LONG ROAD TO RUIN: After completing their five-game homestand with a record of 2-3 (0-2 vs. Milwaukee and 2-1 vs. Philadelphia), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win in Detroit last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Comerica Park...after tomorrow's series finale against the Tigers, the Twins will travel to New York to play the Mets at Citi Field from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 50-32 in its last 82 games since April 22, tied with Philadelphia (50-31) for the most wins in baseball since that date.

EVER-LONG BALLS LEAD TWINS TO W: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 9-3...Pablo López (9-7) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, four of which were home runs by Byron Buxton (12) Trevor Larnach (11), Matt Wallner (5) and Christian Vázquez (5)...it marked the fourth time this season with at least four homers and one short of the season high of five (April 25 vs. CWS)...Vázquez and Brooks Lee each had three hits on the night, tying their season highs...Wallner, Lee and Vázquez — batting in the 7, 8 and 9 spots — combined to go 7-for-11 with four walks and four RBI.

I'LL STICK AROUND: The Twins have returned infielder Jose Miranda from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Miranda, who missed the club's last nine games with a low back strain, played in two games on rehab assignment this week with Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-for-6 with one double and two walks...prior to landing on the IL, Miranda played in 76 games for the Twins, hitting .325 (83-for-255) with 21 doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 43 RBI, 35 runs scored, 14 walks, a .366 on-base percentage, a .522 slugging percentage and an .888 OPS...to make room for Miranda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Edouard Julien to Triple-A St. Paul.

WAITING ON A WAR: The Twins and Tigers are playing their final series of the season this weekend, marking the 11th, 12th and 13th games of 2024 between these two...Minnesota has gone 6-5 against the Tigers this season, going 3-2 at Comerica Park and 3-3 at Target Field.

☞ A win today or tomorrow and the Twins will secure the season series against the Tigers, which would mark the first time since 2022 (11-8) after going 5-8 vs. Detroit in 2023...prior to this season, the Twins have won the season series six of the last seven times.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 131, 29 ahead of Cleveland (102).

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.057 OPS in his last nine games at Comerica Park...Jeffers is 9-for-29 (.310) with two doubles, two home runs, three walks and 10 RBI against the Tigers this season overall.

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a .915 OPS in 11 career games vs. the Tigers...he has hit safely in each of his last eight vs. Detroit.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with three doubles and a .983 OPS in nine games vs. the Tigers this season...he recorded five hits (3 2B) in his last game vs. Detroit on July 4.

LEARN TO FLY-RON: Byron Buxton is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with eight doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, 13 runs scored, a .424 on-base percentage, a .736 slugging percentage and a 1.160 OPS in 15 games this month...among all AL players with a minimum of 50 July plate appearances, he ranks fourth in OPS and slugging, sixth in average, and 10th in OBP.

THERE'S NOTHING LEFT TO LOSE: Minnesota enters today with a .784 OPS vs. left-handed pitching, the highest mark in baseball...their .451 SLG vs. lefties also leads baseball.

☞ Twins are slashing .329/.390/.529 (.919 OPS) in their last 29 games vs. lefties.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .337 (31-for-92) with a .921 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...his .337 average ranks sixth-best among AL players, 12th in baseball.

☞ Manny Margot is slashing .292/.346/.427 against lefties this season and .333/.369/.483 in his last 29 against southpaws...Margot is 4-for-10 with a home run lifetime against Skubal.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with a 1.118 OPS in his last 14 games against lefties...Buck has two hits in nine career at-bats against Skubal, both solo home runs.

☞ Carlos Santana is slashing .303/.354/.573 (.927 OPS) against lefties this season.

THERE 'LOS MY HERO: In his last 35 games, since June 11, Carlos Santana is slashing .293/.387/.512 (.900 OPS)...below are his comparisons through games of June 10 and since June 11:

BIG ME-RANDA: Jose Miranda is hitting an MLB-best .415 (39-for-94) since June 9, including 12 doubles, three home runs, 23 RBI, a .462 on-base percentage, a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.101 OPS over the 27-game stretch...in nine games this month, he is hitting .515 (17-for-33) with a 1.300 OPS.

IS SOMEONE GETTING THE BEST OF YOU: A win today or tomorrow would give the Twins their 21st series victory of the season...they enter play today 20-11-2 in series play in 2024, going 10-6-0 at home and 10-5-2 on the road...they are 4-1-0 in their last five road series...their last series win vs. Detroit was July 2-4 (2-1) at Target Field...their last series win at Comerica Park was June 23-25, 2023 (2-1).

WE RUN: The Twins enter today with 498 runs scored, two short of becoming the seventh team in baseball to reach 500: New York-AL (520), Los Angeles-NL (516), Arizona (513), Baltimore (510), New York-NL (504) and Philadelphia (501)...Minnesota didn't score their 500th run of 2023 until August 6.

☞ Twins are on pace to score 790 runs this season, which would match their 1969 total for 10th most in club history (record is 939 in 2019).

TIMES LIKE THESE: On this day in 1991, Dan Gladden hit a walk-off, three-run homer in the ninth inning to give the Twins a 7-4 win over Milwaukee at the Metrodome...it was in the middle of a five-game stretch in which Gladden drove in 12 runs (4, 3, 3, 1 & 1).

