- ☞ Making 20th start of season and 77th of career.
☞ Last pitched on July 22 vs. the Philadelphia Phillies, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...earned his ninth win of the season in a 7-2 Twins win.
☞ Facing the Detroit Tigers for the fourth time this season...in previous three starts he is 2-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts, a 0.72 WHIP and a .179 (12-for-67) opponent batting average.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 22 vs. the Philadelphia Phillies...earned his ninth win of the season, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...

- ☞ Recorded his 10th quality start of the season.
☞ Recorded his ninth win of the season, setting a new career high.
☞ Has recorded a quality start in each of his last six starts, the second-longest such streak of his career...had seven-straight quality starts from June 14-July 23, 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on July 10 at Chicago-AL in the first game of a doubleheader...took his fifth loss of the season...tossed four scoreless innings to begin his outing before allowing a sacrifice fly to Paul DeLong in the fifth inning; later allowed a two-run home run in the sixth inning to Luis Robert Jr...allowed three runs on four hits, one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched.

LAST SIX STARTS: In his last six starts, Ober has gone 4-1, 2.23 ERA (40.1 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 45 strikeouts, a 0.84 WHIP and a .190 (27-for-142) opponent batting average...in five June starts he went 2-1, 3.19 ERA (31.0 IP, 11 ER), 11 walks, 34 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .190 (27-for-142) opponent batting average.

- ☞ All six starts have been quality starts.

VS. DETROIT: Making his fourth start this season and 11th of his career vs. Detroit Tigers.

- ☞ Making his fourth start this season...in previous three he is 2-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts a 0.72 WHIP and a .179 (12-for-67) opponent batting average.
☞ Making his 11th career start vs. Detroit...in previous 10 he is 3-2, 3.91 ERA (53.0 IP, 23 ER), 10 walks, 56 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP and a .267 (56-for-210) opponent batting average.
☞ Making his sixth career start at Comerica Park...in previous five he is 1-2, 4.34 ERA (29.0 IP, 14 ER), two walks, 29 strikeouts a 1.21 WHIP and a .284 opponent batting average...has made one start this season at Comerica Park on April 14, allowing no runs and three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a no-decision; Twins lost, 4-3.
☞ 29 strikeouts at Comerica Park are the most on the road against any opponent...also, 56 strikeouts against Detroit are the second most against any opponent in his career trailing Chicago-AL (65).

BACK ON THE ROAD : Making his 12th road start of the season today...in previous 11, has gone 4-4 with a 4.67 ERA (61.2 IP, 32 ER), 15 walks, 61 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .222 (50-for-225) opponent batting average...in eight home starts, he is 5-1, 3.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 16 ER), 10 walks, 49 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .225 (38-for-169) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Has gone 10-12 with a 3.98 ERA (206.0 IP, 91 ER) in 39 career road starts compared to a 12-5 with a 3.49 ERA (193.2 IP, 75 ER) in 37 career home starts.
☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is third in road wins on the Twins with 10, trailing Pablo López (11) and Joe Ryan (14)...has four road wins this season.

REVERSE SPLITS: On July 22, Philadelphia left-handed hitters went 2-for-9, with one home and no strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 2-for-15, with four strikeouts.

- ☞ Lefties have a 26.7 percent whiff rate and 86.3 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 29.0 percent whiff rate and 88.8 mph average exit velocity.
☞ Through 19 games this season, lefties have hit .209 (36-for-172) with a .655 OPS and 25.5 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .234 (52-for-222) with a .724 OPS and 29.7 percent strikeout rate.
☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .241 (167-for-693) with 38 doubles, three triples, 22 home runs and a .694 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .230 (186-for-807) with 33 doubles, six triples, 41 home runs and a .706 OPS.
☞ In three starts this season, Detroit left-handed hitters are hitting .156 (5-for-32), three extra base hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts...right-handed hitters are hitting .200 (7-for-35), two doubles and seven strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seam fastball and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through 19 starts:

- ☞ In his last four starts against hitters have hit .173 (8-for-46) with 13 strikeouts against Ober's 4-seam fastball and cutter.

CAREER NOTES

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
• In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
• In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
• Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
• Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
• Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
• In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
• Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
• Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
• Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
• Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
• In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
• Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
• Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 3-1, 3.27 ERA // CAREER: 3-2, 3.59 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the first of a three-game series at New York-NL...last pitched on July 23 vs. Philadelphia Phillies, took a no-decision after tossing 6.0 innings and allowing no runs on three hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...set to face New York-NL for the first time in his career -- was originally selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and traded to Toronto on July 28, 2019...will be making his sixth Interleague start of the season, in previous five he is 1-1, 2.03 ERA (26.2 IP, 6 ER), five walks, 23 strikeouts a 1.05 WHIP and a .235 (23-for-98) opponent batting average.
