THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their current six-game roadtrip, winning a three-game series in Detroit over the weekend...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three against the Mets at Citi Field.

Minnesota has gone 51-33 in its last 84 games since April 22, tied with Philadelphia (51-32) for most wins in baseball...since that date, they have gone 24-18 in road games, the fifth-most away wins in baseball.

On the season, the Twins are 29-25 on the road, tied for seventh-most road wins in baseball.

BAILEY DOMINATES IN DETROIT: The Twins shut out the Tigers at Comerica Park yesterday afternoon, winning by a score of 5-0, their fifth shutout of the season...Bailey Ober (10-5) was the starter and winner, pitching 8.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts...Caleb Thielbar pitched 1.0 inning of relief and completed the one-hitter, the 22nd in Twins history, first since June 25, 2022 vs. Colorado...the offense recorded 12 hits, three apiece from Willi Castro and Manny Margot...Castro also added a walk, tring a single-game career-high by reaching safely four times.

MEET THE METS: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this week...Minnesota is 10-15 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-6 at Citi Field, 2-6 at Target Field...Twins are just 3-11 vs. the Mets dating back to June of 2010.

These two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from September 8-10, 2023, as Minnesota won the first two games and lost the third...Twins outscored the Mets 13-8 in that series.

The last time the Twins played at Citi Field was for a two-game series from April 9-10, 2019, splitting 1-1...that 14-8 win on April 9, 2019, is their only win in this ballpark in their last six tries.

Last season, Willi Castro went 6-for-11 (.545) with one double, one triple and one home run over the three-game series with the Mets at Target Field.

Manny Margot is hitting .357 (30-for-84) with four doubles, three triples, three home runs, 14 RBI and a .965 OPS in 24 career games against the Mets.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins are 12-13 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco and 2-1 vs. Philadelphia.

Byron Buxton is hitting .314 (27-for-86) with three doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI, a .593 slugging percentage and a .955 OPS in 23 games against the NL this season...his OPS ranks fifth-best among AL players (min. 90 PA)...his batting average ranks seventh.

MR. (INTER)NATIONAL: Max Kepler has played in 169 Interleague games in his career, slashing .259/.336/.459 (.795 OPS)...below are his all-time Twins ranks in IL Play:

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis hit his 28th home run in his 96th career game on Saturday night...the Twins record (since 1961) for most home runs in a player's first 100 career games is 21, held by Miguel Sanó (2015-16) and Justin Morneau (2003-04).

Lewis' 8.91 at-bat-per-home run ratio this season leads baseball (minimum of 100 plate appearances), ahead of Aaron Judge (10.08) and Mike Trout (10.90).

Royce's 162-game averages are: .304 batting average with 28 doubles, 47 home runs, 129 RBI, 100 runs scored, 52 walks, 10 stolen bases and a .951 OPS.

MAR-GOAT: In his last 25 games, since June 22, Manny Margot is slashing .294/.319/.441 (.761 OPS)...below are his comparisons through games of June 21 and since June 22:

LEFT SIDE IS THE BEST SIDE: Minnesota enters today with a .778 OPS vs. left-handed pitching, the best in the AL and third-highest mark in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (.780) and Philadelphia (.780)...additionally, their .446 slugging percentage leads baseball.

Twins are slashing .320/.382/.509 (.891 OPS) in their last 31 games vs. lefties.

Willi Castro is hitting .323 (31-for-96) with an .884 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...his .323 average ranks 10th-best among AL players.

Manny Margot is slashing .290/.348/.420 against lefties this season and .328/.371/.469 in his last 31 against southpaws.

Byron Buxton is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with a 1.006 OPS in his last 15 games against lefties.

Carlos Santana is slashing .312/.360/.570 (.930 OPS) against lefties this season... .385/.455/.718 (1.172 OPS) in last 21 vs. lefties.

STRIKING COMPARISONS: The Twins have posted a 20.5% strikeout percentage (163 K/796 PA) through 20 games this month, the fifth-lowest in the AL and ninth-lowest in baseball for the month...by comparison, they posted a 24.9% strikeout rate in April, 21.4% in May and 17.5% in June.

Overall, they posted a 23.2% strikeout rate (542 K/2335 PA) in their first 63 games, compared to 18.0% (293 K/1637 PA) in their last 41.
