THE TWINS: Have gone 0-4 through four games on their current homestand, going 0-2 vs. Cleveland and 0-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL...they will play the three-game series finale this afternoon against the Dodgers...after today's game, they will travel to Detroit for four games from tomorrow-Sunday, then to Baltimore for three games from April 15-17.

THREE-RUN JIMMY JACKS CRUSH VARLAND: The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3...Louie Varland (0-2) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, including two three-run homers from Will Smith and James Outman...Cole Sands pitched 2.0 scoreless inning of relief, striking out four of his eight batters faced...the offense recorded six hits, struck out 15 times, did not draw a walk and went 0-for-3 with runners in scoring position...Minnesota scored their three runs on solo home runs from Ryan Jeffers in the eighth inning, and Carlos Correa and Alex Kirilloff (back-to-back) in the ninth inning...Austin Martin recorded his first career hit with a third-inning double...he followed that with another double in his next at-bat in the sixth inning...according to Elias, he is the first Twin to start his career with consecutive doubles since Trevor Larnach did it from May 12-13, 2021.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 378 career managerial wins, one away from passing Gene Mauch and moving into fifth place on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

INGLEWOOD ALWAYS UP TO NO GOOD: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 23rd, 24th and 25th time in their history this week...the Twins are 7-17 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 2-9 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 2-8 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome...the Twins .292 winning percentage against LA is their lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961).

Byron Buxton has hit safely in six-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs, four RBI, two walks, a .407 on-base percentage, a .680 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 1-3 in Interleague Play this season and going 25-21 in IL Play in 2023...their only two series this season were a two-gamer in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1) and this series vs. Los Angeles-NL (0-2)...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Nationals in D.C. for three games from May 20-22.

KIRILL-OFF THE CHARTS: Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in eight of his nine games played, his only hitless game coming in an 0-for-1 pinch-hitting appearance on Monday night...on the season, he is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with a .400 on-base percentage, a .710 slugging percentage and a 1.110 OPS...he enters today fourth in the AL in OPS, trailing Tyler O'Neil (1.394), Mike Trout (1.150) and MJ Melendez (1.148).

RISPY BUSINESS: Twins hitters are batting .117 (9-for-77) with runners in scoring position, the lowest in baseball...they enter today 0-for-their-last-29 with RISP, seeking their first hit since a Ryan Jeffers single in the top of the ninth on April 3 at Milwaukee...individually, Carlos Correa is 3-for-8 (.375) with RISP and Byron Buxton is 3-for-9 (.333).

YOU GIVE LOVE A BAD NAME: Carlos Correa has reached base safely 17 times (9 hits, 8 walks) in 38 plate appearances this season, including 13 times (7 walks, 6 hits) in his last six games (26 plate appearances)...he ranks third in the AL in on-base percentage (.447), trailing Tyler O'Neil (.488) and Juan Soto (.456)...additionally, he ranks tied for fourth in walks (8).

TENACIOUS D: The Twins defense has committed just two errors on the season — a Kody Funderburk fielding error on March 31 at Kansas City and a Carlos Correa fielding error on April 4 vs. Cleveland...they are tied with Atlanta for fewest errors in baseball this season...additionally, as a team, the Twins rank fifth in baseball in defensive runs above average (3.9).

HOME SICK: Twins are looking to win their first game at Target Field, starting the season 0-4 for the first time in the Target Field Era...this marks the third time in their history to lose their first four home games, also done in 1981 (0-4) and 1962 (0-5)...their last regular season win here came on September 27, 2023 vs. Oakland.

THE MOR YOU NEAU: Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau played in 29 career games against the Dodgers, hitting .346 (36-for-104) with nine doubles, three triples, three home runs, 19 RBI, a .577 slugging percentage and a .963 OPS...one of his five six-plus RBI games came against the Dodgers on September 17, 2014 at Coors Field as a Rockies...the .346 batting average was the highest of his career against any opponent.

THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 1982, the Twins acquired reliever Ron Davis and minor leaguers Greg Gagne and Paul Boris from New York-AL, in exchange for infielder Roy Smalley and pitcher Gary Serum...Davis ranks fifth on Twins all-time saves list with 108 while Gagne was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame in 2010.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY! LOOK AT THIS JERSEY!: Happy birthday to MLB.com's Do-Hyung Park...Do celebrated his birthday a day early last night by spotting a white pinstriped Terry Steinbach game-issued Fourth of July jersey (circa 2013)...also born on this day (in 1880) was Senators catcher/first baseman Cliff Blankenship — who was one of Do's favorite pitchers.

- ⚡ Has faced Los Angeles-NL seven times in his career, once with Minnesota...has gone 1-4 with a 7.03 ERA (32.0 IP, 25 ER), six walks and 28 strikeouts vs. Dodgers.

BACK ON THE BUMP: Made season debut – and first start since May 8, 2022 – on April 3 at Milwaukee... allowed two runs on six hits in 4.0 innings with two walks and two strikeouts...yielded sacrifice fly to Brice Turang in second inning, solo home run to Rhys Hoskins in the fourth...didn't factor into decision as Minnesota staged late comeback and won 7-3...57.3 strike percentage was his lowest in a start since May 9, 2021 at San Francisco (56.6%).

