THE TWINS: The Twins began their 64th season with a three-game series victory at Kauffman Stadium, winning on Thursday and Saturday and dropping the series finale on Sunday afternoon...this afternoon, the Twins will begin a two-game series at American Family Field and travel home after tomorrow afternoon's game...starting on Thursday, Minnesota will open its 15th season at Target Field with three against the Cleveland Guardians (April 4, 6-7) and three against the Los Angeles Dodgers (April 8-10).
 ☞ Today marks the fourth day game for the Twins...15 of the first 21 games on the schedule for Minnesota are day games...the Twins went 34-35 in day games in 2023.

OBBER AND OUT OF KANSAS CITY: The Twins were shutout by the Royals on Sunday afternoon by a score of 11-0...it marked Minnesota's largest margin of defeat in a shutout since a 13-0 loss on September 3, 2022 at Chicago-AL...Bailey Ober (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing a career-high nine runs (8 earned) on nine hits (3 HR) in a career-low 1.1 innings pitched...Kody Funderburk, Daniel Duarte, Cole Sands and Jay Jackson all made their season debuts pitching in relief...the offense recorded just four hits, three being doubles by Alex Kirilloff, Matt Wallner and Carlos Santana.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 377 career managerial wins, one away from tying Gene Mauch for fourth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins and Brewers are playing the first of four scheduled games this season...Minnesota will host the Brewers for two games coming out of the All-Star break from July 20-21...Minnesota went 2-2 against Milwaukee last season, going 2-0 at Target Field from June 13-14 and 0-2 at American Family Field from August 22-23...the Twins' last victory in Milwaukee was April 4, 2021, looking to snap a four-game losing streak here.

☞ The Twins are 242-233 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 69-59 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998.

☞ Since the start of 2016, the Twins have scored 5.16 runs-per-game at Milwaukee, their second best in an NL park (min. 8 games), behind only Wrigley Field (6.38 in 8 games).

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with four doubles, one triple, five RBI, five walks and a .919 OPS in his last 12 games vs. the Brewers.

☞ Carlos Santana began his 2023 season with Pittsburgh and was acquired by Milwaukee at the trade deadline, in exchange for minor league infielder Jhonny Severino...Santana played in 52 games for the Brewers, hitting .249 (51-for-205) with eight doubles, 11 home runs, 33 RBI, 33 runs scored and a .773 OPS.

☞ Today's starter, Louie Varland, is the younger brother of former Brewers pitcher Gus Varland...Gus made his major league debut for Milwaukee on March 30, 2023...he pitched in eight games for the Brewers last season and was returned to the Dodgers via Rule 5 Draft in May...Gus appeared in one game for the Dodgers this season in Seoul, Korea; he is currently in the bullpen for Triple-A Oklahoma City.

MILWAUKEE BUX: Byron Buxton is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.227 OPS in 11 career games at American Family Field...the OPS is his highest at any ballpark (minimum of 40 PA)...he has homered five times in his last six games here.

CREAM CITY CRUSH: Since the start of 2014, the Twins have hit 39 home runs in 24 games at Milwaukee, the best among AL teams and more than six NL clubs in that span (Colorado - 38, Miami - 37, Atlanta - 35, Arizona - 34, New York - 27 and Washington - 24)...Minnesota has homered in 13-straight games at American Family Field, hitting 25 in that span...it's the fifth-longest streak in an opposing ballpark for the Twins (since 1961) and second-longest active.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins went 25-21 in Interleague Play in 2023 - which marked the first season under MLB's new scheduling format (playing all 29 other teams)...Minnesota went 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona, 2-1 at Philadelphia, 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 0-2 at Milwaukee, 2-1 vs. New York-NL, 2-1 at Cincinnati and 2-1 at Colorado.

☞ Max Kepler has 22 career Interleague home runs, tied with Joe Mauer for third most in club history, trailing Torii Hunter (33) and Eddie Rosario (23).

POWER OUTAGE: The Twins have hit just one home run in 117 plate appearances, the only homer being a Royce Lewis first inning shot on Opening Day...Minnesota has the fewest home runs in baseball, ahead of St. Louis, Milwaukee and Oakland - all with two...they had just two home runs through their first three games to start 2023, then hit four in the series opener at Miami.

☞ The Twins finished the 2023 season with 233 home runs, tied with Texas for third-most in baseball, trailing only the Braves (307) and Dodgers (249).

ON THIS DAY: In 2010, the Twins opened Target Field with a "dry-run" exhibition game against the St. Louis Cardinals, losing by a score of 8-4...the game was played in front of 32,995...they completed their spring training season with another against the Cards on April 3.

