THE TWINS: After completing their first roadtrip of the season with a record of 3-2 (2-1 in Kansas City and 1-1 in Milwaukee), the Twins began their first homestand of the season with a loss to the Guardians on Thursday afternoon...today, the Twins will play the second of three against Cleveland at Target Field...after this series, the Twins will host the Dodgers from Monday-Wednesday.

Today marks the seventh day game for the Twins...15 of the first 21 games on the schedule for Minnesota are day games...the Twins went 34-35 in day games in 2023...their first night game will be on Monday, hosting the Dodgers at 6:40 (CT).

Minnesota is looking to avoid falling under .500 for the first time since entering the 2023 All-Star break with a record of 45-46.

GUARDS SPOIL THE OPENER AND PABLO DAY: The Twins lost to the Guardians on Thursday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-2 as Minnesota dropped just their second Home Opener in the last eight seasons (also 2022)...Pablo López was the starter and loser, allowing four runs (3 earned) on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, drew one walk, struck out 15 times and went 0-for-12 with runners in scoring position...Carlos Correa tied his season-high with three hits in four at-bats...Edouard Julien hit his first home run of the season with a fifth inning shot off Tanner Bibee.

FROM ROC TO MAUCH: Rocco Baldelli enters today with 378 career managerial wins, one away from passing Gene Mauch and moving into fifth place on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the second of 13 times in 2024...the Twins were 6-7 vs. the Guardians last season, going 3-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Progressive Field.

Minnesota is looking to avoid losing the three-game series today, which would mark their first series loss to the Guardians since dropping two of three at Target Field from August 28-30, 2023...if the Twins manage a win today and tomorrow, it would mark their first series win over Cleveland in Minnesota since taking two of three from May 13-15, 2022 (0-3-1 here since).

Since 2022, 25 of the 33 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and 14 by one run.

The Twins have hit 124 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent in that span.

Carlos Correa is hitting .308 (32-for-104) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .529 slugging percentage and a .903 OPS in 27 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022.

Max Kepler has 22 career home runs and 49 RBI in 116 games vs. Cleveland, the home runs are his most vs. any opponent and his RBI are second-most (Detroit - 62).

DIVISION SIGNS: This series marks the second for the Twins against an AL Central opponent this season after taking two of three in Kansas City to start the season...since the start of last season, the Twins have gone 31-25 against the AL Central, going 6-8 vs. the Guardians, 9-4 vs. the Royals, 11-5 vs. the White Sox and 5-8 vs. the Tigers...below are the Twins pitching numbers compared to other AL divisions/NL since the start of last season:

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Last season, the Twins went 47-34 at Target Field, for a winning percentage of .580, tying for their fourth-highest in Target Field's history (since 2010), trailing 2020 (.774 — 24-7), 2010 (.654 — 53-28), and 2018 (.605 — 49-32)...their 47 home wins were fourth-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in baseball.

I'LL TAKE BATTING AVERAGE FOR .400, ALEX: Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in all six games this season, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with a .440 on-base percentage, a .682 slugging percentage and a 1.122 OPS...he is one of three players in baseball to hit safely in all their games with an at-bat (minimum of 6 games), joining Jose Altuve (7) and Elly De La Cruz (6).

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached base safely 13 times (7 hits, 6 walks) in 25 plate appearances this season, including nine times (5 walks, 4 hits) in his last three games (13 plate appearances)...he ranks sixth in baseball in on-base percentage, trailing Mookie Betts (.553), Jesse Winker (.545), Logan O'Hoppe (.542), Tyler O'Neill (.536) and Freddie Freeman (.533).

He currently ranks tied for third in baseball in sweet spot percentage (66.7%) with Dominic Fletcher and trailing Edward Olivares (72.7%) and Kyle Tucker (68.4%).

MINOR MATTERS: Three more Twins affiliates opened their seasons yesterday.

Double-A Wichita lost by a score of 6-4 to Frisco...Marco Raya was the starter, allowing one run on four hits in 3.0 innings pitched with no walks and four strikeouts...Emmanuel Rodriguez went 1-for-4 with a double, two RBI and a walk.

High-A Cedar Rapids lost to Beloit by a score of 3-1...Andrew Morris was the starter, pitching 4.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...Gabriel Gonzalez went 2-for-4 with a run scored.

Low-A Fort Myers lost to Tampa by a score of 4-2...Ross Dunn was the starter, allowing one run on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched with three walks and six strikeouts...Byron Chourio went 2-for-3 with two walks.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1982, the largest crowd ever to see a baseball game in Minnesota, 52,279, showed up for the inaugural game at the brand-new Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Twins rookie Gary Gaetti had four hits, including a pair of home runs, but the visiting Seattle Mariners won, 11-7.

HAPPY BERT DAY! Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven turns 73 today...Bert appeared in five games on his birthday, combining to go 2-1, 2.51 ERA (32.1 IP, 9 ER) with 13 walks and 22 strikeouts...he pitched a complete game on his birthday in 1973 against Oakland...Bert retired from the broadcast booth after the 2020 season.