SPRING RECAP: Made four 2024 Grapefruit League starts, posting a 4.73 ERA (13.1 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 10 strikeouts...concluded his spring training on March 23 vs. Boston, allowing three runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings with five strikeouts.

DODGING THE SHERIFF: Has gone 1-4 with a 7.03 ERA (32.0 IP, 25 ER), six walks and 28 strikeouts in seven career starts vs. Los Angeles-NL...four losses are his most vs. any opponent in his career; has only made more starts or thrown more innings vs. Arizona (9 GS, 44.2 IP)...Dodgers batters have hit .272 (34-for-125) with an .889 OPS, 13 doubles and eight home runs off Paddack...faced Dodgers in Minnesota debut April 13, 2022, allowing three runs in 4.0-inning defeat...earned only win vs. Dodgers on August 3, 2020, allowing three runs in 6.0 innings; was also his only quality start vs. the Dodgers, to date.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since joining Minnesota in 2022, has gone 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER), two walks and 17 strikeouts at Target Field, compared to 2-1 with a 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), three walks and 13 strikeouts on the road...in his career (2019-24), has a 4.43 ERA with 9.41 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings-pitched and a 5.09 strikeout-to-walk ratio in home appearances, compared to a 4.03 ERA, 8.66 K/9 and 4.65 K/BB on the road.

- ⚡ During Minnesota tenure, Paddack has surrendered a .442 batting average on balls in play (BABIP) at Target Field, compared to a .308 BABIP on the road.
- ⚡ Last regular season appearance at Target Field came September 26, 2023, when he allowed three runs in 2.0 innings of relief vs. Oakland...was his first big league action in return from second Tommy John surgery.

PLATOON SPLITS: On April 3 in Milwaukee, right-handed hitters went 3-for-5, lefties 3-for-10 with a home run...during Paddack's Minnesota tenure (2022-24), right-handed hitters have hit .275 (22-for-80) with a .685 OPS and 19 strikeouts, while lefties have hit .341 (15-for-44) with an .871 OPS and 11 strikeouts...in Paddack's career, righties have hit .257 (169-for-657) with a .739 OPS, 40.0 hard-hit percentage and an average exit velocity of 89.4 mph, while lefties have hit .232 (150-for-647) with a .692 OPS, 40.1 hard-hit percentage and 89.0 mph average exit velocity.

THE ARSENAL: Threw four-pitch mix April 3 at Milwaukee...used slider, which he worked to improve during the offseason and spring training, exclusively vs. right-handed hitters...here's a breakdown of his repertoire from that first start:

- ⚡ Has thrown more than 26-percent changeups each season since 2019 debut...pitch had 92nd-percentile run value among MLB offspeed pitches in 2019 and 99th percentile in 2020.
- ⚡ On April 3, changeup averaged 35 inches of vertical movement, compared to 31.8-inch average in 2023 regular season return from Tommy John surgery...pitch consistently averaged 32 inches of vertical movement or less prior to surgery.
- ⚡ Curveball velocity compares to 76.0-mph average in 2022 pre-surgery starts.

NO EASING INTO THIS ONE: In his career, Paddack has allowed 10 home runs to leadoff hitters, tied for the most by any lineup spot...leadoff hitters have hit .247 (43-for-174) with a .750 OPS vs. Paddack...Mookie Betts, Los Angeles-NL's leadoff hitter, has gone 5-for-6 with a home run and four RBI in his career vs. Paddack.

- ⚡ Each of the Dodgers' first three hitters – Betts, Shohei Ohtani and Freddie Freeman – boasts an .875-or-better OPS in 2024.

WELL-RESTED: Makes today's start on six days' rest...in his career, has posted a 3.89 ERA (113.1 IP, 49 ER) on six-or-more days' rest, compared to a 5.68 ERA (65.0 IP, 41 ER) on four days' rest...made five starts with Minnesota in 2022, each with five-or-more days' rest.

2023 NOTES:

- ⚡ Signed three-year contract extension on January 18.
- ⚡ On 60-day Injured List from February 23 to September 24, rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in May 2022.
- ⚡ Allowed four earned runs in 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts in three-game rehab assignment.
- ⚡ Returned September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL...exited the bullpen and as he was approaching the infield dirt, umpires called for the tarp...didn't return after 50-minute rain delay.
- ⚡ Made official return to major league mound on September 25 vs. Oakland...first major league appearance in 507 days...threw fastest pitch of career, a 99 mph four-seam fastball to Zack Gelof in the top of the sixth inning.
- ⚡ Included on American League Wild Card Series roster but didn't appear in two-game sweep of Toronto.
- ⚡ Made relief appearances in Games 1 and 4 of American League Division Series vs. Houston, allowing one baserunner and striking out six in 3.2 total innings...both no-decisions in Twins losses.

CAREER NOTES

- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
- In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
- As a rookie in 2019, posted career-bests in wins (9), ERA (3.33), innings (140.2) and strikeouts (153)...named to *Baseball America's* Major League All-Rookie Team.
- Made major league debut March 31, 2019 vs. San Francisco, yielding one run on two hits and striking out seven in 5.0-inning no-decision.
- Entering 2019, was ranked Padres' No. 4 prospect by ESPN.com, No. 5 by MLB Pipeline and No. 6 by *Baseball America*.
- Missed entire 2017 season rehabbing from first Tommy John surgery in August of 2016.
