THE TWINS: The Twins began their 64th season in Minnesota with an Opening Day victory in Kansas City on Thursday...today they will play the second of three games at Kauffman Stadium...following this series, the Twins will travel to Milwaukee to enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play the Brewers for a two-game series at American Family Field from Tuesday-Wednesday...following this trip, Minnesota will open its 15th season at Target Field with three against the Cleveland Guardians (April 4-7) and three against the Los Angeles Dodgers (April 8-10).

LÓP-ACE COOKS ON OPENING DAY: The Twins beat the Royals in the Season Opener on Thursday afternoon by a score of 4-1, winning their second-straight Opening Day and fourth OD win in their last six seasons...Pablo López was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with one run allowed on four hits, no walks and seven strikeouts...it marked Pablo's second-straight Opening Day start, becoming the 13th pitcher in club history (since 1961) to start back-to-back openers...López allowed a leadoff home run to Maikel García but retired 20 of the next 23 batters...he became just the second pitcher in Twins history to win back-to-back Season Openers on the road, the other being Frank Viola (1985 at CAL and '96 at OAK)...Brock Stewart earned a hold with a scoreless eighth and Griffin Jax earned a save with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded 10 hits, highlighted by Carlos Correa (3-for-4) and Royce Lewis (2-for-2)...Lewis homered and singled before exiting in the third inning with a right quad strain.

Byron Buxton started the game in centerfield, his first in a regular season game since August 22, 2022 vs. Texas, a span of 584 days in the field.

Max Kepler made his eighth career Opening Day start in right field (2017-24), matching Hall of Famer Tony Oliva (1964-71) for the most Opening Day starts at the position in Twins history (since 1961), ahead of Tom Brunansky (6), Matt Lawton (6) and Michael Cuddyer (5).

LEWIS TO THE IL: The Twins announced today that they have placed infielder Royce Lewis on the 10-day Injured List with a right quad strain...Lewis sustained the injury while running the bases during the third inning on Thursday...to replace Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled utility player Austin Martin from Triple-A St. Paul...Martin, who was added to Minnesota's 40-man roster in November, played in 10 games for the Twins in spring training, going 5-for-24 (.208) with one double, two RBI and three walks.

The 6-foot, 191-pound utility man spent a majority of the 2023 season with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .263 (54-for-205) with 11 doubles, six home runs, 28 RBI, 33 runs scored, 36 walks, 16 stolen bases (20 chances) and a .791 OPS in 59 games...in his final 49 games, from July 19-end of the season, he hit .289 (48-for-166) with eight doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI, 30 runs scored and an .861 OPS.

The 25-year-old was originally selected by the Toronto Blue Jays with the fifth overall pick in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University and was acquired by the Twins as part of the José Berrios trade in July of 2021.

Martin is ranked as the 15th-best prospect in the Twins organization by MLB.com, as well as the ninth-best prospect for the club by *Baseball America*.

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing the second of 13 meetings in 2024...in 2023, the Twins went 9-4 against KC, including a record of 6-1 at Target Field and 3-3 at Kauffman Stadium...Minnesota began the season by going 9-1 against KC but were swept in three games during their final meeting from July 28-30 at Kauffman Stadium.

Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 50-31 vs. Kansas City, including a record of 21-20 at Kauffman Stadium...50 wins are his most against any opponent and 21 wins at Kauffman are his personal most.

The Twins' 22 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.
Carlos Correa is hitting .335 (55-for-164) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 25 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a .942 OPS in 43 games against the Royals since '19...he has reached safely in 21-straight games at Kauffman Stadium, the longest active streak in this ballpark.

Byron Buxton is hitting .350 (42-for-117) with 14 doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 32 runs scored and a 1.073 OPS in his last 30 games against the Royals...he has reached base safely in 17-straight games at Kauffman Stadium, the second-longest active streak in this ballpark, trailing Correa's 21.

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins went 27-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 15-8-3 at home and 13-11-2 on the road.

Minnesota went 5-0-0 in their final five road series' of 2023, beating Texas, Cleveland, Chicago-AL, Cincinnati and Colorado — all in September.

Minnesota has gone 5-2-0 in their last seven series vs. the Royals, dating back to August of 2022...their last series win at Kauffman Stadium came in a three-game sweep to begin the 2023 season, from March 30-April 2.

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: The Twins finished the 2023 season with a road record of 40-41, including a record of 14-7 in their final 21...Minnesota had a run differential of +59 (386-327) on the road last season.

