**THE TWINS:** Completed their five-game homestand with a record of 2-3, going 0-2 vs. Milwaukee last weekend and 2-1 vs. Philadelphia this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game roadtrip with three games at Comerica Park over the weekend, followed by three games in New York against the Mets from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 49-32 in its last 81 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and tied with Los Angeles-NL (49-31) for second most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (50-30).

**SLIM REAP GETS THE BULK, KEPLER GETS THE DUB:** The Twins beat the Phillies on Wednesday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-4, making them 17-13 in one-run games this season and taking the series from the winningest team in baseball...Steven Okert was the Opener and recorded just one out before being relieved by David Festa...Festa, in his third career appearance, allowed just one run on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and a career-high seven strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, two apiece from Max Kepler and Carlos Santana...Santana tied the game in the seventh inning with a two-run double, while Kepler drove in the winning run with an infield groundball in the bottom of the ninth...for Kepler, it marked his 11th career walk-off plate appearance, tying Harmon Killebrew and Kirby Puckett for most in Twins history (1961-present).

**PHILLY SPECIAL:** Twins pitchers finished the three-game series with Philadelphia, posting a 3.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks, 25 strikeouts and a .198 opponent batting average...Twins starters — Bailey Ober (Monday), Simeon Woods Richardson (Tuesday) and Wednesday's "bulk" pitcher David Festa — combined to allow three runs on 11 hits in 17.1 innings pitched (1.56 ERA), with four walks and 16 strikeouts.

**ROYCE RETURNS:** The Twins have returned infielder Royce Lewis from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Lewis, who missed the club's last 16 games with a right adductor strain, played in two games on rehab assignment this week with Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-for-6 with one double and one walk...prior to landing on the IL, Lewis hit .292 (26-for-89) with five doubles, 10 home runs, 18 RBI, 18 runs scored, nine walks, a .354 on-base percentage, a .685 slugging percentage and a 1.039 OPS...to make room for Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned catcher Jair Camargo to St. Paul after Wednesday's game against Philadelphia...Camargo appeared in two games during his most recent stint with the Twins, going 0-for-2.

**TIGER THINGS:** The Twins and Tigers are already playing their final series of the season this weekend, marking the 11th, 12th and 13th games of 2024 between these two...Minnesota has gone 5-5 against the Tigers this season, going 2-2 at Comerica Park and 3-3 at Target Field. ☞ The Twins took the last series 2-1 at Target Field from July 2-4...the Twins' previous series at Comerica came April 12-14, splitting with Detroit 2-2, winning both games in a doubleheader on April 13.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 127, 25 ahead of Cleveland (102).

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.057 OPS in his last nine games at Comerica Park...Jeffers is 9-for-29 (.310) with two doubles, two home runs, three walks and 10 RBI against the Tigers this season overall.

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a .991 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Tigers...he has hit safely in each of his last seven vs. Detroit...he homered in his first career at-bat (\*shocker\*) in this ballpark on June 23, 2023, off Joey Wentz.

☞ During the four-game series at Comerica Park in April, the Twins starters posted a 2.86 ERA (22.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks, 27 strikeouts (11.0 K/9.0 IP) with a .205 opponent average.

**LOOKIN' LIKE A MILLION BUX:** Byron Buxton is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with seven doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 12 runs scored, a .426 on-base percentage, a .688 slugging percentage and a 1.113 OPS in 14 games this month...among all AL players with a minimum of 50 July plate appearances, he ranks sixth in average, tied for sixth in slugging, seventh in OPS and tied for 10th in on-base percentage.

**THE GAME OF LOVE:** In his last 34 games, since June 11, Carlos Santana is slashing .303/.394/.529 (.924 OPS)...below are his comparisons through games of June 10 and since June 11:

**I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS:** Trevor Larnach has posted an .842 OPS in his last 17 games, dating back to June 29...he enters today having reached base safely in each of his last 12 games, matching his career-high, previously done from April 19-May 2, 2023...during the current streak, he has posted a .395 on-base percentage.

