**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their current seven-game homestand, going 1-2 against Detroit over the weekend, followed by a victory over Chicago-AL last night...tonight, Minnesota will host the White Sox for the second of four games...after the series finale on Thursday afternoon, the Twins will travel to Anaheim to begin a six-game roadtrip with three games at Angel Stadium over the weekend and three games at Guaranteed Rate Field next Monday-Wednesday.

**PADDACK GOT THAT DOG IN HIM:** The Twins shut out the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 7-0, recording their first shutout of the season, first night game win and third win at Target Field of 2024...Chris Paddack (1-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with six hits allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts — one short of his career high...it marked Paddack's first big league win as a starter since May 2, 2022 at Baltimore...the offense tied their season high with 11 hits, three coming from Edouard Julien, who hit a double and his team-leading fifth home run...Max Kepler returned from the IL and went 2-for-4 with a double and three RBI.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins went 9-4 against the Sox last season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 4-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Minnesota started 2-3 in their first five against the Sox, then went 7-1 in their final eight.

- ☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 88-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.
- ☞ The Twins have beat the Sox 71 times (53 losses) at Target Field (since 2010), second most against any opponent (Kansas City - 72).
- ☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .329 (27-for-82) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and an .873 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 15 games against Chicago.
- ☞ Carlos Santana is the all-time leader among actives in walks (113) and games (181) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (88), and third in hits (147), home runs (24) and RBI (78).
- ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .347 (33-for-95) with five doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 23 RBI, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.215 OPS in his last 25 games against the Sox...last season, Buck hit four home runs vs. Chicago.
- ☞ Christian Vázquez is hitting .317 (40-for-126) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .368 on-base percentage and a .764 OPS in 40 career games vs. the Sox.

**ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EARS:** Due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Suns), tonight's Twins-White Sox game will be broadcast on Bally Sports North Extra.

**MAPLE LEAF POWER:** Edouard Julien has hit safely in a season-long three-straight games, going 5-for-12 (.417) with a 1.255 OPS in that span...in his last 12 games, since April 10, he has slashed .279/.367/.605 (.972 OPS) with two doubles, four home runs, six RBI and six walks...in his first nine games, he slashed .107/.194/.250 (.444).

- ☞ He is tied with Jose Altuve for first in home runs among all MLB second basemen.
- ☞ He ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball in barrel percentage at 15.9%.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1980, Angels pitcher Bruce Kison settled for a one-hitter when Minnesota's Ken Landreaux hit a ninth-inning double in a California 17-0 win...for Landreaux, the hit marked the beginning of a 31-game hitting streak, the longest in Twins history.

- Henriquez tossed a scoreless 8th and 9th inn. allowing just 2 H w/ 1 BB and 2 K in yesterday's win vs. CWS.
\*Pen went 4-2, 1.62 ERA (44.1 IP, 8 ER) w/ 19 BB, 43 K, 6 HLD and 2 SV in 13 G vs. CWS last season...went 3-0 0.84 ERA (21.1 IP, 2 ER) w/ 6 BB, 20 K, 6 HLD and 2 SV in 6 home games.
Twins have selected the contract of RHP Ronny Henriquez yesterday...transferred RHP Danilo Duarte to 60-day IL and is scheduled to have surgery on his right elbow on May 8 & will not pitch again in 2024.
Twins currently have 2 notable relievers and high leverage arms on IL: Jhoan Duran (right oblique strain) and Justin Topa (left patellar tendinitis) placed on 3/28.
After posting a 0.98 ERA in first 7 G, 'pen now owns a 2.77 ERA (78.0 IP, 24 ER) 4th best in baseball...is third in runs allowed (27) and fifth in xBA (.213) in all baseball.
