THE TWWWWWWWINS: Have gone 4-0 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, sweeping the Angels in three in Anaheim over the weekend, followed by a victory in Chicago over the White Sox last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three on the South Side...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then begin a seven-game homestand with three against the Red Sox (May 3-5) and four against the Mariners (May 6-9).

☞ The Twins are looking to go three games over .500, which would set their new high-water mark...it would be their highest since finishing the 2023 season 12 games over (.87-.75).

STREAK HITS EIGHT AT GUARANTEED RATE: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 3-2. Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...Brock Stewart (1.0 IP), Griffin Jax (1.0 IP, W) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0 IP, SV) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded just four hits after combining for 34 in their previous two... Carlos Santana hit his fourth home run of the season and fourth in his last five games...Max Kepler drove in Byron Buxton (double) in the top of the ninth inning for the game-winning run.

TWINS CONTINUE TO BEEF UP IN CHICAGO: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Jhoan Duran from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Duran, who has missed the club's first 28 games with a right oblique strain, appeared in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last week, allowing two runs on four hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...to make room for Duran on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Matt Bowman for release or assignment...Bowman appeared in five games for the Twins, posting a 2.35 ERA (7.2 IP, 2 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts.

FEELING GOOD, FEELING GR8, HOW ARE YOU: Minnesota's eight-game winning streak is their longest since June 11-21, 2011 (also 8)...the eight-game winning streak is the longest in baseball this season.

☞ The Twins are looking to win nine straight for the first time since June 17-27, 2008, when they won 10 straight...they have had 10 different winning streaks of nine-plus games in their history (since 1961)...the longest winning streak in Twins history is 15, done from June 1-16, 1991.

☞ Over the last eight games, the Twins have a run differential of +34 (60-26)...prior to the eight-game winning streak their run differential was at -25 (67-92).

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: Over the current eight-game winning streak, the Twins have hit .323 (93-for-288) with 27 doubles, 14 home runs, a .383 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a .946 OPS...they have scored a total of 60 runs (7.5 runs-per-game) during the stretch...below are the Twins numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (8 games) and MLB ranks in parenthesis:

DEEP DISH: The Twins and White Sox are playing the sixth of 13 games this season...Minnesota has won six straight and has gone 12-1 in their last 13 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

☞ At Guaranteed Rate Field, since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs in this ballpark than the Twins, hitting 81 home runs (next is Kansas City with 49).

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .355 (38-for-107) with seven doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 24 RBI, an .804 slugging percentage and a 1.224 OPS in his last 29 games against the Sox...since the start of last season, Buck has hit five home runs in 12 games (9 RBI).

☞ Since the start of last season, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (15-for-40) with a 1.057 OPS in 12 games vs. the White Sox.

☞ Christian Vázquez is hitting .319 (44-for-138) with seven doubles, one home run, 18 RBI, 10 walks, a .365 on-base percentage and a .756 OPS in 43 career games vs. the Sox...Vázquez is also hitting .314 (22-for-70) in 22 career games at Guaranteed Rate.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in nine straight against the Sox, hitting .375 (12-for-32) with four doubles, seven RBI and a .929 OPS in that span.

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .308 (28-for-91) with six doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI and an .816 OPS in 25 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 16 runs in his last 17 games vs. CWS.

I JUST WANNA GO FAST: Minnesota has seen 2,074 fastballs this season, the fewest in baseball...additionally, they have seen the second-most breaking pitches in baseball (1,493)...they have a .464 slugging percentage off fastballs in 2024, second best in baseball, trailing Baltimore (.465)...additionally, their .357 wOBA vs. fastballs ranks sixth in baseball.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Santana has hit safely in five straight and in eight of his last nine...in his last nine, he is slashing .286/.359/.686 (1.045 OPS) with four home runs and 11 RBI after starting the season slashing .123/.206/.140 (.347 OPS) with one extra-base hit (2B) and two RBI...he is the all-time leader among actives in walks (115) and games (185) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (91), tied for second in hits (150), and third in home runs (26) and RBI (82).

HOW DO YOU SAY 'HAPPY BIRTHDAY' IN FRENCH?: Edouard Julien is celebrating his 25th birthday today...he shares a birthday with White Sox pitcher Michael Kopech (28) and former Twins reliever Ryan O'Rourke (36).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up a no-decision on April 25 vs. Chicago-AL...made his first career home start and first appearance at Target Field since April 22, 2023 (relief outing vs. Washington)...allowed two runs on seven hits, one walk and a career-high six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...the only two runs he surrendered were on a second-inning sacrifice fly by Kevin Pillar and a fourth-inning single by Paul DeJong; the single had an exit velocity of 104.5 mph, the hardest hit allowed...was relieved by Cole Sands in the sixth inning, who would end up earning his first major league win.

Had 11 swings and misses on 66 strikes.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was recalled as the 27th man for the doubleheader on April 13 at Detroit...made his second career start at Detroit in Game 2 of that day, picking up his first major league win and first quality start...opposite Tigers starter Matt Manning, Woods Richardson allowed two hits, one run, one walk and five strikeouts...threw an MLB career-high 6.0 innings and matched his then-MiLB career high with five strikeouts (April 22, 2023 vs. Washington)...allowed two hits in the second inning and then retired 12-straight batters...the one run given up was on a second-inning sac fly by Javier Báez.

MAKING NEW FRIENDS: Making his second career start and second consecutive against Chicago-AL...fanned a career-high six batters in his last start vs. the White Sox on April 25...marks the first time he is facing the same team consecutively since May 23/May 28, 2023 at Triple-A St.Paul...he faced Omaha Storm Chasers in those two appearances; went 0-1, (8.1 IP, 11 ER), 16 hits, five walks, four strikeouts...it is one of six times has faced the same opponent in back-to-back outings in the minor leagues.

ROAD WARRIOR: Is set to make his second start on the road this season and third of his career...his only two road starts both have come at Comerica Park, including one start this year...in those two starts he is 1-1, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER), three walks and eight strikeouts...he picked up his first major league win at Comerica Park in his first start of the season on April 13...down in Triple-A, Woods Richardson also made three starts, all of which came on the road...in those three starts he went 0-1, 6.08 ERA (13.1, 9 ER), 16 hits, five walks, 12 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .302.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through three Triple-A starts in 2024, right-handed hitters have hit .267 (8-for-30) vs. Woods Richardson with a .700 OPS, while lefties have hit .348 (8-for-23) with an .858 OPS...conversely, in 25 games last season, righties hit .297 (69-for-232) with an .874 OPS vs. Woods Richardson, compared to lefties'.215 average (47-for-219) with a .677 OPS...in two major league start this year, righties went 4-for-23 (.174) with seven strikeouts, while left-handed hitters went 5-for-17 (.294), with one walk and four strikeouts...in his major league career, left-handed hitters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with one home run, four walks, eight strikeouts and a .676 OPS...righties are hitting .233 (10-for-43) with three doubles, one home run, three walks and 11 strikeouts with a .643 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson used a four-pitch mix in his first two starts vs. Detroit and Chicago-AL...leaned on his 4-seam fastball and changeup the most, combining to throw the two pitches 67.1 percent of the time in that start, compared to his first start at Detroit, where it was a 4-seam fastball and slider combination for 75%...here is his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
