**THE TWINS:** Have gone 7-2 through nine games on their current 10-game, 11-day homestand, going 2-1 vs. Colorado, 4-0 vs. Oakland and 1-1 vs. Tampa Bay...today, Minnesota will wrap up the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Rays...after today's game, the Twins will travel west to begin a nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with three games in Oakland this weekend, an off-day Monday, three games in Arizona Tuesday-Thursday and three games in Seattle next weekend.

⊕ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 34-20, tied with Baltimore (34-18) for third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (36-18) and Philadelphia (35-17).  
 ⊕ The Twins are 4-1 in rubber games this season, their four wins coming May 12 at Toronto, May 22 at Washington, June 2 at Houston and June 12 vs. Colorado...their one loss coming April 21 vs. Detroit.  
 ⊕ Minnesota is looking to win their eighth game of the homestand, which would mark their most for a homestand since going 9-2 over 11 games from July 5-15, 2018.

**TWINS DROP GAME 2 TO TAMPA:** The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings, their first extra-innings loss of the season (3-1)...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the Twins were one out away from keeping the score at 2-2 and entering the bottom of the 10th inning, but Royce Lewis committed a throwing error on a Jonny DeLuca ground ball, which scored Randy Arozarena...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Lewis, who hit his eighth home run of the season...Lewis' homer broke the ribbon board on the second deck with an exit velocity of 108.7 mph — his third-hardest hit of 2024.

**CARLOS COR-RAKING:** Since June 6, Carlos Correa is hitting .482 (27-for-56) with two doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 14 runs scored, a .516 on-base percentage, a .732 slugging percentage and a 1.248 OPS in 13 games...below are his MLB rankings in a few categories since that date:

**PLAYING ALL THE HITS:** Over their last 10 games, the Twins have hit .337 (123-for-365) with 25 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs, 32 walks, 72 runs scored (7.2 R/G), a .398 on-base percentage, a .548 slugging percentage and a .946 OPS...prior to this 10-game stretch, the Twins began the month by hitting .195 (43-for-220) with a .604 OPS and 2.4 runs-per-game.

**R-LEW NOT ENTERTAINED?!** Through 14 games this season, Royce Lewis is hitting .380 (19-for-50) with two doubles, eight home runs, 12 RBI, six walks, a .439 on-base percentage, a .900 slugging percentage and a 1.339 OPS.

⊕ Lewis has played in 84 career games...his 162-game averages are: .319 (189-for-592) with 25 doubles, 48 home runs, 133 RBI, 104 runs scored, 12 stolen bases and a .983 OPS.

**RAY MATTERS:** The Twins and Rays are playing the third of seven games in 2024...their next series will be at Tropicana Field for four games from September 2-5.

⊕ The Twins are 11-7 in their last 18 home games vs. TB, dating back to the start of 2018.

⊕ Carlos Correa is hitting .377 (20-for-53) with a 1.014 OPS in his last 13 games vs. Tampa...in that span, he has three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and a .604 slugging percentage.

⊕ Carlos Santana has posted a 1.033 OPS with six doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI in his last 16 games against the Rays.

⊕ Max Kepler has posted a .949 OPS with five doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks and 12 runs scored in his last 18 games vs. the Rays.

⊕ Rays starter Zack Littell made his debut with the Twins in 2018 and pitched parts of three seasons with Minnesota, from 2018-20, going 6-2, 4.52 ERA (63.2 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 49 strikeouts in 43 games...Littell was acquired by the Twins via trade with the Yankees at the 2017 trade deadline along with Dietrich Enns, in exchange for Jaime Garcia...Zack left the Twins via free agency after the 2020 season.

**TWINS TRY MEATLOAF THE RAYS:** A win today would give the Twins their 14th series win of the season...they enter play today 13-8-2 in series play this season, going 7-4-0 at home and 6-4-2 on the road...a win would give them their 13th series win in their last 17 tries since April 25.  
 ⊕ Minnesota's last series win over Tampa was June 10-12, 2022 (2-1) at Target Field.

