TWINS LET ANOTHER GET AWAY AGAINST MILWAUKEE: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 8-7, suffering their sixth sweep of the season and first at home against the Brewers since June 24-25, 1998 at the Metrodome...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Jorge Alcala, Griffin Jax and Caleb Thielbar all combined to allow four runs in 3.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-5 and hit two solo home runs...for Buck, it marked his 12th career multi-homer game (2nd this season − 5/21 at WSH) and gave him seven home runs in his last 17 games overall.

◆ Target Field drew 78,006 in total attendance for the two-game Brewers series (41,679 on Saturday and 36,327 yesterday), the most in a two-game series in Target Field's history (since 2010), passing their 77,887 mark from May 10-11, 2011 vs. Detroit.

TWINS AND PHILS: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history today...they are 13-11 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium in 2002, 1-2 at the Metrodome in 2004, 5-4 at Target Field in 2012, '13 and '16, and 5-4 at Citizens Bank Park in 2010, '19 and '23.

♣ These two teams last met for a three-game series from August 11-13, 2023 at Citizens Bank Park, as the Twins took two of three.

♣ Minnesota last hosted the Phillies for a three-game series at Target Field from June 21-23, 2016 as the Twins took two of three.

♣ Max Kepler has hit safely in eight of nine career games against the Phillies, hitting .364 (12-for-33) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, a .389 on-base percentage, a .788 slugging percentage and a 1.177 OPS...over the three-game series in Philly last season, Kepler went 3-for-8 (.375) with one double, one home run and one walk.

♣ Carlos Santana played in 161 games for the Phillies in 2018 after signing as a free agent on December 20, 2017...after the 2018 season, he was traded to Seattle along with J.P. Crawford, in exchange for Juan Nicasio, James Pazos and Jean Segura.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 10-12 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona and 1-2 at San Francisco.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (26-for-78) with two doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI, a .628 slugging percentage and a 1.005 OPS in 20 games against the NL this season. his OPS ranks eighth-best among AL players (min. 80 PAs)... his batting average ranks 10th.

◆ Ryan Jeffers has posted a .916 OPS since the start of last season in IL Play, 13th-best among AL Players (minimum of 150 plate appearances) and 20th among all MLB players.

BUCK TRUCK ROLLING ALONG: Byron Buxton is hitting .364 (40-for-110) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 24 RBI, six walks, 27 runs scored, a .413 on-base percentage and a 1.113 OPS in his last 30 games, since June 7...since that date, he ranks among the major league leaders (minimum 100 plate appearances) in batting average (4th) and OPS (5th).

4 Buxton also has multiple hits in 10 of his last 17 games, since June 23; he's hitting .419 (26-for-62) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBI, four walks, 20 runs scored, a .471 on-base percentage and a 1.375 OPS in that span.

5 Byron's two home run yesterday gave him 126 for his career and moved him within six of tying Jacque Jones (132) for 15th on the club's all-time list (since 1961).

6 He now has 11 home runs on the season, marking his sixth-consecutive season with double-digit homers (since 2019)...he joins 12 other Twins to hit 10-plus homers in six-plus straight seasons: Kent Hrbek — 13, Harmon Killebrew — 12, Tony Oliva — 8, Justin Morneau — 7, Torii Hunter — 7, Miguel Sanó — 7, Eddie Rosario — 6, Brian Dozer — 6, Jacque Jones — 6, Tom Brunansky — 6, Gary Gaetti — 6 and Kirby Puckett — 6.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Minnesota enters today with a .783 OPS vs. left-handed pitching, the highest mark in the AL and second-highest in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (.793).

♣ Twins are slashing .332/.393/.545 (.938 OPS) in their last 25 games vs. lefties, including just a 16.9% strikeout rate.

♣ Willi Castro is hitting .341 (30-for-88) with a .940 OPS vs. left-handed pitching.

♣ Manny Margot is slashing .298/.347/.433 against lefties this season and .3137.361/.531 in his last 16 against southpaws.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .500 (11-for-22) with a 1.314 OPS in his last 12 games against lefties.

ICYMI: The Twins made a late roster move prior to yesterday's game against the Brewers, placing left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to July 18) with a left oblique strain...Funderburk, 27, has gone 1-0, 5.61 ERA (33.2 IP, 21 ER), one save, 15 walks, 31 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP in 26 appearances for the Twins this season. This is his first career stint on a major league Injured List...to replace Funderburk on the 26-man roster, the Iwins have recalled right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez from Triple-A St. Paul... Henriquez, 24, has gone 1-2, 3.63 ERA (44.2 IP, 18 ER), three saves, 13 walks, 46 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP in 28 games (1 start) for the Saints this season...this is his third stint with the Twins in 2024, after making scoreless appearances on April 22 vs. Chicago-AL (2.0 IP, 2 H, 1 BB, 2 K) and on June 26 at Arizona (1.0 IP, 1 K).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2021, the Twins acquired Joe Ryan (along with Drew Strotman) from Tampa Bay, in exchange for Nelson Cruz...at the time, Ryan was in Tokyo, Japan, participating in the delayed 2020 Olympics as a member of Team USA's baseball squad.
