THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2 (1-2 against the Tigers and 4-0 against the White Sox), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a victory over the Angels in Anaheim last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Angel Stadium...after tomorrow afternoon's game, they will travel to Chicago to play the White Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

- Minnesota's five-game winning streak is their longest since August 3-7, 2023, when they beat St. Louis once, Arizona three times and Detroit once.
- The Twins are looking to win six-straight for the first time since May 18-24, 2022, when they beat Oakland once, Kansas City three times, then Detroit twice.
- A win tonight would get the Twins back to .500 for the first time since being 3-3 through their game on April 4.

OBERTIME HITS ANAHEIM: The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 5-3...Bailey Ober (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 7.1 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts...he carried a no-hitter through five innings, until a Luis Rengifo leadoff single in the sixth...Matt Bowman pitched 1.1 relief innings for a hold as Caleb Thielbar pitched 0.1 inning to earn his second career save...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Willi Castro...Carlos Santana hit his second home run in as many games as the run scored marked the 1,000th of his career...he became the ninth active player to reach the mark.

I JUST WANNA GO FAST: The Twins saw just 33 fastballs last night, their fewest all season...Minnesota has seen 1,859 fastballs this season, the fewest in baseball...additionally, they have seen the fifth-most breaking pitches in baseball (1,290)...they have a .454 slugging percentage off fastballs in 2024, fourth-best in baseball, trailing Atlanta (.469), Baltimore (.458) and Arizona (.457)...additionally, their .348 wOBA vs. fastballs ranks eight in baseball.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: Over the current five-game winning streak, the Twins have hit .314 (.55-for-175) with 16 doubles, 10 home runs, a .365 on-base percentage, a .577 slugging percentage and a .942 OPS...they recorded double-digit hit totals in all five games and scored a total of 30 runs (6.0 runs-per-game).

- The previous time the Twins had double-digit hit totals in five-straight games was May 26-30, 2022...the last time they did it in six-straight was August 28-September 2, 2019.
- Over the last five games, the Twins have a run differential of +16 (30-14)...prior to the five-game winning streak their run differential was at -25 (67-92).

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins and Angels are playing the second of six games this season...these two will meet for three game at Target Field from September 9-11...Twins are just 8-12 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including a record of 4-6 in Anaheim in that span.

- Max Kepler owns an .861 OPS in 37 career games against Los Angeles-AL, hitting .270 (.33-for-122) with five doubles, seven home runs, 14 RBI, 18 walks, 24 runs scored and a .484 slugging percentage...since 2019, he has an OBP of .432 at Angel Stadium (6 walks, 10 hits in 37 PA).

- Willi Castro has hit safely in his last 14 games vs. the Angels since August 17, 2021, batting .327 (18-for-55) with five doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, 10 runs scored and a .991 OPS in that span...it marks Castro's longest of his career against any opponent...he also has a seven-game hitting streak in Angel Stadium.

- Kyle Farmer is hitting .393 (11-for-28) with two walks, a .452 on-base percentage and an .880 OPS in eight career games vs. the Angels.

- Carlos Santana has five home runs and 13 RBI in his last eight games at Angel Stadium.
- Alex Kirilloff is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with two home runs and six RBI in six games here.

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins are looking for their third series win this season...their two series wins came to open the season at Kansas City and their other was this past week against Chicago-AL (full list to the lower right).

- Their last series win against the Angels came September 22-24, 2023, taking two of three...their last series win in Anaheim came May 20-23, 2019 as the Twins swept in three.
- Twins are looking for consecutive series wins for the first time since winning each of their last five series of 2023.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has hit safely in six of eight games and reached safely via hit or walk in seven of eight games...in his last four games, he has reached base eight times (5 hits, 3 walks) in 15 plate appearances, while striking out just three times...since his recall on April 16, he ranks seventh in the AL in OPS (1.137) and tied for seventh in slugging percentage (.708).

RUN THE JULS: In his last 16 games since April 10, Edouard Julien has slashed .283/.387/.679 (1.066 OPS) with three doubles, six home runs, eight RBI and eight walks...in his first nine games, he slashed .107/.194/.250 (.444 OPS).

- He leads all MLB second basemen in home runs (7)...Jose Altuve is next with six.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .353 (18-for-51) with five doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, nine runs scored, four walks, a .424 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.051 OPS in his last 16 games, since April 9...since that date, he ranks seventh in the AL in OPS.

BALLY MIC DROPS: Angels related notes on BSN broadcasters LaTroy Hawkins and Trevor Plouffe:

- Hawkins spent 2012 with the Angels, going 2-3, 3.64 ERA (42.0 IP, 17 ER) with one save, 13 walks and 23 strikeouts...Hawk appeared in 36 career games at Angel Stadium, 13 as an opponent...his first victory here came on May 23, 1998 in a Twins 9-5 victory as Hawk allowed five runs on six hits in 6.2 innings pitched...his first save in this ballpark came on June 12, 2004 as a member of the Cubs, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings.

- Hometown boy Trevor Plouffe homered in his second career game at Angel Stadium on September 2, 2011, a solo shot off Tyler Chatwood...it was the first of three home runs in this ballpark, the other two came in back-to-back games here on July 23, 2015 (off Garrett Richards) and June 13, 2016 (off Jered Weaver).

