THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-2 (2-1 at KC, 0-1 at MIL) through four games on their five-game roadtrip to begin the season...this afternoon, the Twins will complete the roadtrip with the two-game series finale in Milwaukee...tomorrow afternoon, Minnesota will open its 15th season at Target Field with three against the Cleveland Guardians (April 4, 6-7) and three against the Los Angeles Dodgers (April 8-10).
 ☞ Today marks the fifth day game for the Twins...15 of the first 21 games on the schedule for Minnesota are day games...the Twins went 34-35 in day games in 2023.
 ☞ The Twins are looking to avoid falling under .500 today for the first time since ending the 2022 season with a record of 78-84.

OFF WISCONSIN: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon at American Family Field by a score of 3-2...Louie Varland (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...Jorge Alcala and Jay Jackson each pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded just three hits, all singles from Alex Kirilloff, Byron Buxton and Max Kepler...additionally, Carlos Correa drew three walks in four plate appearances, tying his single-game career high, done for the 15th time.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 377 career managerial wins, one away from tying Gene Mauch for fourth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins and Brewers are playing the second of four scheduled games this season...Minnesota will host the Brewers for two games coming out of the All-Star break from July 20-21...Minnesota went 2-2 against Milwaukee last season, going 2-0 at Target Field from June 13-14 and 0-2 at American Family Field from August 22-23...the Twins' last victory in Milwaukee was April 4, 2021, looking to snap a five-game losing streak here.
 ☞ Since the start of 2016, the Twins have scored 5.0 runs-per-game at Milwaukee, their second best in an NL park (min. 8 games), behind only Wrigley Field (6.38 in 8 games).
 ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .333 (14-for-42) with four doubles, one triple, five RBI, five walks and an .880 OPS in his last 13 games vs. the Brewers.

MILWAUKEE'S BEST: Since the start of 2014, the Twins have hit 39 home runs in 25 games at Milwaukee, the best among AL teams and more than six NL clubs in that span (Colorado - 38, Miami - 37, Atlanta - 35, Arizona - 34, New York - 27 and Washington - 24)...Torii Hunter is the club's all-time leader in home runs at American Family Field, with 11; the most among actives is Byron Buxton, with five.

FEAR THE DEER-BUCK: Byron Buxton is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with three doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.164 OPS in 12 career games at American Family Field...the OPS is his highest at any ballpark (minimum of 40 PA)...he has homered five times in his last seven games here.

POWER OUTAGE: The Twins have hit just one home run in 151 plate appearances, the only homer being a Royce Lewis first-inning shot on Opening Day...Minnesota has the fewest home runs in baseball, while Milwaukee (3) has second-fewest...the Twins finished the 2023 season tied with Texas (233) for the third-most homers in baseball, trailing Atlanta (307) and Los Angeles-NL (249).

OPENING DAY, TAKE THREE: Tomorrow's plans for the 2024 Home Opener at Target Field presented by Your Local Northland Ford Dealers:
 ☞ **Breakfast on the Plaza:** The Twins' tradition returns as fans are invited to drive, walk or bike down 7th Street (adjacent to the Twins New Era Team Store) between 6:00 and 9:00 a.m. to grab a free ballpark-inspired breakfast.

☞ **Open the Gates:** Twins legends Tony Oliva (Gate 6) and Kent Hrbek (Gate 14) will open their namesake ballpark entrances at 1:00 p.m., while franchise icons Justin Morneau (Gate 3), Tom Kelly (Gate 6.5) and Dan Gladden (Gate 29), along with Kirby Puckett Jr. and Catherine Puckett (Gate 34), respectively, will also officially open the Target Field gates and welcome fans home for the 2024 season.

☞ **Opening Weekend Gate Giveaway:** First 10,000 fans through the gates tomorrow, as well as Saturday, will receive a Twins Beanie, courtesy of Your Local Northland Ford Dealers. (Sunday, April 7 is "Kids Opening Day", with the first 5,000 fans 12-and-under getting a Kids Twins Beanie.)

☞ **Celebrating 40 Years of Dick Bremer:** Celebration of legendary broadcaster Dick Bremer, who stepped away from the booth following the 2023 season - his 40th as the television voice of the Twins - to become a special assistant with the club.

☞ **Dedication of TV Broadcast Booth (1:30 p.m.):** The Twins will dedicate the home television broadcast booth in the Herb Carneal Press Box as the "Dick Bremer Broadcast Booth"...beginning with that afternoon's Home Opener, the call of every Twins home game at Target Field will originate from a booth bearing the name of the broadcaster who called that space home for the ballpark's first 14 seasons.

☞ **Ceremonial First Pitch:** Twins fans will have an opportunity to hear some of Bremer's most memorable calls and to applaud the master storyteller, as he takes the field with his family prior to the game and delivers the Home Opener's ceremonial first pitch.

☞ **Honoring Burnsville and Dakota County First Responders:** The Twins will recognize, honor and celebrate the heroism of Burnsville and Dakota County first responders, while paying tribute to the three individuals who tragically lost their lives in the line of duty on February 18.

☞ **Special Starting Lineup:** First responders from Dakota County and the City of Burnsville, along with representatives from the Minneapolis and Metro Transit Police Departments, and the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office, will ring the infield and join the Twins and Guardians along the first and third baselines, respectively, following pregame introductions.

☞ **In Memoriam:** A video and moment of silence will pay tribute to Burnsville Police Officers Paul Elmstrand and Matthew Ruge, and Firefighter/Paramedic Adam Finseth, along with members of the Twins family and military from throughout Twins Territory that we have lost this past offseason.