- Making second start in 2024...prior start was against the Kansas City Royals on March 30 going 5.1 innings, one earned run, three hits, one walk and five strikeouts in a no-decision. Making his 63rd career start...faced the Cleveland Guardians three times in 2023...going 0-3, 3.24 ERA (16.2 IP, 6 ER) 14 hits, two walks and 11 strikeouts. Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his first start the season in Twins' second game on March 30 at Kansas City in a Twins 5-1 win, opposite of Seth Lugo...shut out the Royals through the first five innings...was relieved by Steven Okert in the bottom of the sixth inning who inherited two runners by Joe Ryan and allowed a two out single by MJ Melendez...Ryan's final line was 5.1 innings pitched, one earned run, three hits, one walk and five strikeouts.

SPRING RECAP: In five Grapefruit League starts, Ryan went 2-1, 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 19 strikeouts...in his final Grapefruit League appearance vs. the Baltimore Orioles on March 24, he pitched 5.0 innings, two hits allowing two runs on a first-inning two-run homer by Gunnar Henderson, with one walk and five strikeouts.

JOE VS. THE GUARDIANS: Facing the Guardians for the seventh time in his career...in the previous five he has gone 3-3, 2.05 ERA (48.1 IP, 11 ER), 32 hits, six walks and 37 strikeouts...his last win came on September 18, 2022, in a 3-0 win he logged 7.2 innings, three hits, two walks, five strikeouts.

- His 2.05 ERA against the Guardians is his second lowest vs. any opponent in his career (min. 3 GS). Last start against the Guardians, came on September 5, 2023 at Progressive Field, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched with one walk and three strikeouts in a Twins 2-1 loss. Through six career starts vs. Cleveland he has an opponent batting average of .185, his fourth-lowest mark vs. any opponent (min. 3 GS).

AT HOME IN '23: Went 7-4 with a 3.83 ERA (82.1 IP, 35 ER), 15 walks and 111 strikeouts in 14 starts at home in 2023...Twins went 9-5 in Ryan's 14 starts at home. In 32 career home starts, he is 14-9, 3.65 ERA (180.0 IP, 73 ER) with 48 walks and 216 strikeouts...Twins are 19-13 in Ryan's 32 starts at home. Led Twins' rotation with seven home wins in 2023. Allowed 12 of his 32 home runs (37.5%) at home in 2023...has only given up three home runs against the Guardians at Target Field in 23.2 innings.

- LEFT RIGHT SPLIT: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .143/.250/.143, zero extra-base hits in eight plate appearances Vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters slashed .167/.167/.333, two doubles in 12 plate appearances. Over his career, lefties are batting .207 (126-for-609) with a .633 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .241 (163-for-677) with a OPS of .745. In 2023, Cleveland right-handed hitters hit (3-for-24) one double, no home runs, no walks, eight strikeouts and a BABIP of .188 in Ryan's three starts. Used his split-finger 33% vs. left-handed hitters the most as his primary put away pitch in his one start in 2024, against the Kansas City Royals.

APRIL EXCELLENCE: Set to make his 10th career start in the month of April, is 8-1, 2.13 ERA (55.0 IP, 13 ER), 32 hits, 10 walks and 61 strikeouts...opponents are hitting .214 and a OPS of .497...best month of his career with at least eight games started...since 2022, is tied with Clayton Kershaw with eight April wins and also has the best opponent batting average in the month since April 2022. (Min. 50 IP).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan utilized a five-pitch mix in his first regular season start this year compared to his four-pitch repertoire in 2023...leaned on his four-seam fastball and split-finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 69.1 percent of the time in his first start of the year...here is Joe Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant: PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. (# OF PITCHES, VS. RHB/LHB) RESULTS

2023 NOTES:

- Made Twins Opening Day roster, the second of career...posted career highs in innings (161.2), strikeouts (197) and starts (29). First career complete-game shutout vs. the Boston Red Sox on June 22, logging nine strikeouts and zero walks...season-high 122 pitches. Posted his best month in May going 2-2, 2.73 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER) 30 hits, nine walks, 40 strikeouts and two home runs. Made Postseason debut on October 11 in Game 4 of the ALDS vs. the Houston Astros, allowing one run (a second-inning home run to Michael Brantley) in 2.0 innings with one strikeout. 11 win tied Pablo Lopez for team lead, 197 strikeouts ranked second and 181.2 innings ranked third. Placed on 15-day Injured list on August 3 with a left groin strain...made on rehab start assignment with Triple-A St. Paul and was reinstated on August 26. Was supported with 97 runs of offense for a run support average of 5.40, 11th highest in the AL. Went 8-6, 3.70 ERA (107.0 IP, 44 ER) with 18 walks and 124 strikeouts in 18 starts pre-All-Star break...ranked fifth in the AL in strikeouts and 14th in innings pitched. Posted a 1.78 home runs-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, the fourth highest in the AL.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2024: 0-1, 54.00 ERA // CAREER: 13-13, 3.86 ERA)

Bailey Ober is set to close out a three-game series against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field tomorrow afternoon in his second start of the season...he last faced the Kansas City Royals on March 30, going 1.1 inning, eight earned runs, nine hits, one walk, one strikeout and three home runs, it was the shortest start of his career...set to make his sixth career start against the Cleveland Guardians in his prior five starts he is 1-1, 1.29 ERA (28.0 IP, 4 ER), 19 hits, two walks, 21 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .194...making his 2024 Target Field debut after appearing in 14 games in 2023.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020. Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K). In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197). In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151). Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K). Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts. Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz... learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA. In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season. In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts). Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August. Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts. Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