- ⌚ Making fifth start of season, 10th with Minnesota and 70th of career...last pitched April 22 vs. Chicago-AL, throwing 7.0 shutout innings with six hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts in the Twins 7-0 win...earned his first win of the season and first as a starter since May 2, 2022 in Baltimore...threw 96 pitches, his most in a game since September 11, 2021 at Dodger Stadium (also 96).
- ⌚ Has yet to face Los Angeles-AL in his career...among active Angels hitters, Paddack has only faced Brandon Drury (0-for-3, 1 K).

- SHERIFF'S IN CHARGE:** Last pitched April 22 vs. Chicago-AL, opposite Jonathan Cannon, and earned his first win of the season in the Twins 7-0 shutout victory...threw 7.0 shutout innings with six hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts – his third career double-digit strikeout game...retired first 10 batters before allowing three-straight singles in the fourth; escaped bases-loaded jam with a lineup and a strikeout.
- ⌚ Threw 96 pitches, his most in a start since September 11, 2021 at Dodger Stadium (also 96)...most innings in a start since July 2, 2021 at Philadelphia (also 7.0).
 - ⌚ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...White Sox hitters went 3-for-7 on those balls.
 - ⌚ Generated a season-high 16 whiffs on 49 swings (32.7%)...improved 2024 whiff rate to 22.1 percent.
 - ⌚ First quality start since September 9, 2021 vs. Houston...first scoreless quality start since September 18, 2020 vs. Seattle.
 - ⌚ Sixth career start of 7.0-or-more innings; third of 7.0-or-more scoreless innings.

- TWO STARTS AGO:** Took his first loss of the season April 16 in Baltimore...allowed nine runs on 12 hits – both career highs – in 5.1 innings, walking one and striking out two as the Twins lost, 11-3...yielded two-run home runs to Gunnar Henderson in the second inning and Jordan Westburg in the third...exited with one out in the sixth and Adley Rutschman on third; Caleb Thielbar entered and allowed a single that scored Paddack's ninth run.
- ⌚ 13 of 26 batted balls were hard-hit (95.0+ mph)...seven of the 13 went for base hits...also allowed a 410-foot Ryan O'Hearn flyout (104.0 mph) that would've been a home run in 16 of 30 ballparks.
 - ⌚ Both home runs came against sliders.

- UNFAMILIAR WITH THE ANGELS:** Has never pitched against Los Angeles-AL in his career...officially entered in relief vs. Angels on September 24, 2023 – his first game back from Tommy John surgery – but didn't throw a pitch due to a rain delay...has faced one current Angels hitter, Brandon Drury, who went 0-for-3 with a strikeout in June 2021.
- ⌚ Has made 11 career appearances (10 starts) vs. AL West opponents; has gone 4-2 with a 4.42 ERA (55.0 IP, 27 ER), 12 walks and 53 strikeouts.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Has made two starts on the road and two at Target Field this season...has gone 0-1 with a 10.61 ERA (9.1 IP, 11 ER), .419 opponent batting average and 2.89 home-runs-per-9.0-innings on the road (at Milwaukee and Baltimore), compared to 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER), .255 BAA and 0.77 HR/9 at home (vs. Los Angeles-NL and Chicago-AL).

- PLATOON SPLITS:** On April 22, Chicago-AL's left-handed hitters went 3-for-12 with four strikeouts vs. Paddack, while righties went 3-for-15 with six strikeouts...through four games vs. Paddack this season, left-handed hitters have hit .362 (17-for-47) with an .893 OPS, 14.3 percent whiff rate and 11.5 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .302 (13-for-43) with an .822 OPS, 29.5 percent whiff rate and 28.9 percent strikeout rate.
- ⌚ Has allowed four home runs: two by lefties and two by righties.
 - ⌚ Facing right-handed pitching, the Angels' lefties have hit .189 (44-for-233) with a .508 OPS and 25.9 percent strikeout rate, while their righties have hit .252 (131-for-519) with a .750 OPS and 24.5 percent strikeout rate.

- THE ARSENAL:** Has thrown a four-pitch mix through four starts, per Baseball Savant...for all four pitches, expected batting averages are slightly lower than the actual figures this season...here's his pitch usage thus far in 2024:

- ⌚ On April 22 vs. Chicago-AL, threw a season-high 44 fastballs and season-low 11 curveballs.
 - ⌚ Against White Sox, 4-seamer generated nine whiffs on 26 swings (34.6%)...pitch now has a 24.7 percent whiff rate in 2024.
 - ⌚ Paddack's changeup has allowed a .552 slugging percentage, the fifth highest in baseball (min. 25 PA)...its .622 expected slugging percentage is the highest in baseball.

- STRIKE THROWER:** April 22 vs. Chicago-AL was Paddack's seventh career start with 6.0-or-more innings and no walks...his 5.2 percent walk rate this season ranks in MLB's 82nd percentile...Paddack's 1.8 walks-per-9.0-innings since the beginning of 2019 – his debut season – is tied for seventh best in baseball during that span (min. 50 starts)...has walked two-or-fewer batters in 30-straight starts, dating back to April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona.
- ⌚ Tied with Logan Webb for the third-longest active streak of starts with two-or-fewer walks, trailing Zach Eflin (40) and George Kirby (36).

- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
- In 2020, made Opening Day start and earned win July 24 vs. Arizona...posted 4.73 ERA across 12 regular season outings...became seventh pitcher in San Diego franchise history with 200+ strikeouts in first 35 career starts.
- As a rookie in 2019, posted career-bests in wins (9), ERA (3.33), innings (140.2) and strikeouts (153)...named to *Baseball America's* Major League All-Rookie Team.
- Made major league debut March 31, 2019 vs. San Francisco, yielding one run on two hits and striking out seven in 5.0-inning no-decision.