SPRING RECAP: Made six appearances (5 starts) in the Grapefruit League...in the six appearances, Varland went 1-1, 7.00 ERA (19.0 IP, 14 ER), 19 hits, four walks and 14 strikeouts...last spring outing came on March 26 vs. the Atlanta Braves, where he totaled 5.0 innings, six earned runs, seven hits, five strikeouts and a pair of home runs to Jarrod Kelenic and Orlando Arcia.

LAST START OF 2023: Took a loss in the series finale June 18 vs. Detroit; pitched a season-low 4.1 innings after pitching a season low in the previous start against the Blue Jays (4.2 IP)...gave up one run in the first inning to Javier Báez on a triple and pitched in three scoreless innings in the second, third and fourth...allowed five runs in the fifth inning, highlighted by home runs by Spencer Torkelson and Kerry Carpenter...was relieved by Jordan Balazovic in the fifth inning.

☞ Shortest start of the season, previous low was 4.2 IP on June 11 vs. the Toronto Blue Jays and May 3 vs. the Chicago White Sox.

BULLPEN GEM: Moved to the bullpen starting on September 6th after being called up from Triple-A St. Paul Saints on September 4th...Twins went on to win five out of the seven appearances he made in the month...pitched to a 1-0 record, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 17 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts and two holds.

☞ Began September with a ERA of 5.03 and ended the season with 4.63...batters hit .150 with a .191 BABIP and slugged .300...recorded two holds in the Postseason in back-to-back games vs. the Blue Jays pitching 0.2 innings with two hits, zero runs and one strikeout in the two appearances.

DEBUT VS. BREWERS: Facing the Brewers for the first time in career...has started vs. the NL Central one time his career, vs. Chicago-NL on May 14, 2023, logging 6.1 innings, with three earned runs, four hits, one walk and seven strikeouts and picking up his first victory of the year in a 16-3 win.

☞ Louie is the younger brother of former Brewers pitcher Gus Varland...Gus made his major league debut for Milwaukee on March 30, 2023...he pitched in eight games for the Brewers last season and was returned to the Dodgers via Rule 5 Draft in May...Gus appeared in one game for the Dodgers this season in Seoul, Korea; he is currently in the bullpen for Triple-A Oklahoma City.

ON THE ROAD: After making six starts on the road in 2023, he is set to make his 2024 debut...in 2023 on the road he went 2-1 4.70 ERA (38.1 IP, 20 ER) 12 walks and 40 strikeouts...last road game started at Toronto (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 ER)...tied with GS on May 3 for the shortest start of his career.

☞ Through nine starts on the road in his career, Varland is 3-2, 4.36 ERA (53.2 IP, 26 ER) with 15 walks, 55 strikeouts and opponent batting average of .256...has made two appearances out of the bullpen in his career on the road: September 6 vs. Cleveland, ND (3.0 IP, 0 ER) zero walks, two strikeouts and faced 11 batters...second appearance was on September 15 vs. Chicago-AL, ND (2.0 IP, 0 ER) one hit, no walks, four strikeouts and seven batters faced.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Across 17 appearances in 2023 season, left-handed hitters batted .209 (19-for-91) with 28 strikeouts against Varland...righties hit .275 (47-for-171) with 43 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .243/.289/.430 with four home runs and 27 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .264/.316/.492 with 12 home runs and 44 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland used a five-pitch mix in his 17 appearances in the 2023 season, including a 4-seam fastball, cutter, slider and changeup, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and cutter for 76 of his 89 pitches (85.4%) in his last start of the 2023 season vs. Detroit on June 18...below is a look at his 2023 repertoire:

☞ Averaged 10.6 inches of horizontal movement on his slider last season, the third-most slider horizontal movement on the Twins staff in 2023, according to Baseball Savant (José De León - 14.2, Bailey Ober - 10.9).

- ☞ Pitched in first career spring training with Twins and was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on March 19, where he started the season.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the week on April 30-the first of two honors on season.
- ☞ Earned first win of the season on May 14 vs. Chicago-NL, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched leading to 16-3 victory.
- ☞ Went 3-1, 3.34 ERA (35.0 IP, 13 ER) with seven walks and 31 strikeouts in six May starts for Minnesota, leading the staff in innings for the month.
- ☞ Went 0-2, 10.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 17 ER) with five home runs allowed and eight walks in a three-start stretch from June 6-18 and was optioned to St. Paul on June 20 (Kenta Maeda reinstated from IL).
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the week on August 13...pitched a professional career high 7.1 innings on August 11 vs. Louisville, allowing three hits with one walk and six strikeouts.
- ☞ Recalled by Minnesota on September 4, where he remained the rest of the season, pitching out of the Twins' bullpen.
- ☞ Appeared in both games in the ALCWS vs. Toronto, pitching 0.1 in game 1, holding a 3-1 lead...appeared in Game 2, throwing another 0.1 inning, holding a 2-0 lead...was on the ALDS roster vs. Houston but did not appear in the series.
