 ♠ Minnesota has gone 48-32 (.600) in its last 80 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and tied with Los Angeles-NL (48-30, .615) for second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (50-29, .633).
 ♠ The Twins have gone 10-3 in rubber games this season, going 6-1 in their last seven chances.

WOODS AND WHEELER KEEP IT REAL TIGHT, BUT PHILS WIN: The Twins were shut out by the Phillies last night at larget Field by a score of 3-0, evening the three-game series at 1-1.. Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts, opposite Zack Wheeler.. Jhoan Duran allowed the only three runs on the night, coming in the top of the ninth inning on two hits...the offense recorded just three hits, a Matt Wallner double being the only extra-base hit of the game for Minnesota...Twins also went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position.

◆ The Iwins were shut out for the sixth time this season and first since June 8 (4-0 loss at PIT)...also their third time being shut out at larget Field, first since a 5-0 loss on May 16 vs. New York-AL...were shut out by the Phillies for just the second time all-time (also, a 3-0 loss on June 21, 2002 in Philadelphia).

BEEFING UP THE STAFF: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 60-day Injured List...additionally, the Iwins have recalled right-handed pitcher David Festa from Triple-A St. Paul.

♣ Stewart, 32, has missed the Iwins' last 70 games with right shoulder tendinitis...he appeared in four games on rehab assignment with the Saints, posting a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks, eight strikeouts and a .154 opponent batting average...prior to landing on the Injured List, he pitched in 13 games for the Iwins; pitched to a 0.68 ERA (13.1 IP, 1 ER) with seven holds, six walks, 17 strikeouts, and a .174 opponent batting average in those outings.

♣ Festa 24, has gone 3-3, 4 03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), 26 walks and 89 strikeouts in 15 starts for St. Paul this season..this is his second stint with the Iwins in 2024, going 1-1, 10.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 12 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts...Festa is the number four ranked prospect in the Iwins system by MLB.com.

♣ To make room for Stewart on the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have designated infielder Diego Castillo for release or assignment...to make room for Festa on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned Ronny Henriquez to Triple-A St. Paul...Castillo played in three games for the Twins, going 2-for-6 (.333) with one double, two RBI, two walks and three runs scored...Henriquez, who was recalled on Sunday, appeared last night, getting one out.

STARTING WITH STEVEN: Steven Okert made two starts as the Opener last season for Miami... the first was on July 16 at Baltimore, allowing three runs on four hits in 0.1 inning...the second was on September 10 at Philadelphia, allowing two runs on three hits in 0.2 innings pitched... the last time the Twins used an Opener was Emilio Pagán on September 30, 2023 at Colorado — the Twins' penultimate game of 2023.

LIBERTY, LIBERTY, LIBERTY: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 27th time in their history today. Twins are 14-12 all-time against Philadelphia going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium in 2002, 1-2 at the Metrodome in 2004, 6-5 at Target Field in 2012, '13, '16 and '24, and 5-4 at Citizens Bank Park in 2010, '19 and '23.

■ Max Kepler has hit safely in 10 of 11 career games against the Phillies, hitting .385 (15-for-39) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, a .432 on-base percentage, a .744 slugging percentage and a 1.175 OPS...he has driven in a run in eight of the 11 games.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 11-13 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco and 1-1 vs. Philadelphia...the Twins next NL opponent will be the Mets for three games at Citi Field from next Monday-Wednesday.

Byron Buxton is hifting .313 (26-for-83) with two doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI, a 590 slugging percentage and a .946 OPS in 22 games against the NL this season...his OPS ranks eighth-best among AL players (min. 80 PA)...his batting average ranks 10th.

VERY SERIES ISSUES: A win today would give the Twins their 20th series victory...they enter play today 19-11-2 in series play this season, going 9-6-0 at home and 10-5-2 on the road... their last series win was July 8-10 at Chicago-AL, going 0-2-0 since.

◆ Twins are 3-1-0 in series play against the Phillies, dating back to 2013.

◆ Twins are 3-4-1 in series play against the National League this season...their three wins are Washington (May 20-22), Colorado (June 10-12) and Arizona (June 25-27).

WE TALKIN' BOUT PRACTICE!: Royce Lewis (right adductor strain) made his first appearance on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night, going 0-for-3 with two strikeouts, playing third base...Justin Topa (left patellar tendinitis) also made his first rehab appearance last night for Low-A Fort Myers, pitchin 1.0 scoreless inning, with one walk and one strikeout.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2022, Jim Kaat and Tony Oliva were enshrined into the National Baseball Hall of Fame, becoming the fifth and sixth Twins to go into the hall and first two to be inducted in the same class...Joe Mauer became the seventh last weekend.
