**THE TWINS:** The Twins completed their first roadtrip of the season with a record of 3-2, going 2-1 in Kansas City and 1-1 in Milwaukee...this afternoon, the Twins will open their 15th season at Target Field with the first of three against the Guardians...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then complete the series with afternoon games against Cleveland on Saturday and Sunday...after this series, the Twins will host the Dodgers from Monday-Wednesday.

☐ Today marks the sixth day game for the Twins...15 of the first 21 games on the schedule for Minnesota are day games...the Twins went 34-35 in day games in 2023...their first night game will be on Monday, hosting the Dodgers at 6:40 (CT).

**A LEFT-HANDED TOAST IN WISCONSIN:** The Twins beat the Brewers yesterday afternoon at American Family Field by a score of 7-3, including a five-run seventh inning...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense set season highs in runs, hits (11), walks (7) and extra-base hits (5)...Alex Kirilloff set a career high by reaching five times, going 4-for-4 with a walk...Ryan Jeffers recorded the club's second home run of the season with a three-run go-ahead 376-foot shot.

**FROM ROC TO MAUCH:** Rocco Baldelli enters today with 378 career managerial wins, one away from passing Gene Mauch and moving into fifth place on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**OHIO PLAYERS:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the first of 13 times in 2024...the Twins were 6-7 vs. the Guards last season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field...the Twins outscored the Guardians 59-44 in 2023.

- ☐ Since 2022, 24 of the 32 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and 14 by one run.
- ☐ The Twins homered 19 times against Cleveland pitching last season, the most any team hit against the Guardians in 2023.
- ☐ The Twins have hit 123 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent in that span.
- ☐ Carlos Correa is hitting .290 (29-for-100) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .360 on-base percentage, a .510 slugging percentage and an .870 OPS in 26 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022.
- ☐ Max Kepler has 22 career home runs and 49 RBI in 115 games vs. Cleveland, the home runs are his most vs. any opponent and his RBI are second-most (Detroit - 62).
- ☐ Christian Vázquez is hitting .308 (32-for-104) with eight doubles, 11 walks and an .816 OPS in 33 career games vs. the Guardians.

**YOU'VE GOT TO CHANGE YOUR EVIL WAYS:** Carlos Santana was signed to a one-year contract by the Twins on February 7...prior to joining Minnesota, Santana played 189 career games against the Twins, hitting .254 (178-for-701) with 32 doubles, three triples, 31 home runs, 105 RBI, 105 walks, 106 runs scored and a .793 OPS against Minnesota pitching...Santana made his debut with Cleveland in 2010 and played parts of 10 seasons with the Guards, hitting .251 (1197-for-4773) with 273 doubles, 216 home runs, 710 RBI, 717 runs scored and an .818 OPS (121 OPS+) in 1334 games.

**FEELING MINNESOTA:** The Twins are opening their 15th season at Target Field today...they are 36-27 all-time in Home Openers, going 12-9 at Metropolitan Stadium from 1961-81, 16-12 at the Metrodome from 1982-2009, and 8-6 at Target Field since 2010...Twins have won six of their last seven Home Openers, their only loss in that span coming in 2022 in a 2-1 defeat against the Seattle Mariners on April 8.

☐ The Twins are hosting Cleveland in a Home Opener for the fourth time in their history, the previous three: a 5-4 loss on April 9, 1963 at Met Stadium, a 7-4 win on April 4, 2004 at the Metrodome and a 2-0 win on March 28, 2019 at Target Field.

**MAKING A TARGET RUN:** Last season, the Twins went 47-34 at Target Field, for a winning percentage of .580, tying for their fourth-highest in Target Field's history (since 2010), trailing 2020 (.774 — 24-7), 2010 (.654 — 53-28), and 2018 (.605 — 49-32)...their 47 home wins were fourth-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in baseball.

☐ The Twins have an all-time record at Target Field of 550-532 (.508).

☐ Minnesota slashed .249/.332/.448 with a .780 OPS at home last season, compared to .238/.320/.408 with a .728 OPS on the road.

**OPENING DAY, TAKE THREE:** Today's plans for the 2024 Home Opener at Target Field presented by Your Local Northland Ford Dealers: ☐ **Breakfast on the Plaza:** The Twins' tradition returns as fans are invited to drive, walk or bike down 7th Street (adjacent to the Twins New Era Team Store) between 6:00 and 9:00 a.m. to grab a free ballpark-inspired breakfast.

☐ **Open the Gates:** Twins legends Tony Oliva (Gate 6) and Kent Hrbek (Gate 14) will open their namesake ballpark entrances at 1:00 p.m., while franchise icons Justin Morneau (Gate 3), Tom Kelly (Gate 6.5) and Dan Gladden (Gate 29), along with Kirby Puckett Jr. and Catherine Puckett (Gate 34), respectively, will also officially open the Target Field gates and welcome fans home for the 2024 season.

☐ **Opening Weekend Gate Giveaway:** First 10,000 fans through the gates tomorrow, as well as Saturday, will receive a Twins Beanie, courtesy of Your Local Northland Ford Dealers. (Sunday, April 7 is "Kids Opening Day", with the first 5,000 fans 12-and-under getting a Kids Twins Beanie.)

☐ **Celebrating 40 Years of Dick Bremer:** Celebration of legendary broadcaster Dick Bremer, who stepped away from the booth following the 2023 season — his 40th as the television voice of the Twins — to become a special assistant with the club.

☐ **Dedication of TV Broadcast Booth (1:30 p.m.):** The Twins will dedicate the home television broadcast booth in the Herb Carneal Press Box as the "Dick Bremer Broadcast Booth"...beginning with that afternoon's Home Opener, the call of every Twins home game at Target Field will originate from a booth bearing the name of the broadcaster who called that space home for the ballpark's first 14 seasons.

☐ **Ceremonial First Pitch:** Twins fans will have an opportunity to hear some of Bremer's most memorable calls and to applaud the master storyteller, as he takes the field with his family prior to the game and delivers the Home Opener's ceremonial first pitch.

☐ **Honoring Burnsville and Dakota County First Responders:** The Twins will recognize, honor and celebrate the heroism of Burnsville and Dakota County first responders, while paying tribute to the three individuals who tragically lost their lives in the line of duty on February 18.

☐ **Special Starting Lineup:** First responders from Dakota County and the City of Burnsville, along with representatives from the Minneapolis and Metro Transit Police Departments, and the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office, will ring the infield and join the Twins and Guardians around the first and third baselines, respectively, following pregame introductions.

☐ **In Memoriam:** A video and moment of silence will pay tribute to Burnsville Police Officers Paul Elmstrand and Matthew Ruge, and Firefighter/Paramedic Adam Finseth, along with members of the Twins family and military from throughout Twins Territory that we have lost this past offseason.
