THE TWINS: Today the Twins will play the eighth of 35 scheduled spring training games and the seventh official Grapefruit League spring game... 15 more games will be played at Lee Health Sports Complex and 13 games will be played on the road...tomorrow afternoon the to take on the Tampa Bay Rays in a unique doubleheader - following the conclusion of the Grapefruit League game, the significant others of the Twins and Rays will take the field for a charity softball game.

TWINS BLANKED BY BRAVES: The Twins were shut out by the Atlanta Braves in North Port yesterday afternoon, 5-0; Minnesota hasn't won since defeating Pittsburgh 5-3 on February 24 (4 losses, 1 tie since)...Chris Paddack was the starter and did not factor into the decision, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings with one strikeout... Kody Funderburk was saddled with the loss in relief yielding four runs ( 3 earned) on four hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...Alex Kirilloff went 1 -for- 3 with a pair of throwing errors and Jose Miranda went 1 -for-2 with one walk...the Twins went 0 -for-3 with runners in scoring position and left six men on base.

THE BATTLE OF DANIELS PARKWAY: Today marks the second of six scheduled spring meetings between the Twins and Red Sox...Twins fell to Boston, 8-6, at JetBlue Park on February 25 ...Minnesota will host the Sox for two more games (March 6 and 18 ) and Boston will host the Twins two more times (March 15 and 23)...the Twins went 3-2 against Boston last spring, claiming their first Chairman's Cup victory since 2020 (results below)...during the 2023 regular season, the Twins went 3-4 against Boston, going 1-2 at Fenway Park from April 18-20 and 2-2 at for three games at Fenway Park from September 20-22.

FIRE ON THE MOUND-TAIN: Joe Ryan will be making his 2024 spring debut against the Red Sox this afternoon...went 2-1, 2.16 ERA (16.2 IP, 4 ER) with three walks, 20 strikeouts and a 1.02 WHIP in five starts last spring...in 2023, made Twins Opening Day roster for second time in career (second time consecutively) and was club's number three starter; went 11-10, 4.51 ERA ( 161.2 IP, 81 ) with 34 walks and 197 strikeouts in 29 starts...began season 5-0, 2.37 ERA ( 38.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 43 strikeouts in first six starts from April 2-May 2; became seventh pitcher in Twins/Senators franchise history to win each of his first five starts...pitched first career complete-game shutout on June 22 vs. Boston, allowing three hits, with no walks and nine strikeouts in a Twins 6-0 victory...struck out Michael Stefanic on September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL, the 1,462nd strikeout for Twins pitchers on season, setting a Twins/Senators franchise record...ranked second on Twins staff in strikeouts (147) and second in innings pitched (161.2) and starts (29); also ranked third in the AL and fourth in baseball in strikeouts-per-walk ratio at 5.79 (minimum of 150.0 innings pitched).
