**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 4-2 through six games on their current seven-game homestand, going 1-2 against Detroit over the weekend, followed by three consecutive victories over Chicago-AL the last three nights...today, Minnesota will host the White Sox for the homestand and series finale...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Anaheim to begin a six-game roadtrip with three games at Angel Stadium over the weekend, followed by three games at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ The Twins are looking to win four-straight for the first time since July 21-24, 2023, when they took three from the White Sox and one from the Mariners.

**OFFENSE PUTS UP SOME SOCK:** The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 6-3, securing their second series win of the season...Joe Ryan (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on four hits (2 home runs - Pillar and Lee) in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded a season-high 13 hits, led by Christian Vázquez, who went 3-for-4 with one RBI...Willi Castro celebrated his 27th birthday with his second home run of the season.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson from Triple-A St. Paul...Woods Richardson, who was appointed as the 27th man for the doubleheader on April 13 at Detroit, made the start that day for the Twins, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts, while earning his first major league victory...since that start with Minnesota, he has made one start for the Saints on April 19 at Indianapolis, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...to make room for Woods Richardson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez to Triple-A St. Paul...Henriquez made one appearance for the Twins, pitching 2.0 shutout innings of relief with two hits allowed, one walk and two strikeouts on Monday night against the White Sox.

**WEARING OUT THE SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the fourth of 13 games this season...after this series, they will play three games at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday...Minnesota has gone 10-1 in their last 11 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 90-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

☞ The Twins have beaten the Sox 73 times (53 losses) at Target Field (since 2010), their most against any opponent at this ballpark.

☞ Carlos Santana is the all-time leader among actives in walks (115) and games (183) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (89), and third in hits (148), home runs (24) and RBI (79).

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .359 (37-for-103) with six doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 24 RBI, an .816 slugging percentage and a 1.242 OPS in his last 27 games against the Sox...since the start of last season, Buck has hit five home runs in 11 games (9 RBI).

☞ Since the start of last season, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with a 1.062 OPS in 10 games vs. the White Sox...he has hit safely in seven straight vs. Chicago.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in seven-straight against the Sox, hitting .370 (10-for-27) with four doubles, six RBI and a .932 OPS in that span.

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .322 (28-for-87) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI and an .846 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 16 runs in his last 16 games against Chicago.

**"WE USE MAINLY BATS...THE GOOD QUALITY KIND":** Through the first three games of this series, the Twins are hitting .321 (34-for-106) with 12 doubles, four home runs, a .368 on-base percentage, a .547 slugging percentage and a .916 OPS...they have recorded double-digit hit totals in all three games and have scored a total of 19 runs (6.3 runs-per-game).

**SWEEPS WEEK:** Minnesota is seeking its first sweep of the season today...last season the Twins swept opponents six times, five in three games and one in two games...they swept the White Sox one time in 2023, from July 21-23 in three games at Target Field.

☞ The Twins failed in their only opportunity to sweep an opponent this season...they entered the three-game series finale against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium on March 31 up two games to none and lost the finale 11-0.

☞ Their last four-game sweep of an opponent came July 8-11, 2021 vs. Detroit at Target Field...their last sweep of the White Sox in four games came September 28-30, 2018.

☞ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the White Sox nine times...they have only swept the Royals more in that span (12).

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** Trevor Larnach has hit safely in five of seven games and reached safely via hit or walk in six of seven games...in his last three games, he has reached six times (3 hits, 3 walks) in 11 plate appearances, while striking out just twice...since his recall on April 16, he ranks sixth in the AL in OPS (1.167) and seventh in slugging percentage (.750).

**MAPLE LEAF POWER:** In his last 12 games, since April 10, Edouard Julien has slashed .250/.357/.542 (.899 OPS) with two doubles, four home runs, six RBI and seven walks...in his first nine games, he slashed .107/.194/.250 (.444 OPS).

☞ He ranks second among all MLB second basemen in home runs (5), trailing only Jose Altuve (6).

☞ He ranks in the 90th percentile in baseball in barrel percentage at 14.9%.

**RIP, AL SHAVER:** Legendary Minnesota sports broadcaster Al Shaver passed away on Monday at age 96 in Vancouver Island, British Columbia...Shaver was on the Twins' WCCO radio broadcast team in 1970 with Herb Carneal, Ray Christensen and Halsey Hall.

**LAST TIME OUT IN THE BIGS:** Was recalled as the 27th man for the doubleheader on April 13...made his second career start at Detroit in Game 2 of that day, picking up his first major league win and first quality start...opposite Tigers starter Matt Manning, Woods Richardson allowed two hits, one run, one walk and five strikeouts...threw an MLB career-high 6.0 innings and matched his MLB career high with five strikeouts (April 22, 2023 vs. Washington)...allowed two hits in the second inning and then retired 12-straight batter...the one run given up was on a second-inning sac fly by Javier Báez.

**LAST MINOR LEAGUE BUMP DAY:** Most recent start with Triple-A St. Paul came April 19 at Indianapolis...took second no-decision of the season, allowing six hits, two runs, one walk, four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...also threw a season-high 91 pitches...all three Triple-A starts this season have come on the road.

**WELCOME TO TARGET FIELD:** Has made one appearance at Target Field in his career, which came on April 22, 2023 against the Washington Nationals...entered in relief for Pablo López and did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits (1 HR), three walks and five strikeouts...in 2023, Woods Richardson made 13 home appearances (12 starts) with Triple-A St. Paul, he went 4-3 with a 6.48 ERA (58.1 IP, 42 ER), 64 hits, 11 home runs, 33 walks, 49 strikeouts with a 1.66 WHIP and an opponent batting average of .278 (64-for-230).

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** Through three Triple-A starts in 2024, right-handed hitters have hit .267 (8-for-30) vs. Woods Richardson with a .700 OPS, while lefties have hit .348 (8-for-23) with a .858 OPS...conversely, in 25 games last season, righties hit .297 (69-for-232) with an .874 OPS vs. Woods Richardson, compared to lefties' .215 average (47-for-219) with a .677 OPS...in one major league start this year righties went 0-for-11 (.000) with two strikeouts, while left-handed hitters went 2-for-8 (.250), with one walk and three strikeouts...in his major league career, left-handed hitters are hitting .231 (6-for-26) with one home run, four walks and seven strikeouts and a .679 OPS...righties are hitting .194 (6-for-31) with two doubles, one home run, two walks and six strikeouts and a .590 OPS.

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson used a four-pitch mix in his first start this season at Detroit...leaned on his 4-seam fastball and slider the most, combining to throw the two pitches 75.0 percent of the time in that start...here is his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

**2023 NOTES:**

- Pitched in Twins spring training for first time in career and optioned to Triple-A on March 11.
- Made two starts for Saints from April 9-15 and was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made one relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- Optioned back to St. Paul one day later on April 23.
- Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings on April 28 at Rochester.
