**THE TWINS:** Completed their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 6-3, going 2-1 in Oakland, 2-1 in Arizona and 2-1 in Seattle...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the Tigers through Thursday...after this series, they will host the Astros for three games over the weekend.  
 ☞ With the win on Sunday in Seattle, the Twins improved to 10 games over .500, their high water mark for 2024...highest since finishing the 2023 season 12 games over (87-75).  
 ☞ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 40-24, the second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing only Philadelphia (41-21).

**LARNACH SENDS TWINS HOME AFTER LONG TRIP:** The Twins beat the Mariners on Sunday afternoon in Seattle by a score of 5-3, securing the Twins their 16th series victory of the season (16-9-2)...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, no walks and 10 strikeouts — ninth career double-digit strikeout total for Ryan...the offense recorded eight hits and was led by Trevor Larnach, who went 2-for-4 and drove in three runs, including a two-run go-ahead shot in the top of the eighth inning, his eighth homer of the season.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins are playing the eighth of 13 games against the Tigers...Minnesota has gone 3-4 against the Tigers this season, going 2-2 at Comerica Park from April 12-14 and 1-2 at Target Field from April 19-21.

☞ The Twins have gone 36-18 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season...in fact, in that time frame, the Twins have only lost three home series to the Tigers, holding a 12-3-2 series record in that span.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 123, 24 ahead of Chicago-AL (99).

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .306 (30-for-98) with six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and an .885 OPS in his last 25 games vs. the Tigers.

☞ Carlos Santana is hitting .234 (168-for-718) with 41 doubles, 27 home runs, 104 RBI, 125 walks and 109 runs scored in 196 career games vs. Detroit...below are his ranks vs. Detroit among actives:

**SUMMER OF C4:** Carlos Correa enters today with a .311 batting average, fourth best in the AL, trailing Luis Rengifo (.317), Aaron Judge (.316) and Bobby Witt Jr. (.312)...through games of June 5, he was hitting .247, raising his average 64 points over the last 22 games...Correa finished June hitting .388 (38-for-98) with four doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, 21 runs scored, nine walks, a .441 on-base percentage, a .582 slugging percentage and a 1.023 OPS...among all AL players in June, he finished second in batting average, third in hits and eighth in OPS...Correa's batting average ranked ninth in Twins history for the month of June.

**LOVIN' LEFTIES:** Minnesota is 15-8 this season when facing a lefty starter...Twins hitters are slashing .284/.337/.462 with a .799 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .237/.311/.409 with a .720 OPS vs. right-handed pitching.  
 ☞ They are slashing .405/.466/.660 (1.126 OPS) in their last 14 games vs. lefties, including a 14% strikeout rate.  
 ☞ Willi Castro is hitting .377 (29-for-77) with a 1.025 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 34 games vs. lefties, he is hitting .433 (29-for-67) with a 1.159 OPS.  
 ☞ Manny Margot is slashing .315/.373/.452 against lefties this season and .405/.439/.568 in his last 15 against southpaws.

**BUCK SEASON:** Byron Buxton has homered four times in his last six games and has driven in 12 runs in that span...in his last 19 games, since June 7, he is hitting .343 (24-for-70) with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 18 RBI, 15 runs scored, a .657 slugging percentage, a 1.039 OPS and an 18% strikeout rate...over that span, he has a 42.1% hard hit percentage (32.1% - league avg over that time).  
 ☞ Over the trip, Buxton went 11-for-27 (.407) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, eight runs scored and a 1.433 OPS in seven games played.

**TAKE A LOOK AT ME NOW:** Former Tiger Willi Castro has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games...in his last 30 games since May 29, he is hitting .321 (36-for-112) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 25 runs scored and a .938 OPS...he has already set single-season career highs in doubles (21) and needs 11 hits to match his career-high of 92 set in 2023.

**WE'RE TALKIN' LEE:** Twins number two prospect (MLB.com) Brooks Lee has been named to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game to be played at Globe Life Field in Texas on July 13...in 19 games for Triple-A St. Paul, Lee has hit .333 (27-for-81) with five doubles, six home runs, 18 RBI, 19 runs scored, a .400 on-base percentage, a .617 slugging percentage and a 1.017 OPS...the following players have represented the Twins in the Futures Game since 2013: **David Festa** in 2023; **Spencer Steer** and **Matt Wallner** in 2022; **Josh Winder** in 2021; **Jordan Balazovic** and **Royce Lewis** in 2019; **Alex Kirilloff** and **Lewis Thorpe** in 2018; **Nick Gordon** in 2017; **JT Chargois** in 2016; **José Berrios** in 2015 & '14; **Max Kepler** in 2015; **Trevor May**, **Alex Meyer** and **Kennys Vargas** in 2014; and **Byron Buxton** and **Miguel Sanó** in 2013.
