THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their current five-game homestand, going 0-2 vs. Milwaukee over the weekend, followed by a win over Philadelphia last night...tonight, the Twins will host the Phillies for the second of three...they will wrap the series tomorrow afternoon, then travel to Detroit for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip, which includes an off-day on Thursday, three games at Comerica Park over the weekend, then three games in New York against the Mets from next Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 48-31 (.608) in its last 79 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (49-29, .628).

'GOOD LUCK TO EVERYONE IN THE CENTRAL': The Twins beat the Phillies last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2, snapping their three-game losing streak...Bailey Ober (9-5) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...his only two runs allowed came on a Bryce Harper two-run homer in the first inning...the offense recorded 12 hits, walked five times and went 5-for-15 with runners in scoring position...Carlos Santana went 2-for-4 with a double (18), an RBI (44) and a stolen base (3).

LIBERTY, LIBERTY, LIBERTY...LIBERTY: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this week...Twins are 14-11 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium in 2002, 1-2 at the Metrodome in 2004, 6-4 at Target Field in 2012, '13, '16 and '24, and 5-4 at Citizens Bank Park in 2010, '19 and '23.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in nine of 10 career games against the Phillies, hitting .389 (14-for-36) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, a .425 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.203 OPS...he has driven in a run in eight of the 10 games.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 11-12 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco and 1-0 vs. Philadelphia.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has posted a .919 OPS since the start of last season in IL Play, 13th-best among AL Players (minimum of 150 plate appearances) and 20th among all MLB players.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with five doubles in 14 games vs. the NL this season.

KEPING UP WITH THE REST OF THEM: Max Kepler drew one walk last night, giving him 408 for his career, tying Matt Lawton for 12th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...next on the list is Michael Cuddyer in 11th place with 411...the Twins leader is Harmon Killebrew with 1,321.

☞ Max also recorded his 499th career RBI last night, one short of becoming the 12th player in club history to reach the 500 RBI mark...he trails Killebrew (1,325), Hrbek (1,086), Puckett (1,085), Oliva (947), Mauer (923), Morneau (860), Hunter (792), Gaetti (758), Carew (733), Allison (642) and Cuddyer (580).

IS SOMEONE GETTING THE BEST OF YOU: A win tonight or tomorrow would give the Twins their 20th series victory (series results to the right)...they enter play today 19-11-2 in series play this season, going 9-6-0 at home and 10-5-2 on the road...their last series win was July 8-10 at Chicago-AL, going 0-2-0 since.

☞ Twins are 3-1-0 in series play against the Phillies, dating back to 2013.

☞ Twins are 3-4-1 in series play against the National League this season...their three wins are Washington (May 20-22), Colorado (June 10-12) and Arizona (June 25-27).

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: Trevor Larnach has posted a .916 OPS in his last 15 games, dating back to June 29...he enters today having reached base safely in each of his last 10 games, two games short of his career-high of 12, done April 19-May 2, 2023...the 10-game streak is the fourth-longest of his career, trailing the aforementioned 12 and two 11-game streaks (March 30-April 11, 2023 and April 19-May 5, 2024).

ROYCE ON REHAB: Royce Lewis will begin his rehab assignment tonight with Triple-A St. Paul as the Saints host Omaha at CHS Field at 7:07 pm (CT)...Lewis has missed the club's last 14 games with a right adductor strain.

BEFORE THE BREAK: Last pitched July 13 at San Francisco, opposite Hayden Birdsong, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-2 win...allowed two runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...stranded runners on first and third in the first inning...with two outs in the fourth, allowed a run on a walk and two hits...was pulled after Heliot Ramos' fifth-inning game-tying single.

- ⚡ Seven strikeouts were his second most in a start this season (8 K, 5/6 vs. SEA).
- ⚡ Induced 10 whiffs on 45 swings (22.2%)...ranks in MLB's 23rd percentile with a 21.7 percent whiff rate this season.
- ⚡ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); San Francisco went 4-for-7 on those swings...Woods Richardson ranks in MLB's 61st percentile with a 37.2 percent hard-hit rate.
- ⚡ Minnesota has won four-straight Woods Richardson starts and 12 of 16 overall.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started July 7 vs. Houston, opposite Spencer Arrighetti, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off win...allowed two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed both runs in the second inning on two singles and two walks...retired 13-straight batters from innings 2-6.

- ⚡ Induced 10 whiffs on 48 swings (20.8%).
- ⚡ Allowed only three hard-hit balls; Houston went 0-for-3 on those swings.

ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT: Has never faced Philadelphia or any of its current hitters...is 1-1 with a 2.61 ERA (20.2 IP, 6 ER) in four Interleague starts this season.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making eighth home start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2 IP, 15 ER), 8.60 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 3.35 walks-per-9.0 innings and 0.72 home-runs-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 2-1 with a 3.45 ERA (44.1 IP, 17 ER), 7.11 K/9, 2.03 BB/9 and 1.02 HR/9 in nine road starts...has allowed a .191 (26-for-136) opponent batting average and .563 OPS at home, compared to .257 (44-for-171) BAA and .706 OPS on the road.

REVERSE SPLITS: Through 16 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .208 (25-for-120) with a .275 slugging percentage, .567 OPS and 20.4 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .241 (45-for-187) with a .406 SLG, .690 OPS and 21.2 percent strikeout rate...righties have hit 18 of the 22 extra-base hits vs. Woods Richardson.

- ⚡ On July 13, San Francisco's lefties went 4-for-8 with a walk and two strikeouts vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 3-for-12 with two doubles and five strikeouts...four hits were his most allowed to left-handed hitters in a game this season.
- ⚡ Hard-hit rate vs. Woods Richardson: 35.5 percent by lefties, 39.0 percent by righties.
- ⚡ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 86.9 mph by lefties, 89.8 mph by righties.
- ⚡ Among right-handed pitchers, Woods Richardson has allowed the seventh-lowest SLG (.275) and 12th-lowest OPS (.567) to left-handed hitters (min. 100 LHB faced).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix this season...here's his 2024 repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ On July 13, San Francisco went 1-for-7 with four strikeouts vs. his slider...pitch has allowed the 10th-lowest batting average (.181), ninth-lowest slugging percentage (.284) and sixth-lowest hard-hit rate (26.7%) in baseball (min. 100 PA).
- ⚡ He's thrown the most 4-seamers in baseball (544) without allowing a home run.
- ⚡ In his last nine starts since May 28, opponents have hit .206 (13-for-63) and slugged .254 vs. his 4-seamer...in his first seven starts, the pitch allowed a .296 (16-for-54) batting average and .333 SLG.
- ⚡ Ranks in MLB's 85th percentile with a fastball run value of seven, 91st percentile with a breaking ball run value of five.

CAREER NOTES

- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
