**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Chicago against the White Sox earlier this week, followed by a loss to the Giants on Friday and a win yesterday afternoon over San Francisco at Oracle Park...today, they will play the series finale at Oracle Park, completing the roadtrip and the unofficial "first half" of the season.   
 ☞ Minnesota has gone 47-28 in its last 75 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (48-25).   
 ☞ The Twins are 30-16 in day games this season, the most day wins in baseball.   
 ☞ The Twins have gone 27-23 on the road, winning nine of their last 13 away from Target Field.   
 ☞ The Twins are 10-2 in rubber games this season, winning each of their last six: June 23 at Oakland, June 27 at Arizona, June 30 at Seattle, July 4 vs. Detroit, July 7 vs. Houston and July 10 (G2) at Chicago-AL.

**SLAMTANA LEADS THE WAY IN WIN:** The Twins defeated the Giants 4-2 yesterday, evening the series at a game apiece...Carlos Santana (2-for-2, 2 BB) put the Twins ahead on a sixth-inning solo homer, his first career longball at Oracle Park; he has now homered in all 30 current major league ballparks...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter and did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on seven hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...Cole Sands (1.2 IP, 1 K) earned the win in relief and Jhoan Duran tossed a scoreless ninth, recording his 15th save of the season and the 50th of his career.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have placed infielder Jose Miranda on the 10-day Injured List with a low back strain (retroactive to July 11)...to replace Miranda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of infielder Diego A. Castillo from Triple-A St. Paul...Castillo has hit .272 (64-for-235) with 12 doubles, two triples, five home runs, 30 RBI, 39 walks, 34 runs scored and a .783 OPS in 71 games for the Saints this season...he began the Triple-A season with Norfolk in the Baltimore system and was acquired by the Twins from the Orioles in exchange for cash considerations on April 5...to make room for Castillo on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley for release or assignment.

**MY GIANT:** The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 22nd, 23rd and 24th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 11-12 all-time against San Francisco, going 4-2 at Target Field, 6-8 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to 2017, the Twins have won seven of their last 11 over the Giants.

**SERIES BUSINESS:** The Twins enter today with 19 series wins this season, their most series victories prior to the All-Star break since 2001, when they also had 19...full series results at the right.   
 ☞ Twins have won six-straight series for the second time this season, also doing so from April 22-May 12...a win today would give them seven-straight series victories for the first time since June 13-July 6, 2008, when they won series at Milwaukee, vs. Washington, vs. Arizona, at San Diego, vs. Milwaukee, vs. Detroit and vs. Cleveland.

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** Minnesota is slashing .366/.426/.604 (1.031 OPS) in its last 22 games vs. lefties, including a 17.4% strikeout rate.   
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .345 (29-for-84) with a .942 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 39 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .392 (29-for-74) with a 1.051 OPS.

**TEXAS TWO STARS:** Shortstop Carlos Correa and utility player Willi Castro were selected to represent the Twins at the 94th Major League Baseball All-Star Game on Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX...this marks Correa's third career All-Star selection and Castro's first.

**FEELING A DRAFT:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place tonight night, starting at 6 pm (CT)...the Twins will select 21st overall (1st round), 33rd overall (compensatory round - Sonny Gray), 60th overall (2nd round) and 69th overall (competitive balance round B).

**COOL HAND LUKE:** Twins number five prospect (MLB.com's 94th overall), Luke Keaschall represented the Twins in the MLB All-Star Futures Game yesterday afternoon at Globe Life Field, replacing Brooks Lee; Keaschall entered the game at second base in the top of the fifth inning and struck out in his lone at-bat, as the American League fell to the National League, 6-1...the 21-year-old infielder has split the 2024 season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita, hitting .327 (102-for-312) with 21 doubles, 11 home runs, 38 RBI, 66 runs scored, 52 walks, 19 stolen bases, a .438 on-base percentage and a .945 OPS in 84 games.

**TWINS MILB WEEKLYS:** Double-A Wichita infielder Luke Keaschall and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.   
 ☞ Keaschall, 21, hit .563 (9-for-16) with two home runs, two RBI, two walks, four runs scored and a 1.570 OPS in four games for the Wind Surge...he also represented the Twins in the MLB All-Star Futures Game yesterday.   
 ☞ Varland, 26, started for the Saints on July 11 at Louisville, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks and six strikeouts in a no-decision.

☞ Has made seven career starts vs. San Francisco, all with the Padres; is 1-1 with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), four walks and 38 strikeouts in those starts.

