JERSEY/SHIRSEY OF THE DAY: Spotted in the stairway of the Lee Health County Sports Complex postgame yesterday was a navy Alexi Casilla shirsey.
TAMPA COMES DOWN FOR A TIE: The Twins hosted Elvis Martinez and the Rays yesterday afternoon in Fort Myers and drew a 4-4 tie, their second of the spring (other: $3-3 \mathrm{vs}$. PHI on Feb. 27)...Simeon Woods Richardson pitched 2.0 scoreless innings to start, allowing one hit, two walks and one strikeout...Jhoan Duran, Jay Jackson and Justin Topa each pitched 1.0 scoreless inning...the offense set a spring high spring, a solo shot in the fourth inning.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN: The Twins Families defeated the Rays Families, $10-5$, in a nine-inning charity softball game following yesterday's Twins/Rays game...the event included a pregame ceremony with a $\$ 10,000$ check presented to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Charlotte and two-run home run and a three-run jack in the eighth inning....the Twins' defense was highlighted by an outfield assist by leftfielder Daniella Correa (wife of Carlos), and solid play by third baseman Trish Topa (wife of Justin) and shortstop Lina Staumont (wife of Josh), who also tallied multiple hits.

TWINS AND BRAVES: At Lee Health Sports Complex, the Twins and Braves are playing each other for the second of six meetings this spring... their last meeting came at CoolToday Park last Tuesday as Atlanta shut out the Twins 5-0...they will travel back to North Port for two more games (March 11 and 25) and host the Braves for two games (March 22 and 26)...last spring the Twins went $1-4$ against the Braves during spring training, their only win coming in Fort Myers on February 28 ..these two met during the regular season for three games at Truist Park as Minnesota was swept from June 26-28...Minnesota will host the Braves in 2024 for three games from August $26-28$, which will be their first trip to Target Field since August of 2019.

I'M JUST GLADD TO BE HERE: Twins Hall of Famer and radio ace Dan Gladden played in 42 career regular and Postseason games against the Braves during his stellar career from 1983-91, hitting. 333 ( 50 -or-- 150 ) with tive doubles, two triples, two home runs, $10 \mathrm{RBI}, 28$ runs scored, 14 stolen bases, a .399 on-base percentage and an .832 OPS....in 35 regular season games, Gladden hit .358 with an .856 OPS against Atlanta - the average being his highest against any opponent and his OPS being second highest (Philadelphia - .861 ).

BIRD WATCHING: Up at Ed Smith Stadium in Sarasota, the Twins and Orioles are facing off for the second of three scheduled meetings this spring...these two last met on Wednesday as the 0's beat the Twins by a score of 12-3 in Fort Myers...these two will meet one more time this spring at Lee Health Sports Complex on March $24 .$. Twins went 1 .-2-1 agreats ine series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards from April are slated to tace off six times in the 2024 regular season, beginning with
$15-17$, followed by three games at Target Field from September 27-29.

PABLO DAY, PART 2: Pablo López is on the mound today making his second spring start after taking the loss vs. Baltimore on February 28 ...went 0-0, 4.00 ERA ( 9.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in four appearances ( 3 starts) in 2023 spring training...the 2023 and soon-to-be 2024 Twins Opening Day starter went 11-8, 3.66 ERA (194.0 IP, 79 ER) with 48 walks, 234 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in 32 starts for Minnesota in 2023, after being acquired from Miami last January...set career highs in wins (11), innings pitched (194.2), quality starts (20), strikeouts (234), strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched (10.9), strikeouts-per-walk (4.9) and tied career-high in starts (32).... his 234 strikeouts matched Dean Chance's 1968 total for seventh most in club history and were the most since Johan Santana struck
out 235 in $2007 . .$. also fo finished fifth in the AL in innings pitched (194.0) and ninth in all of baseball...ranked 11th in the AL in ERA (3.66) and opponent batting average (.238), tied for third in the AL in quality starts (20) and tied for fifth in baseball; also finished ninth in the AL in WHIP (1.15)...went 2-0, 0.71 ERA (12.2 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and 10 strikeouts in two Postseason starts for the Twins, leading the club to its first playoff win in 19 years....won the Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award, voted on by the Twin Cities chapter of the BBWAA and by the Twins Community Fund Board of Directors.
