LARNACH SENDS TWINS HOME AFTER LONG TRIP: The Twins beat the Mariners on Sunday afternoon in Seattle by a score of 5-3, securing the Twins their 16th series victory of the season (16-9-2)...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, no walks and 10 strikeouts — ninth career double-digit strikeout total for Ryan...the offense recorded eight hits and was led by Trevor Larnach, who went 2-for-4 and drove in three runs, including a two-run go-ahead shot in the top of the eighth inning, his eighth homer of the season.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins are playing the eighth of 13 games against the Tigers... Minnesota has gone 3-4 against the Tigers this season, going 2-2 at Comerica Park from April 12-14 and 1-2 at Target Field from April 19-21.
