OHIO PLAYERS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the first of 13 times in 2024...the Twins were 6-7 vs. the Guards last season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...the Twins outscored the Guardians 59-44 in 2023.

◆ Since 2022, 24 of the 32 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and 14 by one run.

◆ The Twins homered 19 times against Cleveland pitching last season, the most any team hit against the Guardians in 2023.
