THE TWINS: Begin the unofficial "second half" with a five-game Interleague homestand... tonight, the Twins will host the Milwaukee Brewers for the first game of the final Border Battle series of the season...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale against Milwaukee, the Twins will welcome the Philadelphia Phillies — owners of the best record in baseball — for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

♣ Minnesota has gone 47-29 (.618) in its last 76 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (48-25, .640).

♣ The Twins are 27-18 (.612) at home this season, owning the fourth-best home winning percentage in the American League...Twins have won 10 of their last 14 home games since June 12.

IN CASE YOU FORGOT: The Twins fell to the San Francisco Giants, 3-2, in their unofficial "first half" finale on Sunday, July 14 at Oracle Park...Chris Paddack was the starter and did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 ER) on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Giants starter Blake Snell retired the first 18 batters faced before Manny Margot broke up the perfect game with a leadoff single in the seventh... the Twins tied the game at 2-2 on Margot's two-run double in the top of the ninth, but lost via a walk-off in the ninth.

THE STARS AT NIGHT ARE BIG AND BRIGHT...DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS: Carlos Correa and Willi Castro represented the Twins at the 94th Major League Baseball All-Star Game on Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX...Correa earned his third career All-Star selection (first as a Twin) and did not play in the game...Castro, on his first All-Star team, grounded out to third base as a pinch hitter against Philadelphia's Jeff Hoffman in the bottom of the eighth inning and remained in the game as the designated hitter...the American League defeated the National League, 5-3.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Chris Paddack on the 15-day Injured List with a right forearm strain (retroactive to July 17). Additionally, the Twins placed shortstop Carlos Correa on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to July 16) last night with right plantar fasciitis...to fill the spots on the 26-man roster, the Twins have reinstated utility player Austin Martin from the 10-day Injured List and recalled infielder Edouard Julien from Iriple-A St. Paul...Martin, who has missed the Twins' last eight games with a right oblique strain, has hit .265 (30-for-113) with nine doubles, one home run, nine RBI, 11 walks, 27 runs scored and a .702 OPS in 47 games for the Twins this season... Julien, who was named to the Twins' 2024 Opening Day roster and optioned on June 3, has hit .233 (30-for-129) with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, 11 RBI, 35 walks, 23 runs scored, a .400 on-base percentage and a .780 OPS in 35 games for the Saints,

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins and Brewers are playing the third of four scheduled games this season; Twins are 1-1 against Milwaukee this season after splitting a two-game series at American Family Field from April 2-3; the April 3 win snapped a five-game skid for Minnesota in that ballpark...Minnesota went 2-2 against Milwaukee last season, going 2-0 at Target Field from June 13-14 and 0-2 at American Family Field from August 22-23...the Twins are 243-234 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 70-60 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998.

◆Willi Castro is a career .424 (14-for-33) hitter with one double, two triples, five RBI, six runs scored and a 1.004 OPS in 12 games against the Brewers.

★Max Kepler is hitting .298 (14-for-47) with four doubles, one triple, five RBI, five walks and a .791 OPS in his last 14 games vs. the Brewers.

■ Carlos Santana played in 52 games for Milwaukee in 2023, after being acquired from Pittsburgh on July 27...he is hitting .308 (12-for-

39) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, four walks, six runs scored and a .911 OPS in his last 10 games against the Brewers. **THE OTHER GUYS:** The Twins are 10-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona and 1-2 at San Francisco...Minnesota is also 3-3 in home Interleague game this season.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Twins completed the 2024 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft on Tuesday afternoon...in total, the Twins selected 22 players, including: 11 right-handed pitchers, two left-handed pitchers, two catchers, five infielders and two outfielders... this included one player out of high school and 21 out of college.

◆ Minnesota selected shortstop Kaelen Culpepper with the 21st overall pick...Culpepper, 21, hit .328 (80-for-244) with 15 doubles, six triples, 11 home runs, 59 RBI, 35 walks, 17 stolen bases, a .419 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS in 61 games for Kansas State University in 2024, earning a spot on the All-Big 12 Second Team.

**ST. PAUL HAS BEEF STEW**: Brock Stewart tossed a scoreless inning on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo last night...he allowed one hit and struck out two batters in the appearance, and reached 96 mph with his fastball.

WELL PLAYED, MAUER: Twins legend Joe Mauer will be formally enshrined in the National Baseball Hall of Fame tomorrow, with a ceremony starting at 12:30pm CT on the grounds of the Clark Sports Center...the 2009 American League Most Valuable Player spent his entire 15-season career with his hometown Twins...some notes about Mauer's career and induction, courtesy of MLB Network.

◆ Mauer is the third catcher elected to HOF on first ballot (Johnny Bench, Ivan Rodriguez)...he is also the fourth player to make HOF after being drafted first overall (Ken Griffey Jr., Chipper Jones, Harold Baines)

◆ Mauer made his major league debut in 2004 and is the first Hall of Famer to play his entire career in the 2000s (debuted in 2004)... he is also the first player born in the 1980s to enter Cooperstown (born in 1983).

◆ Mauer is one of just eight single-team HOFers to play entire career in home state, joining Whitey Ford (New York), Lou Gehrig (New York), Charlie Gehringer (Michigan), Tony Gwynn (California), Barry Larkin (Ohio), Cal Ripken Jr. (Maryland) and Phil Rizzuto (New York)...only Harmon Killebrew (1,329) played more games in a Minnesota Twins uniform than Mauer (1,858).

◆ Mauer is also one of 22 retired MVPs to play their entire career of 15-plus seasons with one franchise — all are in the HOF.

**FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS:** National Baseball Hall of Famer and Twins legend Tony Oliva is celebrating his 86th birthday today...he shares a birthday with Macedonian king Alexander the Great, monk and geneticist Gregor Mendel and musician Carlos Santana, among others.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 2025: The Minnesota Twins, in conjunction with Major League Baseball, announced on Thursday their preliminary schedule for the 2025 regular season, the club's 65th campaign in Twins Territory...the Twins begin the 2025 season with their earliest Opening Day game ever, a Thursday, March 27 Interleague contest against the St. Louis Cardinals at Busch Stadium...the Twins will then host Houston at Target Field on Thursday, April 3, marking Minnesota's second Home Opener vs. the Astros (also a 3-2, 10-inning victory in 2023)...the Twins and Milwaukee Brewers will play a pair of three-game Border Battle sets, with Minnesota visiting American Family Field on May 16-18 as part of MLB's new "Rivalry Weekend" showcase; the Brewers play at Target Field from June 20-22.

ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EARS: Tomorrow's Border Battle season series finale will be streamed live and free on The Roku Channel, as part of Major League Baseball's Sunday Leadoff deal with Roku.
