**THE TWINS:** Completed their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record 3-6, going 2-1 in Houston, 0-3 at New York-AL and 1-2 at Pittsburgh...tonight, Minnesota will begin a nine-game, 10-day homestand with the first of three against the Rockies...after this series, they will welcome the A's for four games from Thursday-Sunday, enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play the Rays for three games next Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins are 16-13 at home this season...they have gone 14-7 in their last 21 at Target Field after starting the season 2-6 here.

**RAISE THE JOLLY ROGER, HAPPY FLIGHT:** The Twins beat the Pirates yesterday afternoon at PNC Park by a score of 11-5 in 10 innings, making them 2-0 in extras this season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the Twins used a season-high six relievers (Thielbar, Sands, Jax, Alcalá, Duran, Staumont), who combined to allow one unearned run in 5.1 innings pitched, with just three hits allowed...the offense recorded 13 hits, six of which came in the ninth inning-or-later...Carlos Correa reached four times, going 3-for-5 with a walk, two runs scored and two RBI.

☞ Minnesota snapped a 4-4 tie with a seven-run 10th inning, marking the fourth time in club history (since 1961) scoring at least seven runs in the 10th inning-or-later: 11 runs in top 10 on June 21, 1969 at Oakland...eight runs in top 10th on August 1, 1970 at Detroit...seven runs in top 10th on July 23, 2013 at Los Angeles-AL...and seven runs in top 12th on April 13, 2024 (Game 1)

**THOUGHT THE ROCKY MOUNTAINS WOULD BE A LITTLE ROCKIER THAN THIS:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 22nd, 23rd and 24th time in their history this week...the Twins have gone 12-9 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-4 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 5-4 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22).

☞ These two last met in Colorado for a three-game series to end the 2023 season, from September 29-October 1, as the Twins took two of three.

☞ The Twins have hit just 17 home runs against the Rockies in their history, tied with Atlanta for Minnesota's fewest against any opponent in their history.

☞ Offensive notables from that three-game series in 2023: Ryan Jeffers went 5-for-9 (.556) with one home run...Alex Kirilloff went 4-for-9 (.444) with a double...Max Kepler went 3-for-8 (.375) with a home run and four RBI.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** The Twins are 5-6 in Interleague Play this season...they played a two-game series in Milwaukee from April 2-3 (1-1), a three-game series at Target Field against Los Angeles (1-2), a three-game series at Washington (2-1) and a three-game series at Pittsburgh (1-2) over the weekend...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Diamondbacks at Chase Field from June 25-27.

☞ Trevor Larnach has four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, a .585 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS in 20 games against the NL since the start of last season.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with one triple, three home runs, seven RBI, eight walks and a 1.015 OPS in 11 games against NL opponents this season.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has nine home runs, a .403 on-base percentage, a .593 slugging percentage and a .996 OPS in 37 Interleague games since the start of last season...Jeffers' IL OPS ranks 10th in baseball since the start of last season.

**INTER-NATIONAL MAN:** Max Kepler has played in 156 Interleague games in his career, slashing .259/.340/.471 (.811 OPS)...below are his all-time Twins ranks in Interleague Play:

**SOLID 'PENMANSHIP:** Over the last 18 games, the Twins relievers have gone 5-0, 2.23 ERA (60.2 IP, 15 ER) with 21 walks, 51 strikeouts, a .189 opponent batting average, 12 holds and seven saves in seven opportunities...below are the reliever ranks among other AL bullpens on the season:

**C4 IGNITING:** Carlos Correa is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with one home run, four RBI, two walks, a .474 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.099 OPS in his last four games.

☞ Correa is hitting .311 (19-for-61) against breaking pitches this season, fourth-best average in the AL and ninth-best in baseball (minimum of 750 pitches seen).

☞ On the season, he ranks in MLB's 89th percentile in expected batting average (.287) and bat speed (74.9) and in the 87th percentile in expected wOBA (.364).

**ROYCE RULES:** Through six games this season, Royce Lewis is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with one double, three home runs, four RBI, two walks, a 4.74 on-base percentage, a .941 slugging percentage and a 1.341 OPS.

☞ Lewis has gone 3-for-9 (.333) off fastballs, 2-for-4 (.500) against offspeed pitches and 1-for-4 (.250) against breaking pitches.

