KUIAIIUNAL PULL: In 20 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 8-5, 3.15 ERA (108.2 IP, 38 ER) with 13 home runs allowed, 28 walks and 116 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .195 batting average...in that span, they rank second in baseball in ERA and WHIP (0.97), third in opponent batting average, and fifth in strikeouts-per-9.0 (9.61).

MATT WALLNER, FROM FOREST RAKE: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, Matt Wallner has hit .349 (22-for-63) with eight doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, a .453 on-base percentage, a .794 slugging percentage and a 1.247 OPS in 21 games. ◆ He has reached safely in 12 consecutive starts since July 21.

◆ He leads all MLB hitters (minimum of 40 plate appearances) with a 95.9 mph average

exit velocity.

BYR-ON AND ON AND ON: Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (47-for-141) with 15 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 30 RBI, 33 runs scored, a .399 on-base percentage, a .688 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS in his last 41 games since June 11...since that date, he ranks second (min. 150 PA) in baseball in slugging, fifth in OPS and batting average, and 11th in or bear percentage.

RIZZ LEWIS: Royce Lewis came off the IL hitting just .200 (3-for-15) with two extra-base hits, two walks, a .294 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS in his first five games, but has since posted a 1.032 OPS with two doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, seven walks, a .389 on-base percentage and a .643 slugging percentage in nine games (Twins 7-2).

Royce has 11 RBI this month, tied with Josh Naylor and Bobby Witt Jr. for third-most in baseball for August, trailing Zach Neto (14) and Vinnie Pasquantino (12).

CHRISTIAN MINGLE: In his last 18 games since July 3, Christian Vázquez is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with two doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, one stolen base, 11 runs scored, a .574 slugging percentage and a .936 OPS...below are his numbers before July 1 and since July 3.

♣ Winokur, 19, played in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting 333 (5-for-15) with two home runs, three RBI and a 1.145 OPS... the Newport Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the third round (82nd overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Edison High School in Huntington Beach, CA...he is ranked as the club's 12th best prospect by MLB.com.

♣ Morris, 22, made the start on Wednesday at Corpus Christi, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...the New York, NY native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech University.

RIP, MIKE CUBBAGE: Former Twins infielder Mike Cubbage passed away in hospice care yesterday after his battle with cancer...Cubbage played parts of five seasons with Minnesota from 1976-80, hitting .266 with 66 doubles, 29 home runs and 226 RBI in 555 games.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started July 30 at New York-NL, opposite Sean Manaea, and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-0 defeat...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with a walk and six strikeouts...faced the minimum (10 batters) through 3.1 innings...in fourth, allowed a J.D. Martinez RBI single after a walk, and a wild pitch...second run came on Mark Vientos' fifth-inning home run.

- ₱ Induced nine whiffs on 31 swings (29.0%).
- ◆ Allowed five hard-hit balls

ROOKIE VS. GUARDIANS: Has never faced Cleveland or any of its hitters at the MLB level...has made two starts against Triple-A Columbus, Cleveland's affiliate, on August 30, 2023 and March 30, 2024; combined to allow one run on five hits in 8.0 innings.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making third appearance (2nd start) at Target Field...is 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA (9.1 IP. 8 ER). 1.129 opponent OPS, two walks and 13 strikeouts at home, compared to 2-1 with a 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER), .636 OPS, four walks and 17 strikeouts on the road

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through five MLB games vs. Festa, left-handed hitters have hit .241 (13-for-54) with a .519 slugging percentage, .812 OPS, 27.6 percent strikeout rate and 5.2 percent walk rate, while righties have hit .279 (12-for-43) with a .558 SLG, .884 OPS, 30.4 percent strikeout rate and 6.5 percent walk rate.