CANADIAN BREW: Justin Morneau hit his second career home run at American Family Field on June 22, 2003, in his 12th career game...he pinch hit for LaTroy Hawkins in the ninth inning, going deep off Mike DeJean, hitting it off the scoreboard; it was his only career homer in this ballpark (34 games)...Morneau hit .322 (73-for-227) in 61 career games against the Brewers, with 17 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 48 RBI, 31 walks, a .397 on-base percentage and a .904 OPS...he hit .299 (38-for-127) with 16 walks in 34 games at Milwaukee.

SPRING RECAP: Made four 2024 Grapefruit League starts, posting a 4.73 ERA (13.1 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 10 strikeouts...concluded his spring training on March 23 vs. Boston, allowing three runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings with five strikeouts.

HOUSTON HAD A PROBLEM: Made relief appearances in Games 1 and 4 of American League Division series vs. Astros, allowing one baserunner and striking out six in 3.2 total innings...threw 35 of 48 pitches for strikes...recorded three-straight strikeouts in Game 4, fanning Alex Bregman, Yordan Alvarez and Kyle Tucker.

PADDACK VS. THE CREW: Has posted a 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER) with two walks and 18 strikeouts in three career starts vs. Milwaukee...has allowed two runs in 11.0 total innings in two starts at American Family Field...last start vs. Milwaukee was also at American Family Field, on May 26, 2021, when he allowed one run on two hits in 6.0 innings with one walk and two strikeouts.

⚡ Has faced only three current Milwaukee hitters in his career: Rhys Hoskins, Willy Adames and Christian Yelich, none of whom has reached base against him.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since joining Minnesota in 2022, has gone 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA (14.0 IP, 10 ER), two walks and 17 strikeouts at Target Field, compared to 2-1 with a 2.03 ERA (13.1 IP, 3 ER), one walk and 11 strikeouts on the road...in his career (2019-23), has a 4.43 ERA with 9.41 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings-pitched and a 5.09 strikeout-to-walk ratio in home appearances, compared to a 4.02 ERA, 8.76 K/9 and 4.86 K/BB on the road...earned the win in relief in his last regular season appearance on the road, September 30, 2023 at Colorado...earned the win in his last road start May 2, 2022 at Baltimore, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched.

PLATOON SPLITS: During Paddack's Minnesota tenure, right-handed hitters have hit .271 (19-for-70) with a .636 OPS and 17 strikeouts, while lefties have hit .308 (12-for-39) with an .838 OPS and 11 strikeouts...in Paddack's career, righties have hit .257 (166-for-647) with a .735 OPS, 40.3 hard-hit percentage and an average exit velocity of 89.5 mph, while lefties have hit .229 (147-for-642) with a .689 OPS, 40.4 hard-hit percentage and 89.1 mph average exit velocity.

THE ARSENAL: Threw four-pitch mix in 2023 return from injury...featured changeup vs. right-handed (35.0%) and left-handed (42.1%) hitters...incorporated slider after trade to Minnesota and threw pitch exclusively to right-handed hitters in 2022-23...here's a breakdown of his 2023 repertoire:

⚡ Has thrown more than 26-percent changeups each season since 2019 debut...pitch had 92nd-percentile run value among MLB offspeed pitches in 2019 and 99th percentile in 2020.

⚡ Worked to improve slider this offseason/spring training and plans to increase usage of the pitch.

2023 NOTES:

- ⚡ Signed three-year contract extension on January 18.
- ⚡ On 60-day Injured List from February 23 to September 24, rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in May 2022.
- ⚡ Allowed four earned runs in 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts in three-game rehab assignment.
- ⚡ Returned September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL...exited the bullpen and as he was approaching the infield dirt, umpires called for the tarp...didn't return after 50-minute rain delay.
- ⚡ Made official return to major league mound on September 25 vs. Oakland...first major league appearance in 507 days...threw fastest pitch of career, a 99 mph four-seam fastball to Zack Gelof in the top of the sixth inning.
- ⚡ Included on American League Wild Card Series roster but didn't appear in two-game sweep of Toronto.
- ⚡ Made relief appearances in Games 1 and 4 of American League Division Series vs. Houston, allowing one baserunner and striking out six in 3.2 total innings...both no-decisions in Twins losses.

FULLY RECOVERED: Underwent second Tommy John surgery May 18, 2022; first surgery was in 2016...made one rehab appearance each with Low-A Fort Myers, Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul before activation from 60-day Injured List on September 24, 2023...in two regular season relief appearances, threw 35 four-seam fastballs averaging career-high 95.5 MPH...fastball and changeup both averaged vertical and horizontal movement within 1.5 inches of 2022 pre-injury numbers.

IN THE ZONE: Including Postseason, issued only one walk in 8.2 innings upon 2023 return from injury...his 4.97 K/BB ratio is tied with Bailey Ober for ninth best in MLB since 2019...has walked one batter or fewer in 55 of 68 career appearances...posted a 95th percentile walk rate (4.8%) in 2021, his last full season...71.3 first-pitch strike percentage in 2019 ranked first among qualified pitcher seasons from 2019-23.

BIG MOVES: With 2022 rotation spot in question, San Diego traded him, Emilio Pagan and a PTBNL to Minnesota for Taylor Rogers and Brent Rooker; trade completed April 7, a day before Opening Day...Pagan posted a 3.67 ERA, 10 saves and 15 holds in 125 games in 2022-23 with Minnesota...Rogers, a 2021 All-Star with Minnesota, pitched in 42 games for San Diego; sent to Milwaukee in August 1, 2022 trade for Josh Hader...Rooker played in 16 games for San Diego/Kansas City in 2022; joined Oakland as waiver claim and hit 30 home runs in 2023, earning first All-Star selection.

- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
- In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
- Made Postseason debut in 2020 NL Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, surrendering six earned runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings...credited with loss in Game 1.
