutive starts from July 25 to August 18, going 4-0 with a 0.84 ERA and .554 opponents' OPS during that span.
Set another career-high with 14 strikeouts September 10 vs. New York-NL, throwing eight scoreless frames in a 2-0 loss.
Ranked in 98th percentile in baseball in pitching run value (.26), 95th percentile in chase percentage (34.3%), 93rd percentile in xERA (3.00), 90th percentile in fastball run value (.12).

Joe Ryan is set to make his season debut Saturday vs. Kansas City at Kauffman Stadium...will mark beginning of his fourth big league season and third on Minnesota's Opening Day roster...posted a 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 19 strikeouts in five 2024 Grapefruit League starts...won his first start in 2023, on April 2 at Kansas City, allowing one run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...boasts a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER) in two career appearances vs. Kansas City...held hitters to a .186 average and .533 OPS in April 2023, his best marks of any month last season.

Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCWS vs. Toronto.
In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