HELLO, I'VE WAITED HERE FOR YOU...EVERLONG: The Foo Fighters will be at Target Field tomorrow night on stop six of their "Everything or Nothing at All" Tour...it is the band's first ever trip with Target Field and one of 12 rock 'n' roll marathons at 10 stadiums for the FOOS this summer.

☞ Target Field's last major concert was Pink's "Summer Carnival" Tour on August 10, 2023, drawing a Target Field-record crowd of 44,627.

- Making 21st start of 2024 and 82nd of career...took a no-decision in previous start July 21 vs. Milwaukee, allowing four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts. Making his third start vs. Detroit this season...in his previous two starts he is 0-0, 3.18 ERA (11.1 IP, 4 ER), two walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.32 WHIP. Ranks third among qualified pitchers with a 6.84 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 21 vs. Milwaukee...didn't factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts; Twins lost, 8-7...retired the first eight batters he faced before Eric Haase's third-inning solo home run...allowed three runs on four hits in the fifth...was his fifth start this season with 6.0-or-more innings and zero walks; has completed 6.0-or-more innings in 13 of 20 starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on July 12 at San Francisco...took his sixth loss of the season in a 7-1 Twins loss, allowing five runs on six hits in 5.1 innings, with three walks and six strikeouts...allowed three runs in the first two innings...pitched scoreless third and fourth innings before runs in innings 5-6...collected his 500th career strikeout in the third inning, a swinging strikeout by Heliot Ramos. Posted a season-high three walks.

VS. DETROIT: Facing the Detroit Tigers for the third time this season and ninth of his career. In two starts this season vs. Detroit he is 0-0, 3.18 ERA (11.1 IP, 4 ER), two walks, 18 strikeouts a 1.32 WHIP and a .277 (13-for-47) opponent batting average. Had a career-high 12 strikeouts this season on April 13 in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Detroit...allowed three runs (1 ER) on six hits (1 HR) and one walk taking a no-decision in a 11-5 Twins win. Making his ninth career start vs. Detroit...in previous eight he has gone 4-1, 3.47 ERA (46.2 IP, 18 ER), seven walks, 63 strikeouts, a 0.99 WHIP and a .219 (39-for-178) opponent batting average. Making his fourth career start at Comerica Park...in his prior three he is 2-0, 1.02 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER), three walk, 27 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .217 (15-for-69) opponent batting average. Has 63 career strikeouts vs. Detroit are his most against any single opponent in his career.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Through 10 road starts in 2024, Ryan has gone 2-3 with a 3.28 ERA (60.1 IP, 22 ER), 12 walks, 66 strikeouts and eight home runs allowed, compared to 4-3, 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), seven walks, 64 strikeouts and nine home runs in 10 home starts. In 39 career road starts, he is 14-13, 4.17 ERA (215.2 IP, 100 ER), 50 walks, 228 strikeouts and 18 quality starts...Twins are 22-17 in Ryan's 39 road starts. Twins are 6-4 this season on the road when Ryan starts. Since making his debut in 2021, he leads Twins pitchers with 14 road wins...has two road wins this season, trailing Steven Okert (3), Bailey Ober (4) and Pablo López (6).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .204/.240/.367 with eight home runs, nine walks and 57 strikeouts in 233 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .245/.283/.451 with nine home runs, 10 walks and 73 strikeouts in 251 plate appearances. Over his career, lefties are batting .207 (170-for-823) with 32 doubles, five triples, 28 home runs and a .628 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .243 (219-for-902) with 55 doubles, three triples, 45 home runs and a .745 OPS. In his last start against Milwaukee, left-handed hitters went 1-for-9 with no walks and two strikeouts...right-handed hitters went 6-for-16 with two doubles, one home run and five strikeouts. In two starts this season, Detroit left-handed hitters have hit .360 (9-for-25) with three extra-base hits, one walk and nine strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .182 (4-for-22) with one double, one walk and nine strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 20 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and sinker the most, combining to throw the two pitches 62.5 percent of the time in his last start against Milwaukee...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant: PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. (# OF PITCHES, VS. RHB/LHB) RESULTS 4-Seam Fastball (94.0)...48.1% (904 pitches, 476/428) .200 (41-for-205), 11 2B, 4 3B, 6 HR, 71 K Split Finger (88.6)...22.6% (425 pitches, 132/293) .209 (24-for-115), 4 2B, 6 HR, 28 K Sweeper (81.6)...15.5% (292 pitches, 205/87) .218 (17-for-78), 4 2B, 3 HR, 27 K Slider (87.1)...7.9% (148 pitches, 93/55) .353 (12-for-34), 3 2B, 2 HR, 1 K Sinker (93.0)...6.0% (112 pitches, 111/1) .346 (9-for-26), 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 K In his last seven starts since June 13, opponents have hit .205 (16-for-78) with 27 strikeouts against Ryan's 4-seam fastball.

ZONE DEFENSE: 55% of Ryan's pitches this season have been in the zone, the eighth-highest percentage in baseball...among all starters with a minimum of 110.0 innings pitched, he ranks third in the AL in lowest walk percentage at 3.9%...additionally, he ranks sixth on that same list in K% (26.9%) and second in soft contact percentage at 20.3%.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Enters today with 508 career strikeouts, 25th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up are Jim Merritt and Scott Erickson, tied for 23rd with 527 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020. Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K). In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197). Made his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151). Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K). Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts. Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA. In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season. In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts). Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August. Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts. Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus. Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.
