♣ Minnesotá has gone 50-33 in its last 83 games since April 22, the most wins in the AL and second-most in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (51-31).

♣ The Twins have gone 11-3 in rubber games this season, including 7-1 in their last eight chances.

TIGERS THROW MONKEY WRENCH IN TWINS PLANS: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 7-2, allowing seven unanswered runs...Joe Ryan (6-7) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two from Royce Lewis, who hit a two-run homer in the first inning, his 11th home run of the season.

BACK AND FORTH: The Twins and Tigers are playing their final game of the season today...

Minnesota has gone 6-6 against the Tigers, going 3-3 at Comerica Park and 3-3 at Target Field.

◆ These two will meet for the first time in 2025 for a three-game weekend series at Target Field from April 11-13...their first trip to Comerica will be a three-game weekend series from June 27-29.

◆ A win today and the Twins will secure the season series against the Tigers, which would mark the first time since 2022 (11-8) after going 5-8 vs. Detroit in 2023...prior to this season, the Twins have won the season series six of the last seven tries.

◆ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 132, 30 ahead of Cleveland (102).

◆ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and a .940 OPS in his last 10 games at Comerica Park.

◆ Royce Lewis is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with three doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and a 1.020 OPS in 12 career games vs. the Tigers...he has hit safely in each of his last nine vs. Detroit.

◆ Jose Miranda is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with three doubles and a .915 OPS in 10 games vs. the Tigers this season.

THERE IS NOTHING LEFT TO LEWIS: Royce Lewis hit his 28th home run in his 96th career game last night...the Twins record (since 1961) for most home runs in a player's first 100 career games is 21, held by Miguel Sanó (2015-16) and Justin Morneau (2003-04).

♣ Lewis' 8.91 at-bat-per-home run ratio this season leads baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances), ahead of Aaron Judge (10.00) and Mike Trout (10.90).

♣ Royce's 162-game averages are: .304 batting average with 29 doubles, 47 home runs, 130 RBI, 101 runs scored, 51 walks, 10 stolen bases and a .950 OPS.

◆ Cespedes, 23, played in six games for the Kernels, hitting .391 (9-for-23) with three home runs, eight RBI, three walks and a 1.264 OPS, including a two-homer game on Sunday vs. Wisconsin...the Azua, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins in April of 2019.

◆ Raya, 21, made the start on Friday at Amarillo, pitching a season-high 5.0 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the Laredo, Texas native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft...he is ranked as the club's eighth-best prospect by MLB.com, third among pitchers.

**BIG ME:** Right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala is celebrating his 29th birthday today...he has never appeared in a major league game on his birthday.
