On the season, the Twins are 29-25 on the road, tied for seventh-most road wins in baseball.

**BAILEY DOMINATES IN DETROIT:** The Twins shut out the Tigers at Comerica Park yesterday afternoon, winning by a score of 5-0, their fifth shutout of the season...Bailey Ober (10-5) was the starter and winner, pitching 8.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and a career-high 11 strikeouts...Caleb Thielbar pitched 1.0 inning of relief and completed the one-hitter, the 22nd in Twins history, first since June 25, 2022 vs. Colorado...the offense recorded 12 hits, three apiece from Willi Castro and Manny Margot...Castro also added a walk, tring a single-game career-high by reaching safely four times.

◆ These two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from September 8-10, 2023, as Minnesota won the first two games and lost the third...Twins outscored the Mets 13-8 in that series.
