THE TWINS: After completing their first roadtrip of the season with a record of 3-2 (2-1 in Kansas City and 1-1 in Milwaukee), the Twins began their first homestand of the season with consecutive losses to the Guardians on Thursday and Saturday, then had game three rained out yesterday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will play their first night game of the season with the first of three against the Dodgers...they will play game two tomorrow night then wrap the series on Wednesday afternoon.

SATURDAY'S FOR THE GUARDS: The Twins lost to the Guardians on Saturday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-1, suffering their first series loss of the season...Joe Ryan (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched with no walks and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits, drew seven walks, struck out 14 times and went 0-for-11 with runners in scoring position...Alex Kirilloff recorded the first hit with an RBI triple in the first inning and Carlos Correa recorded the other hit with a ninth inning single.

I'LL TAKE HITTING STREAKS FOR SEVEN, ALEX: Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in all seven games this season, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with a .433 on-base percentage, a .692 slugging percentage and a 1.126 OPS...he is one of three players in baseball to hit safely in all their games with an at-bat (minimum of 7 games), joining Jose Altuve (10) and Jarrod Kelenic (8)...below are the Twins' last five hitting streaks of seven-or-more to begin a season:

DODGE BALL: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 23rd, 24th and 25th time in their history this week...the Twins are 7-15 all-time vs. LAD...in the regular season, Minnesota is 2-9 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 2-6 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome...Minnesota went 1-2 at Dodger Stadium last season, winning the middle game of the three-game series from May 15-17.

☞ The May 16, 2023 victory snapped an 11-game losing streak to the Dodgers, beating them for the first time since June 29, 2011...the game was started by tonight's starter, Bailey Ober, who allowed one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts, opposite Clayton Kershaw...the win marked the Twins second-ever victory at Dodger Stadium, the other being a 5-3 win on June 11, 2005, a difference of 6,549 days.

☞ Kyle Farmer was selected by the Dodgers in the eighth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Georgia and made his debut with Los Angeles on July 30, 2017 vs. San Francisco...recorded first career hit in a pinch hitting appearance in the 11th inning, driving in two runs with a double...became the first player in Dodgers franchise history to produce a walk-off hit in his first major league plate appearance and the first player on any team to do it since Toronto's Tomas Perez on May 3, 1995.

☞ Tonight's starter, Bailey Ober, was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

☞ Manny Margot was acquired by the Dodgers in December and played two spring training games with LA in Arizona before being traded to Minnesota along with Rayne Doncon and cash considerations, in exchange for Noah Miller on February 26.

☞ Christian Vazquez caught the final out of the 2018 World Series for the Red Sox at Dodger Stadium as Chris Sale struck out Manny Machado.

☞ Reliever Brock Stewart was drafted by the Dodgers in the sixth round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft and spent parts of four seasons with Los Angeles from 2016-19...made major league debut as a Dodger on June 29, 2016 at Miller Park.

☞ Dodgers bench coach Danny Lehman was drafted by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2007 First-Year Player Draft out of Rice University...he spent 2007-13 in the Twins minor league system, reaching as high as Triple-A Rochester.

OYE COMO VA: Carlos Santana is celebrating his 38th birthday today...he has played 10 career games on his birthday, hitting .297 (11-for-37) with four walks, one double, three home runs and 11 RBI...Santana was originally signed by the Dodgers on August 13, 2004...he was traded by the Dodgers to Cleveland on July 26, 2008, in exchange for infielder Casey Blake...full circle, Blake played parts of two seasons for the Twins from 2001-02.

PLUS-MINUS: The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Daniel Duarte on the 15-day Injured List with a right triceps strain...Duarte appeared in two games for the Twins on March 31 at Kansas City and April 3 at Milwaukee, combining to go 1-0, 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER), two hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...to replace Duarte on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled infielder Jose Miranda from Triple-A St. Paul...Miranda played in seven games for the Saints, hitting .250 (7-for-28) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, four runs scored, three walks and a .313 on-base percentage.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached base safely 16 times (8 hits, 8 walks) in 30 plate appearances this season, including 12 times (7 walks, 5 hits) in his last four games (18 plate appearances)...he leads baseball in on-base percentage (.533), ahead of Mookie Betts (.518) and Tyler O'Neill (.514).

MOVE ON, GET OBER IT: Bailey Ober allowed a career-high nine runs (8 earned) on a career-low 1.1 innings pitched in his first start on March 31 at Kansas City...minus that start, the Twins' pitching staff has posted a 2.41 ERA (59.2 IP, 16 ER) in seven games this season, including a starters ERA of 3.66 (32.0 IP, 13 ER) in the other six starts.

