THE TWINS: The Twins began their 64th season in Minnesota with consecutive wins in Kansas City on Thursday and Saturday...today they will play the three-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium...following today's game, the Twins will travel to Milwaukee to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play the Brewers for a two-game series at American Family Field from Tuesday-Wednesday...following this trip, Minnesota will open its 15th season at Target Field with three against the Cleveland Guardians (April 4-7) and three against the Los Angeles Dodgers (April 8-10).

THE BUCK TRUCK WEIGHS IN AT KANSAS CITY: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 5-1, scoring all five runs in the eighth and ninth innings, including a four-run ninth...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts... Griffin Jax earned the win with a scoreless eighth and Brock Stewart pitched a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-4 with three RBI, driving in the tying run with an eighth-inning double and driving in two insurance runs with a ninth-inning double.

◆ Minnesota matched a Twins record with four batters reaching via hit by pitch (Buxton, Castro, Wallner, Jeffers), previously done on July 5, 1970, April 13, 1971 and May 7, 1995 (17.0 innings).

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 377 career managerial wins, one away from tying Gene Mauch for fourth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

KINGS OF THE HILL: Twins pitchers have allowed just two runs through two games, the fewest runs allowed by a pitching staff to this point (next: Texas - 5, Detroit - 6, 4 teams with 7)... the runs have been scored by KC on a Maikel García leadoff home run on Thursday and an MJ Melendez RBI single in the sixth inning on Saturday...one run-or-fewer allowed in each of the first two games for Minnesota marks the fourth time in club history, also 2023, 2017 and 2003.
◆ Starters Pablo López and Joe Ryan have combined to allow two runs on 12.1 innings pitched (1.46 ERA) with one walk and 12 strikeouts.

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing the third of 13 meetings in 2024...their next series will be a four-gamer in Minnesota from May 27-30...the Twins next trip to Kansas City will be a three-game series from September 6-8.

♣ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 51-31 vs. Kansas City, including a record of 22-20 at Kauffman Stadium...51 wins are his most against any opponent and 22 wins at Kauffman are his personal most.

♣ The Twins' 23 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .325 (55-for-169) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 25 walks, a .412 on-base percentage and a .915 OPS in 44 games against the Royals since '19.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .355 (43-for-121) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 32 runs scored and a 1.091 OPS in his last 31 games against the Royals...he has reached base safely in 18-straight games at Kauffman Stadium, the longest active streak in this ballpark.

MASKED SINGER: Since 2020, only Lucas Giolito has allowed more earned runs (35) against the Twins than Brady Singer (33)...notable individuals lifetime against Singer: Byron Buxton is 7-for-13 (.538) with two doubles, two home runs and four RBI...Carlos Correa is 5-for-12 (.417) with two doubles, two RBI and two walks...Max Kepler is 5-for-20 (.250) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI and four walks (.375 OBP).

TWINS TRY CLEAN UP AT THE K: Last season the Twins swept opponents six times, five in three games and one in two games...they swept Kansas City twice in 2023: March 30-April 2 at Kauffman Stadium and July 3-5 at Target Field.

◆ The Twins have opened a season by sweeping a three-game series nine times in their history, most recently in 2023 at KC and 2017 vs. KC.

◆ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the Royals 12 times (56 series), their most of any opponent in that span (next: White Sox - 9 times and Tigers - 8 times).

ALL SAINTS NIGHT: Triple-A St. Paul began their season last night after a weather postponement Friday night at CHS Field...they beat the Columbus Clippers by a score of 8-1...David Festa was the starter, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, three walks and four strikeouts...Jose Miranda highlighted the offense, going 2-for-4 with a double and a home run.

THE MOR YOU NEAU: Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau hit 26 career home runs against the Royals, his most vs. any opponent.. his first career homer was on June 17, 2003 at Kauffman Stadium, a solo shot off Albie Lopez.

FINAL 2023 APPEARANCE: Ober concluded his 2023 campaign October 10, in Game 3 of the ALDS vs. Houston, pitching 1.1 innings of relief and allowing three runs on four hits with one walk, two strikeouts and two home runs...started Game 1 of ALDS at Minute Maid Park on October 7, allowing three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 3.0 innings, with no walks and two strikeouts.

OBER VS. ROYALS: Making eighth career start vs. Kansas City and fifth at Kauffman Stadium...has gone 0-2 with a 5.23 ERA (31.0 IP, 18 ER), five walks and 33 strikeouts in his career vs. Kansas City... owns a 5.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 11 ER) with two walks and 16 strikeouts at Kauffman; his second-worst ERA at any big league park (min. 2 GS), ahead of only Guaranteed Rate Field (5.89)...last pitched at Kauffman on July 29, 2023, allowing six runs on 11 hits (2 HR) in 4.0 innings.

◆ Two active Royals − MJ Melendez and Bobby Witt Jr. − have homered against Ober.

SMOOTH ROAD IN '23: Went 5-3 with a 3.57 ERA (68.0 IP, 27 ER), 12 walks and 75 strikeouts in 12 road starts in 2023...six of his 12 quality starts came on the road...yielded a .233 BAA and .670 OPS on the road in 2023, compared to a .230 BAA and .692 OPS at Target Field...allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last four road starts during 2023 regular season...both of his 2023 season-high-tying nine-strikeout outings came on the road: August 9 at DET and October 1 at COL. ₱ In 28 career road starts, he's gone 6-8 with a 3.68 ERA (144.1 IP, 59 ER), 25 walks and 145 strikeouts.

LEFT AND RIGHT. Left-handed hitters batted, 228 (62-for-272) with 17 walks and 63 strikeouts vs. Ober last season...right-handers hit. 236 (63-for-267) with 12 walks and 83 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters have slashed .251/.307/.399 with a 21.3 percent strikeout rate against Ober...

righties have hit .229/.260/.439 with a 27.9 percent strikeout rate. **♥** In Ober's two 2023 starts vs. Kansas City, left-handed hitters went 9-for-22 with a .545 slugging percentage, while righties went 6-for-21 and slugged .524, hitting two doubles and a home run.

THE ARSENAL: Ober wielded a four-pitch mix in 2023, per Baseball Savant...utilized fastball and changeup against all hitters, while mostly featuring slider vs. righties and curveball vs. lefties... here's a look at his repertoire:
