THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, winning a three-game series 2-1 in Detroit over the weekend, followed by a loss in Queens to the Mets last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three against the Mets at Citi Field...after tomorrow afternoon's game, they will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the White Sox for three over the weekend.

Minnesota has gone 51-34 in its last 85 games since April 22, tied with Philadelphia (51-33) for most wins in baseball.

The Twins have 57 games left this season...they have an opponent winning percentage of .492 in their final 57, tied for third-lowest strength of schedule in baseball remaining.

TWINS GET BIT BAD IN BIG APPLE: The Twins lost to the Mets last night at Citi Field by a score of 1.5-2, their largest margin of defeat since a 1.5-2 loss on July 9, 2023 vs. Baltimore at Target Field...Simeon Woods Richardson (3-2) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing a career-high six runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings pitched, including three walks...Josh Staumont allowed five runs in 0.1 inning of relief and Brock Stewart allowed four runs in 0.2 innings... the offense recorded nine hits, as Byron Buxton and Max Kepler each reached three times... Ryan Jeffers hit his 15th home run of the season, setting a new single-season career-high. 

© Outfielder Matt Wallner pitched 1.1 scoreless inning of relief...did you know that Wallner has now made more pitching appearances at Citi Field than three-time All-Star Glen Perkins?

GIVE US ALL THE TREVORS: The Twins have acquired right-handed pitcher Trevor Richards via trade with Toronto, in exchange for minor league infielder Jay, Harry. Richards, 31, has appeared in 45 games (2 starts) for the Jays this season, going 2-1, 4.64 ERA (52.1 IP, 27 ER), seven holds, 24 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .189 (36-for-190) opponent batting average... left-handed batters have slashed .175/.256/.250 against him and right-handers have slashed .200/.294/.391...he has posted an xBA of .202 this season, ranking in the 91st percentile among all major league pitchers...additionally, since the start of last season, he has posted an 11.09 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio (154 K/125.0 IP), the eighth best in the AL (min. of 100.0 IP)...The Aviston, Illinois native has played parts of seven major league seasons with the Marlins (2018-19), Rays (2019-21), Brewers (2021) and Jays(2021-24)...since the start of 2022, he has appeared in 163 games, 12th most among AL pitchers.

**WELCOME BACK, DOBBER:** The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak from Triple-A St. Paul...Dobnak, 29, has appeared in 21 games (19 starts) for the Saints this season, going 9-5, 3.61 ERA (99.2 IP, 40 ER), 43 walks and 102 strikeouts...over his last eight Triple-A starts, since June 15, Dobnak has gone 5-0, 1.70 ERA (42.1 IP, 8 ER), 16 walks and 42 strikeouts...the 6-foot-1, 230-pound right-hander pitched parts of three seasons for the Twins from 2019-21, going 9-12, 4.94 ERA (125.2 IP, 69 ER), 30 walks and 77 strikeouts in 33 games (21 starts)...he last appeared in a major league game for Minnesota on September 3, 2021 at Tampa Bay.

TALKIN' NEW YORK: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this week...Minnesota is 10-16 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-7 at Citi Field, 2-6 at Target Field.

◆ Twins are just 1-6 in their last seven games at Citi Field since June of 2010...their only win in that span was a 14-8 victory on April 9, 2019...in that game, the Twins hit five home runs, three coming off Jacob deGrom (2 from Mitch Garver).

◆ Manny Margot is hitting .364 (32-for-88) with five doubles, three triples, three home runs, 14 RBI and a .978 OPS in 25 career games against the Mets.