**TWO STRIKES, CALLS TIMEOUT, TAKES HELMET OFF, WIPES FACE WITH BOTH SLEEVES, HITS BALL 9-BILLION MILES:** Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Matt Wallner has hit .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, three home runs, a .444 on-base percentage, a .742 slugging percentage and a 1.186 OPS in 11 games...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in average exit velocity at 100.8 mph (minimum of 250 pitches seen) and eighth in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 19.4%.

**BACK FROM THE BREAK:** Last pitched July 20 vs. Milwaukee, opposite Freddy Peralta, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 12-inning, 8-4 loss...allowed one run on four hits in 7.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...only run came on Jackson Chourio's third-inning RBI single...only three runners reached scoring position.

- ☞ Threw 109 pitches, the second most of his career and most since June 4, 2022 vs. San Francisco (110 pitches).
- ☞ Induced 11 whiffs on 52 swings (21.2%)...ranks in MLB's 72nd percentile with a 28.0 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Milwaukee went 2-for-6 on those swings...López ranks in MLB's 43rd percentile with a 39.6 percent hard-hit rate.

**STOPPING THE SLUGGING:** Has allowed four total extra-base hits over his last five starts since June 23, tied for the fewest in a five-start span in his career...has a 1.7 percent home run rate (2 HR in 119 PA) over his last five starts, compared to a 4.7 percent rate (16 HR in 340 PA) in his first 15 starts. Here's how López has improved in his last five starts:

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started July 10, opposite Drew Thorpe, in Game 2 of the doubleheader at Chicago-AL, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 win...allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...yielded two hits and one run in the second inning, then a solo home run to Martín Maldonado in the third...stranded two baserunners in the fourth.

- ☞ Induced 18 whiffs on 58 swings (31.0%).
- ☞ Allowed eight hard-hit balls; White Sox went 2-for-8 on those swings.

**PABLO VS. DETROIT:** Started at Comerica Park on April 12 and took the loss in Minnesota's 8-2 defeat; allowed five runs on six hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings, with three walks and seven strikeouts...allowed a first-inning home run to Mark Canha...faced four batters in the fifth but retired none...4.0 innings is tied for his shortest start this season; also threw 4.0 innings 4/23 vs. Chicago-AL and 6/6 at New York-AL.

- ☞ Has made three career starts vs. Detroit, all at Comerica from 2023-24; is 1-2 with a 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks, 25 strikeouts and a .261 (18-for-69) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Canha is 5-for-10 with a double, a home run, two walks and three RBI in his career vs. López.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making 11th road start of the season...has gone 5-3 with a 4.58 ERA (57.0 IP, 29 ER), 11.37 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 2.37 walks-per-9.0 innings and 1.74 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 3-4 with a 5.17 ERA (54.0 IP, 31 ER), 9.33 K/9, 1.50 BB/9 and 1.17 HR/9 in 10 home starts.

- ☞ Has a 1.04 WHIP and .660 opponent OPS on the road, 1.28 WHIP and .754 OPS at home.
- ☞ Batting average on balls in play vs. López: .252 on the road, .346 at home.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 20 games vs. López, left-handed hitters have hit .257 (54-for-210) with a .452 SLG, .741 OPS, 27.2 percent strikeout rate, 4.0 percent walk rate and 4.5 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .231 (50-for-216) with a .389 SLG, .674 OPS, 28.5 percent strikeout rate, 6.4 percent walk rate and 3.4 percent home run rate.

- ☞ On July 20, Milwaukee's lefties went 1-for-10 with a double, a walk and four strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 3-for-13 with three strikeouts.
- ☞ Whiff rate: 25.8 percent vs. lefties, 30.2 percent vs. righties.
- ☞ Hard-hit rate vs. López: 34.4 percent by lefties, 45.3 percent by righties...among right-handed pitchers, has allowed the fifth-highest hard-hit rate to right-handed hitters (min. 200 RHB faced).