**SUPERNATURAL:** Carlos Santana needs two games played to reach 2,000 games for his career, entering today with 1,998...among active players, he ranks third in games, trailing Andrew McCutchen (2,068) and Joey Votto (2,056)...on that same list, he ranks second in walks (1,238), tied for sixth in doubles (377), seventh in RBI (1,048), ninth in hits (1,720) and runs scored (1,021), and 10th in home runs (312).

⊕ In 15 games this month, he is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with four doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, six walks, a .411 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS...among AL players in June, he ranks ninth in OPS, 10th in on-base percentage, tied for 10th in slugging percentage and 11 in hits.

**BIRTHDAY SHOUTS:** Twins assistant pitching coach Luis Ramirez is celebrating his 51st birthday today...Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez is celebrating his 24th birthday today...Henriquez, who is on the club's 40-man roster, has appeared in 20 games for the Saints this season, going 1-2, 3.57 ERA (35.1 IP, 14 ER), with nine walks and 35 strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched June 14 vs. Oakland, opposite Mitch Spence, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 walk-off win in 10 innings...allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings with four walks and four strikeouts...allowed a first-inning grand slam to Shea Langeliers after two walks and a single...stranded a runner in scoring position in the third and fourth innings.

- ☞ Four walks marked an MLB career high and his most in a game since August 8, 2023 vs. Triple-A Louisville.
- ☞ Induced seven whiffs on 36 swings (19.4%)...ranks in MLB's 22nd percentile with a 21.2 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls, all over 100.0 mph; Oakland went 2-for-6 on those swings, including Langeliers' 102.8 mph grand slam...ranks in MLB's 55th percentile with a 37.8 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Minnesota has gone 8-3 in Woods Richardson's 11 starts this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started June 8 at Pittsburgh, opposite a Pirates bullpen game, and took the loss in Minnesota's 4-0 defeat...allowed one run on six hits (1 HR) in a career-high 6.1 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts...worked around two hits in the first and third innings...struck out the side, all swinging, in the fourth...only run came on Rowdy Tellez's seventh-inning home run...was pulled after the next batter, Yasmani Grandal, reached on an error.

- ☞ First MLB start in which he pitched into the seventh inning.
- ☞ Induced a career-high 17 whiffs on 57 swings (29.8%).
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls; Pittsburgh went 2-for-6 on those swings.

**ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT:** Has never faced Tampa Bay or any active Rays hitters...only career start vs. the American League East came May 11 at Toronto, when he allowed five runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 4.1-inning no-decision; Twins lost, 10-8.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making fifth home start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP, 8 ER), 9.90 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings and 0.45 home-runs-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 1-1 with a 3.12 ERA (34.2 IP, 12 ER), 6.23 K/9 and 1.30 HR/9 in seven road starts...has allowed a .203 (15-for-74) batting average and .547 OPS at home, compared to .250 (33-for-132) opponent batting average and .690 OPS on the road.

- ☞ Has an identical WHIP (1.15) at home and on the road.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 11 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .198 (16-for-81) with a .570 OPS and 19.8 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .256 (32-for-125) with a .683 OPS and 20.6 percent strikeout rate...righties have hit four of the six home runs and five of the six doubles vs. Woods Richardson.

- ☞ On June 14, Oakland's lefties went 1-for-6 with a walk and two strikeouts, righties went 3-for-10 with a home run, three walks and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 87.4 mph by lefties, 90.3 mph by righties.
- ☞ Hard-hit rate vs. Woods Richardson: 36.5 percent by lefties, 39.4 percent by righties.

- ☞ On June 14, Oakland went 2-for-9 with three strikeouts vs. Woods Richardson's 4-seamer...over his last four starts since May 28, opponents have hit .185 (5-for-27) and slugged .222 vs. the pitch.
- ☞ Slider has allowed a 21.7 percent hard-hit rate, 12th lowest in baseball (min. 50 PA).
- ☞ Has thrown slider 28.7 percent of the time when behind in the count...opponents have hit .133 (2-for-15) with four strikeouts vs. the pitch in those situations.
- ☞ Opponents have gone 1-for-7 vs. Woods Richardson's first-pitch fastballs.

- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