Edouard Julien is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, six walks, a .405 on-base percentage and a 1.016 OPS in his last 10 road games, dating back to September 14, 2023.

Matt Wallner is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with two doubles, six RBI, four walks, a .484 on-base percentage and a 1.076 OPS in his last 10 road games, dating back to September 14, 2023.

YOU STAY CLASSY, PLANET EARTH: A total of 264 players represented 19 different countries and territories outside of the 50 United States on 2024 MLB Opening Day rosters and inactive lists...for the fourth consecutive season, the Astros have the most internationally-born players with a total of 16 on their roster...they are followed by the Padres (15), Red Sox (14), Marlins (14), Guardians (12), Twins (11), Mets (11), Pirates (11) and Rays (11)...of the 11 Twins, six different non-U.S. countries were represented: Puerto Rico (3): Willi Castro, Carlos Correa and Christian Vázquez; Dominican Republic (4): Jorge Alcalá, Johan Duran, Manuel Margot and Carlos Santana; Germany (1): Max Kepler; Mexico (1): Daniel Duarte; Canada (1): Edouard Julien; and Venezuela (1): Pablo López.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan's last start of last season came in Game 4 of the ALDS vs. the Houston Astros in the first Postseason appearance of his career on October 11, 2023, pitching 2.0 innings, allowing two hits and one run on second-inning home run by Michael Brantley...it was the shortest start of the season for Ryan...was relieved by five pitchers as the Twins eventually lost by a score of 3-2, eliminating them from the Postseason.

SPRING RECAP: In five Grapefruit League starts, Ryan went 2-1, 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 19 strikeouts...in his final Grapefruit League appearance vs. the Baltimore Orioles on March 24, he pitched 5.0 innings, two hits allowing two runs on a first-inning two-run homer by Gunnar Henderson, with one walk and five strikeouts.

SPECIAL K: Has recorded 378 career strikeouts through his first 61 games, the most in Twins' history (1961-) through a pitcher's first 61 career games...would also hold the record through a pitcher's first 62 career games, six ahead of Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (372 from 1970-72)...his 10.15 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio in his career is the fourth best in Twins' history and his 4.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio also ranks fourth (min. 300.0 IP).

- ☞ Recorded a career-high 197 strikeouts last season, becoming the 11th pitcher in Twins' history (1961-) to strike out at least 197 batters in a single season.
- ☞ Also set a single-season career high with a 10.97 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, the highest ratio in club history (1961-) among pitchers with at least 25 starts.

JOE VS. THE ROYALS: Facing Kansas City for the seventh time in his career...is 5-0, 1.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 41 strikeouts in six prior starts vs. the Royals...got the win at Kansas City on April 2 in his first start of the year, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits (1 HR), facing 19 hitters with two walks and six strikeouts in the Twins' 2-0 victory...the only run given up by Ryan was on 3-2 count with two outs in the bottom of the second inning, a home run by Edward Olivares.

- ☞ His 1.50 ERA against Royals is his lowest vs. any opponent in his career (min. 3 GS).
- ☞ At Kauffman Stadium, is 3-0, 1.02 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER)...best vs. any opponent on the road in his career. (min. 3 GS).
- ☞ Last win vs. Royals came on April 2, 2022 at Kauffman Stadium, allowing one run on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched with two walks and six strikeouts.
- ☞ Ryan's five wins against the Royals since the start of 2022 are tied with former teammate Sonny Gray for most in baseball against KC in that span.

ON THE ROAD: Went 4-6 with a 5.22 ERA (79.1 IP, 46 ER) 19 walks and 86 strikeouts in 15 starts on the road in 2023...Twins went 7-8 in Ryan's 15 starts on the road.

- ☞ In 29 career road starts, he is 12-10, 4.52 ERA (155.1 IP, 78 ER) with 38 walks and 162 strikeouts...Twins are 16-13 in his 29 career starts on the road.
- ☞ Allowed 20 of his 32 home runs (62.5%) on the road in 2023...has only given up one home run at Kauffman Stadium in 17.2 innings pitched.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan utilized a four-pitch mix in his 29 regular season starts last season...leaned on his four-seam fastball and split-finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 84.1 percent of the time last year...ranked third in baseball in 2023 in strikeouts with his four-seam fastball (120), trailing only ATL's Spencer Strider (123) and NYY's Gerrit Cole (121)...here's a look at Ryan's 2023 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
