THE TWINS: After completing their first roadtrip of the season with a record of 3-2 (2-1 in Kansas City and 1-1 in Milwaukee), the Twins began their first homestand of the season with consecutive losses to the Guardians on Thursday and Saturday, followed by a rainout on Sunday, then a loss to the Dodgers last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against Los Angeles...after tomorrow's series finale, they will travel to Detroit for four games from Thursday-Sunday, then to Baltimore for three games from April 15-17.

SORRY MS. JACKSON: The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2, dropping their third-straight game...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Jay Jackson, who was trying to hold a 2-2 tie, was issued his first loss, allowing two runs on two hits, including solo home runs from James Outman and Shohei Ohtani in the seventh inning...Manny Margot had two of the Twins' three hits, including his first homer as a Twin, a two-run, 416-foot shot in the third inning.

BATTLE OF LOS ANGELES: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 23rd, 24th and 25th time in their history this week...the Twins are 7-16 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 2-9 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 2-7 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome...the Twins .304 winning percentage against LA is their lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961).

Byron Buxton has hit safely in five-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with two home runs and a 1.197 OPS.

Reliever Brock Stewart was drafted by the Dodgers in the sixth round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft and spent parts of four seasons with Los Angeles from 2016-19...made major league debut as a Dodger on June 29, 2016 at Miller Park.

Dodgers bench coach Danny Lehman was drafted by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2007 First-Year Player Draft out of Rice University...he spent 2007-13 in the Twins minor league system, reaching as high as Triple-A Rochester.

THAT'S WHAT I'M TONKIN ABOUT: The Twins have acquired right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin from the Mets in exchange for cash...Tonkin, 34, appeared in three games for the Mets this season, allowing two earned runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched (4.50 ERA) with one walk and three strikeouts...last season, he pitched in 45 games for the Atlanta Braves, going 7-3, 4.28 ERA (80.0 IP, 38 ER), one save, two holds, 23 walks, 75 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .217 (64-for-295) opponent batting average...the 6-foot-7, 220-pound pitcher was originally drafted by the Twins in the 30th round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft and made his debut with Minnesota in 2013...he pitched in parts of five seasons with the Twins from 2013-17, going 3-3, 4.43 ERA (146.1 IP, 72 ER), 54 walks and 149 strikeouts...to make room for Tonkin on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Max Kepler on the 10-day Injured List with a right knee contusion (retro to April 7)...Kepler, who fouled a ball off his right leg in the season opener on March 28 at Kansas City, has gone 1-for-20 with one walk in five games this season...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Zack Weiss (right shoulder strain) to the 60-day IL.

Tonkin is the brother-in-law of former Twins outfielder Jason Kubel...Jason, who is seven years older than Michael, married his sister Blake...Jason recommended that (former GM) Terry Ryan and his staff take a look at Tonkin prior to the 2008 draft.

I'LL TAKE OBP FOR .400, ALEX: Alex Kirilloff had his seven-game hitting streak snapped last night, going 0-for-1 in a pinch hit appearance...Kirilloff has hit safely in seven of eight games this season, hitting .370 (10-for-27) with a .419 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.086 OPS...he enters today eighth in the AL in on-base percentage, trailing Tyler O'Neill (.514), Anthony Volpe (.488), Carlos Correa (.471), Juan Soto (.462), Corey Seager (.442), Logan O'Hoppe (.429) and Andrés Giménez (.422).

RISP TAKERS: Twins hitters are batting .122 (9-for-74) with runners in scoring position, second-lowest in baseball, ahead of only Chicago-AL (.091)...they enter tonight 0-for-their-last-26 with RISP, seeking their first hit since a Ryan Jeffers single in the top of the ninth on April 3 at Milwaukee...individually, Carlos Correa is 3-for-7 (.429) with RISP and Byron Buxton is 3-for-9 (.333).

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached base safely 16 times (8 hits, 8 walks) in 34 plate appearances this season, including 12 times (7 walks, 5 hits) in his last five games (22 plate appearances)...he ranks third in the AL in on-base percentage (.471), trailing Tyler O'Neill (.514) and Anthony Volpe (.488)...additionally, he ranks tied for fourth in walks (8).

SLICK LEATHER: The Twins defense has committed just two errors on the season — a Kody Funderburk fielding error on March 31 at Kansas City and a Carlos Correa fielding error on April 4 vs. Cleveland...only the Braves (1) have committed fewer errors this season...additionally, as a team, the Twins rank fifth in baseball in defensive runs above average (3.4) and tied for sixth in defensive runs saved (3).

OFF TARGET: Twins are looking to win their first game at Target Field, starting the season 0-3 for the second time in the Target Field Era (also 2014 and 2016)...they have lost their first four home games just twice in their history, in 1981 (0-4) and 1962 (0-5)...their last win here came on September 27, 2023 vs. Oakland.