☞ Tonight marks Lewis' first time in front of the home crowd since Game 4 of the ALDS on October 11, 2023 vs. Houston, when he went 1-for-3 with a home run...in his last 17 regular and Postseason games in this ballpark, he has posted a 1.000 OPS with eight home runs and 19 RBI.

**THE RIPPLE EFFECT:** The Twins today unveiled the club's 2024 Nike MLB City Connect Series uniform, a look that embodies this majestic land "where the water reflects the sky" and celebrates the 10,000 lakes that shape and unite us...the Nike City Connect Series, which debuted in 2021, celebrates the deep-rooted history, culture and spirit of each city that continues to bring the Major League Baseball clubs and their communities together...the Twins are the final MLB franchise to debut their initial City Connect uniform design and one of nine clubs to be featured in the 2024 series...these new uniforms will make their on-field debut this Friday and Saturday against the Athletics.

**BIRTHDAY SHOUT:** Happy 69th birthday to former Twins coach Scott Ullger...Ullger spent 20 seasons as a coach for the Twins, serving as third base coach, first base coach, bench coach and hitting coach...he also played 35 games for the Twins in 1983.

**BAD NIGHT IN THE BRONX:** Last pitched June 5 at New York-AL, opposite Carlos Rodón, and took the loss in Minnesota's 9-5 defeat...allowed seven runs on six hits in 4.0+ innings with two walks and seven strikeouts...allowed four runs on five hits in the first inning...retired 10-straight batters with six strikeouts from innings 1-4...loaded the bases with no outs before being pulled in the fifth; Diego Castillo entered and allowed all three runners to score.

- ⚔ Induced 12 whiffs on 37 swings (32.4%)...ranks in MLB's 40th percentile with a 23.8 percent whiff rate this season.
- ⚔ Allowed two hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph), both first-inning singles: 115.5 mph by Giancarlo Stanton, 101.0 mph by Anthony Volpe...ranks in MLB's 33rd percentile with a 41.0 percent hard-hit rate.
- ⚔ Has a 12.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 12 ER) vs. New York-AL this season, 4.18 ERA (56.0 IP, 26 ER) vs. all other opponents.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started May 30 vs. Kansas City, opposite Daniel Lynch IV, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 win...allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed first-inning two-run home run to Vinnie Pasquantino, third-inning RBI double to Bobby Witt Jr. and fourth-inning solo shot to MJ Melendez...was pulled with a runner on first and two outs in the sixth; Caleb Thielbar entered and stranded the runner.

- ⚔ Induced eight whiffs on 41 swings (19.5%).
- ⚔ Allowed nine hard-hit balls; Kansas City went 4-for-9 on those swings, including the Pasquantino (106.1 mph) and Melendez (109.0 mph) home runs.

**RECORD VS. ROCKIES:** Has made four career appearances (2 starts) vs. Colorado, going 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA (17.0 IP, 4 ER), two walks and 21 strikeouts...made relief appearance at Coors Field on September 30, 2023, in second game after returning from Tommy John surgery; threw 3.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and earned the win in Minnesota's 14-6 victory.

- ⚔ Both starts vs. Colorado – August 10, 2019 and August 30, 2020 – were quality starts.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making eighth home start of the season...has gone 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA (38.2 IP, 14 ER), 1.40 home-runs-per-9.0 innings and 9.78 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 1-2 with an 8.20 ERA (26.1 IP, 24 ER), 1.71 HR/9 and 6.49 K/9 in five road starts...has a 1.32 WHIP and .729 opponent OPS at home, compared to 1.56 WHIP and .848 OPS on the road.

- ⚔ Has completed 5.0-or-more innings in six of seven home starts.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** On June 5, New York-AL's left-handed hitters went 2-for-8 with a double, a walk and four strikeouts vs. Paddack, while its righties went 4-for-10 with a double, a walk and three strikeouts...through 12 games vs. Paddack, lefties have hit .287 (39-for-136) with a .746 OPS and 17.7 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .293 (39-for-133) with an .812 OPS and 25.2 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚔ Has induced a 20.7 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 27.2 percent vs. righties.
- ⚔ Colorado ranks 19th in baseball with a .678 OPS vs. right-handed pitching this season.

- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
- In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.
