**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Oakland, followed by a loss in Arizona last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of a three-game series against the D-Backs through tomorrow afternoon... after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Seattle to play the Mariners for three games over the weekend.

⚡ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 36-23, fourth-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (38-19), Los Angeles-NL (37-20) and New York-AL (37-22)...in that span, they have a road record of 15-13.

**DEFEATED IN THE DESERT:** The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks last night at Chase Field by a score of 5-4, making them 14-9 in one-run games... Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, three from Byron Buxton, who singled, doubled (12) and homered (6)...Ryan Jeffers hit a three-run game-tying home run in the seventh inning, his team-leading 13th of the season...Jeffers came up with Buxton on second base and two outs in the ninth inning and lined out to leftfield, a ball that had an expected batting average of .940.

**TWINS AND SNAKES:** The Twins and D-Backs are playing each other for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this week...the Twins have gone 17-11 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 8-1 at Target Field (2014-23) and 5-8 at Chase Field (2004-22).

⚡ The Twins have won nine of their last 12 games against the D-Backs, dating back to September of 2014.

⚡ Minnesota has won one game at Chase Field since June 8, 2005, going 1-7 here since.

⚡ In 15 career games at Chase Field, Carlos Correa is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, a .391 on-base percentage and a .900 OPS.

⚡ Byron Buxton has played six career games against the D-Backs, going 11-for-25 (.440) with three doubles, two triples, three home runs and a 1.542 OPS.

⚡ Max Kepler has played in 10 career games against the D-Backs, hitting .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and a .968 OPS.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** The Twins are 7-8 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado and 0-1 at Arizona.

⚡ Carlos Correa is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with one double, one triple, three home runs, nine RBI, nine walks and a 1.018 OPS in 15 games against NL opponents this season...among all MLB players, he ranks 11th in on-base percentage.

**ROYCE RULES:** In 39 career road games, Royce Lewis is hitting .349 (51-for-146) with five doubles, 13 home runs, 36 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .651 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS.

⚡ Lewis is riding an 0-for-last-10, his last hit being a third inning double on Saturday afternoon at Oakland; it's tied for the longest 0-fer of his career, after going 0-for-10 from August 19-22, 2023...he has now gone hitless in two consecutive games; for his career (89 games), he has never gone hitless in three straight games.

⚡ Since coming off the IL on June 4, he ranks third in baseball in slugging percentage (.750) and home runs (9) and is sixth in OPS (1.127).

**KEEPING ENEMIES CLOSE:** Six of Minnesota's last eight games have been decided by one run...they won the first two (1 vs. TB and 1 vs. OAK) of those six and have lost each of the last four (2 vs. TB, 1 at OAK and 1 at ARI)...Twins have gone 14-9 in one-run games this season, tied with four other teams for fourth-most one-run wins in baseball.

**DAYS GONE BY-RON:** Byron Buxton enters tonight with a five-game hitting streak, tying his season-high, previously done from April 19-24...during the current streak, he is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with four doubles, two home runs, four RBI, a .900 slugging percentage and a 1.300 OPS...in his last 15 games overall, he is hitting .345 (19-for-55) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, 10 runs scored and a .997 OPS.

⚡ Buck's strikeout percentage of 28.8 this season is the lowest in three seasons (31.4% in 2023, 30.4% in 2022, 24.4% in 2021)...his -2.6 strikeout percentage improvement from 2023 to 2024 is the second-best on the team, behind Carlos Correa (-4.3%).

**ICYMI - MILB POWS:** Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley earlier this week was named International League Pitcher of the Week and High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Christian MacLeod was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

⚡ Boushley, 30, threw 7.0 innings of shutout baseball on Saturday, June 22 against Toledo...he allowed just three hits and did not issue a walk while striking out five.

⚡ MacLeod, 24, made the start on Tuesday for theernels vs. Peoria, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and a career-high 10 strikeouts, earning his first win of the season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched June 20 vs. Tampa Bay, opposite Zack Littell, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-inning, 7-6 loss...allowed two runs on four hits in 6.0 innings with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed two doubles and a run in the second inning, then a double and a sacrifice fly in the third...recorded four-straight outs via strikeout from innings 4-5.

- ☞ All four hits allowed were doubles.
- ☞ Recorded his fourth career quality start; owns a 1-1 record in those outings.
- ☞ Induced 12 whiffs on 47 swings (25.5%)...ranks in MLB's 24th percentile with a 21.6 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Tampa Bay went 3-for-7 with three doubles on those swings...ranks in MLB's 52nd percentile with a 38.3 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Has recorded 9.58 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings in four June starts, compared to 6.75 in eight April/May starts.
- ☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in nine of 12 MLB starts this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started June 14 vs. Oakland, opposite Mitch Spence, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 walk-off win in 10 innings...allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings with four walks and four strikeouts...allowed a first-inning grand slam to Shea Langeliers after two walks and a single...stranded a runner in scoring position in the third and fourth innings.

- ☞ Induced seven whiffs on 36 swings (19.4%).
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls, all over 100.0 mph.

**ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT:** Has never faced Arizona or any active Diamondbacks hitters...this marks the 12th different team he's faced in his MLB career...has made three career Interleague appearances and two starts (2 G/1 GS vs. WSH, 1 GS vs. PIT), going 0-1 with a 3.45 ERA (15.2 IP, 6 ER), four walks and 12 strikeouts.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making eighth road start of the season...has gone 1-1 with a 3.12 ERA (34.2 IP, 12 ER), 6.23 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings and 1.30 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER), 9.69 K/9 and 0.35 HR/9 in five home starts...has allowed a .250 (33-for-132) batting average and .690 OPS on the road, compared to .200 (19-for-95) BAA and .566 OPS at home.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 12 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .198 (17-for-86) with a .569 OPS and 20.6 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .248 (35-for-141) with a .680 OPS and 20.8 percent strikeout rate...righties have hit 12 of the 16 extra-base hits vs. Woods Richardson.

- ☞ On June 20, Tampa Bay's lefties went 1-for-5 with a double and two strikeouts, righties went 3-for-16 with three doubles, two walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 87.7 mph by lefties, 90.2 mph by righties.

- ☞ On June 20, Tampa Bay went 2-for-11 with three strikeouts vs. Woods Richardson's slider...pitch has allowed a .209 wOBA, 11th lowest in baseball (min. 50 PA).
- ☞ Ranks in MLB's 93rd percentile with a breaking ball run value of 6 and 82nd percentile with a fastball run value of 6.
- ☞ In his last five starts since May 28, opponents have hit .200 (7-for-35) and slugged .286 vs. his 4-seamer...in his first seven starts, the pitch allowed a .296 (16-for-54) batting average and .333 slugging percentage.
- ☞ Throws a first-pitch curveball 15.5 percent of the time...opponents have gone on those pitches.
- ☞ Throws slider 28.2 percent of the time when behind in the count...opponents have hit .188 (3-for-16) and slugged .313 vs. the pitch in those situations.

**CAREER NOTES**

- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