PABLO DAYS: The Twins, in partnership with Pablo and Kaylee López, announced yesterday a special 'Pablo Day' ticket package for each of Pablo's home starts at Target Field from May to September that includes a commemorative jersey and philanthropic contributions to three local nonprofits designated by the López family...the new "Pablo Day" package includes a ticket to the next Twins home game that López starts, plus a unique, Pablo-themed jersey whose design pays homage to the All-Star's Venezuelan roots...a portion of the proceeds from each package sold will benefit a trio of local nonprofits specially selected by Pablo and Kaylee López: Children's Minnesota, Project Success and Ruff Start Rescue...this limited-quantity ticket package will be available for purchase at twins.com/PabloDay beginning approximately 48 hours before Pablo's next scheduled home start...fans will be able to sign up via the link to receive email notifications regarding the Pablo Day ticket package; updates will be emailed once starting pitcher probabilities for each upcoming López home start are announced. Pablo Day ticket package holders will be seated together in a designated area of Target Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a loss in the series finale April 2 at Milwaukee; pitched a career-low 4.0 innings pitched in a Twins' 3-2 defeat...worked a scoreless first inning, including a leadoff strikeout to Sal Frelick...gave up two RBI to Brice Turang and a third-inning home run to Christian Yelich...his final was 4.0 innings pitched, three earned runs, six hits, two walks and five strikeouts.

☞ Shortest start of his career, previous low was 4.1 IP on June 18, 2023 vs. the Detroit Tigers.

SPRING RECAP: Made six appearances (5 starts) in the Grapefruit League...in the six appearances, Varland went 1-1, 7.00 ERA (19.0 IP, 14 ER), 19 hits, four walks and 14 strikeouts...last spring outing came on March 26 vs. the Atlanta Braves, where he totaled 5.0 innings, six earned runs, seven hits, five strikeouts and a pair of home runs to Jarred Kelenic and Orlando Arcia.

BULLPEN GEM: Moved to the bullpen starting on September 6 after being called up from Triple-A St. Paul Saints on September 4...Twins went on to win five out of the seven appearances he made in the month...pitched to a 1-0 record, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 17 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts and two holds.

☞ Began September with a ERA of 5.03 and ended the season with a 4.63...batters hit .150 with a .191 BABIP and slugged .300...recorded two holds in the Postseason in back-to-back games vs. the Blue Jays pitching 0.2 innings with two hits, zero runs and one strikeout in the two appearances.

DEBUT VS. DODGERS: Facing the Dodgers for the first time in his career...has made one total career start against the NL West, vs. San Diego Padres on May 9, 2023, logging 6.0 innings, five hits, one run, two walks and six strikeouts, picking up a no-decision in a 6-1 Twins loss.

☞ Has only faced one active player on the Dodgers roster, Shohei Ohtani (1-for-6)...the one hit was a home run on May 20, 2023.

☞ Louie is the younger brother of current Oklahoma City Dodgers pitcher Gus Varland...Gus made his major league debut for Milwaukee on March 30, 2023...he pitched in eight games for the Brewers in 2023 and was returned to the Dodgers via Rule 5 Draft in May of 2023...Gus appeared in one game for the Dodgers this season in Seoul, Korea; he is currently a pitcher for the Oklahoma City Dodgers.

BACK AT TARGET FIELD: Set to make his second start of the season and first of the year at Target Field after making four starts (nine appearances) coming out of the bullpen in the later half of the season...he logged 2-2, 4.55 ERA (29.2 IP, 15 ER), five walks and 31 strikeouts...his last home win came in a relief appearance on September 12 vs. Tampa Bay Rays where he logged 2.1 innings, one hit, no runs and three strikeouts.

☞ Through six game started at home and 11 total appearances he holds a 2-2, 4.46 ERA (40.1 IP, 20 ER), eight walks and 10 strikeouts...his last start at home came on June 18, 2023 vs Detroit Tigers where he pitched a season low 4.1 innings allowing six runs on nine hits, two-home runs, two walks and four strikeouts.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Through one appearance in the 2024 season, left-handed hitters have hit .364 (4-for-11), with one home run and four strikeouts...righties have hit .286 (2-for-7) with one strikeouts and one walk...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .236/.286/.444 with seven home runs and 40 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .272/.323/.511 with 14 home runs and 56 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland used a five-pitch mix in his first start against the Brewers, including a 4-seam fastball, cutter, slider and changeup, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and cutter for 63 of his 89 pitches (70.8%) in his first start of the 2024 season vs. Milwaukee on April 2nd...below is a look at his 2024 repertoire through one start:

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 – was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
- In 2019, made his professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton...made three appearances, including one start...struck out 10 batters in 8.2 innings pitched.
- Selected by Twins in 15th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.