☞ Fastball averaged 93.8 mph on July 8...was 91.4 mph in June 21, pre-Injured List start at Oakland.

**RETURN FROM THE IL:** Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right arm fatigue) to pitch July 8 at Chicago-AL, opposite Chris Flexen...didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 11-inning, 8-6 win, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts...had 1-2-3 first and second innings...allowed third-inning solo home run to Martin Maldonado and fifth-inning RBI double to Corey Julks.

☞ Induced nine whiffs on 40 swings (22.5%)...ranks in MLB's 39th percentile with a 23.8 percent whiff rate.

☞ Allowed four hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Chicago-AL went 3-for-4 on those swings, including Maldonado's 104.6 mph home run...ranks in MLB's 21st percentile with a 42.8 percent hard-hit rate.

☞ Minnesota is 11-5 in Paddack's starts this season.

**BEFORE THE IL:** Started June 21 at Oakland, opposite Joey Estes, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 loss...allowed three runs on five hits in 4.2 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...allowed a run on three hits in the first inning...worked around two walks in the second, one in the third...exited with two on and two out in the fifth; Kody Funderburk entered and allowed both runners to score.

☞ Induced 10 whiffs on 35 swings (28.6%).

☞ Allowed 10 hard-hit balls; Oakland went 5-for-10 on those swings.

☞ First three-walk game since April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona.

**STATS VS. SAN FRANCISCO:** Has made seven career starts vs. San Francisco, all with San Diego from 2019-21...has gone 1-1 with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), four walks, 38 strikeouts and seven home runs allowed. (.797 opponent OPS) in those starts.

☞ Made MLB debut vs. Giants at Petco Park on March 31, 2019, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts.

☞ Has made five starts at Oracle Park, going 1-1 with a 4.18 ERA (23.2 IP, 11 ER), three walks and 27 strikeouts.

☞ Mike Yastrzemski and Wilmer Flores have both homered off Paddack twice.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making eighth road start of the season...has gone 1-2 with a 7.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 29 ER), 6.25 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 2.75 walks-per-9.0 innings and 1.50 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 4-1 with a 3.61 ERA (47.1 IP, 19 ER), 9.13 K/9, 1.71 BB/9 and 1.52 HR/9 in nine home starts...has a 1.50 WHIP and .800 opponent OPS on the road, compared to 1.33 WHIP and .756 OPS at home.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 16 games vs. Paddack, left-handed hitters have hit .298 (50-for-168) with a .787 OPS, 17.0 percent strikeout rate, 6.0 percent walk rate and 3.8 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .273 (47-for-172) with a .763 OPS, 23.2 percent strikeout rate, 5.0 percent walk rate and 3.9 percent home run rate.

☞ On July 8, Chicago-AL's lefties went 0-for-5 with a walk vs. Paddack, while its righties went 3-for-12 with a double, a home run, a walk and three strikeouts.

☞ Whiff rate: 20.9 percent vs. lefties, 26.8 percent vs. righties.

☞ Barrel rate: 8.0 percent vs. lefties, 11.8 percent vs. righties.

**THE ARSENAL:** Has thrown a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here's his pitch repertoire and results this season:

☞ On July 8 at Chicago-AL, his 4-seamer averaged 93.8 mph; compares to 91.4 mph in June 21, pre-Injured List start at Oakland.

☞ 4-seamer ranks fifth in baseball (min. 150 PA) with a 24.4 percent putaway rate...Pablo López ranks third at 25.6 percent.

☞ His changeup is allowing the highest slugging percentage (.525) in baseball (min. 300 changeups thrown)...pitch has allowed an MLB-leading and career-high-tying seven home runs.

☞ Right-handed hitters have hit .200 (7-for-35) with a .343 SLG and eight strikeouts vs. Paddack's slider, while lefties have hit .333 (5-for-15) with .533 SLG and two strikeouts vs. the pitch.

☞ Opponents are hitting .462 (6-for-13) with two home runs and a .923 SLG vs. Paddack's first-pitch fastballs, which he throws 41.9 percent of the time.

**WORKING AHEAD:** Has a 64.5 first-pitch strike percentage; compares to MLB average of 61.0 percent...after a first-pitch strike, Paddack's opponents have slashed .286/.321/.389; MLB average is .214/.261/.339...after a first-pitch ball, Paddack's opponents have slashed .272/.331/.447; MLB average is .255/.367/.425...five of his 14 home runs allowed this season have come on the first pitch and three have come in two-strike counts.