☞ The bullpen this season has combined to post a 0.98 ERA (27.2 IP, 3 ER), the lowest in baseball...additionally, their .140 opponent batting average ranks second lowest in baseball, trailing Cleveland (.132).

RISPY BUSINESS: Twins hitters are batting .125 (9-for-72) with runners in scoring position, second-lowest in baseball, ahead of only Chicago-AL (.104)...they enter tonight 0-for-their-last-24 with RISP, seeking their first hit since a Ryan Jeffers single in the top of the ninth on April 3 at Milwaukee...individually, Carlos Correa is 3-for-7 (.429) with RISP and Byron Buxton is 3-for-9 (.333).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul catcher Jair Camargo and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris yesterday were named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Camargo, who was added to the Twins 40-man roster in November, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .273 (6-for-22) with one double, one home run, three RBI, three walks and just four strikeouts...the 24-year-old from Barranquilla, Colombia, was part of the Twins-Dodgers Kenta Maeda trade that sent Brusdar Graterol to Los Angeles-NL.

☞ Morris, 22, made the Opening Day start for the Kernels on Friday night at Beloit, pitching 4.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts...the New York, NY native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech University...he is ranked as the 18th-best prospect in the Twins system by MLB.com.

ROUGH START: Made 2024 season debut March 31 at Kansas City opposite Brady Singer, allowing eight runs on nine hits (3 HR) in 1.1 innings...dealt the loss in Minnesota's 11-0 defeat...set new career high for earned runs allowed in a start (previously six, also at Kauffman Stadium on July 29, 2023)...generated just one whiff on 53 pitches.

☞ Allowed home runs to Salvador Perez, Kyle Isbel and Maikel Garcia.

SPRING RECAP: In five Grapefruit League starts, Ober went 1-2 with a 6.35 ERA (14.1 IP, 9 ER), 13 hits, five walks, 22 strikeouts and at least one home run in each of his last four outings...in his last spring start, March 25 vs. Atlanta, he allowed four runs on four hits in 4.1 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts; surrendered a three-run home run to Marcell Ozuna and a solo shot to Austin Riley.

DOMINATED THE DODGERS: Making second career start vs. Los Angeles-NL and first at Target Field...faced Dodgers on May 16, 2023, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...earned victory opposite Clayton Kershaw in Minnesota's 5-1 win...threw 102 pitches, his second highest total of 2023 (104, 8/4 vs. ARI)...in his career, has allowed multiple hits to only one active Dodger, Freddie Freeman (2-for-3).

☞ Originally drafted by Dodgers in 23rd round of 2016 Draft...opted to return to College of Charleston for 2017 season...signed with Twins as 12th-round pick in 2017.

BAILEY'S BACK HOME: Making 2024 Target Field debut...started 14 home games in 2023, going 3-3 with a 3.30 ERA (76.1 IP, 28 ER), 17 walks and 71 strikeouts...last season, opponents hit .230 with a .261 batting average on balls in play (BABIP) vs. Ober at home, compared to .233 with a .293 BABIP on the road...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of 14 home starts in 2023...made last home start September 26, 2023, vs. Oakland, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts in a Twins 11-3 victory.

LEFT AND RIGHT: Left-handed hitters hit .228 (62-for-272) with 17 walks and 63 strikeouts vs. Ober last season...right-handers hit .236 (63-for-267) with 12 walks and 83 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters have slashed .251/.307/.399 with a 21.3 percent strikeout rate against Ober...righties have hit .229/.260/.439 with a 27.9 percent strikeout rate.

☞ In May 16, 2023 game, Dodgers' left-handed hitters went 3-for-13 with a double and four strikeouts, while their right-handed hitters went 3-for-10 with two doubles and two strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ober debuted a cutter in his March 31 start at Kansas City, per Baseball Savant; had previously thrown a four-pitch mix (4-seam fastball, changeup, slider and curveball) in his big league career (2021-23)...here was his repertoire in his 2024 season debut:

☞ Threw only one changeup (1.9 percent) to a right-handed hitter on March 31 after throwing the pitch at a 23.3-percent rate vs. righties in 2023...pitch resulted in just five home runs last season.

☞ Against Kansas City, average 4-seam fastball velocity was up from 91.3 mph in 2023.

☞ Induced only one whiff on 53 pitches...posted 28.6-percent whiff rate in 2023.

2023 NOTES:

- ☞ Was Triple-A St. Paul's Opening Day starter and pitched in four games for Saints to begin the season, posting a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings.
- ☞ Recalled by Twins on April 23 and made season debut that day against Washington, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings, earning the win.
