THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3, going 2-2 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game roadtrip with the first of four at Globe Life Field against the Rangers...after this series, the Twins will travel to San Diego to play the Padres for three games at Petco Park from Monday-Wednesday. **☞** Twins have gone 60-40 in their last 100 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date.

TWINS DROP FINALE TO ROYALS: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-1, missing the three-game sweep...Louie Varland (0-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing three runs on eight hits (2 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, including two from Manny Margot...the only run scored by the Twins came on a Carlos Santana solo home run in the fourth inning, his 16th of the season.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day IL with right hip inflammation...Buxton, who exited Monday night's game against the Royals, has played in 90 games for the Twins this season, hitting .275 (84-for-305) with 23 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 49 RBI, a .334 on-base percentage, a .528 slugging percentage and an .862 OPS. **☞** To replace Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled infielder Edouard Julien from Triple-A St. Paul...Julien, who will be making his third stint with the Twins this season, hit .263 (15-for-57) with six doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, 10 runs scored, 11 walks and a .382 on-base percentage in his last 14 games during his most recent stint at St. Paul. **☞** Additionally, the Twins optioned right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to St. Paul after his start yesterday afternoon against the Royals...to replace Varland on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez from St. Paul...Henriquez, who will be making his fourth stint with the Twins this season, has appeared in three games for Minnesota in 2024, combining to pitch 3.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...recently, the 24-year-old allowed three runs on 11 hits in 10.1 innings pitched (2.61 ERA), with four walks and 13 strikeouts in his last six games (2 starts) for the Saints, since July 25.

OBBER DRIVER: Since allowing eight runs on nine hits in 1.1 innings pitched in his first start on March 31 at Kansas City, Bailey Ober has gone 12-4, 2.98 ERA (126.2 IP, 42 ER) with 30 walks, 136 strikeouts, a 0.90 WHIP and a .187 opponent batting average in 21 starts since April 8...below are his AL rankings since that date (minimum of 115.0 innings pitched):

ADDITIONALLY: Ober has a run value of 2.3 on his offspeed pitches, the best in baseball since April 8.

STARTING LINE: In 24 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 10-6, 3.21 ERA (129.0 IP, 46 ER) with 18 home runs allowed, 32 walks and 132 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .208 batting average...in that span, they rank second in baseball in WHIP (1.02), third in ERA and fourth in opponent batting average.

CONGRATS, VAZKY!: Christian Vázquez is celebrating 10 years of major league service today...in his last 20 games, Vázquez is slashing .344/.379/.656 (1.035 OPS), hitting safely in 14 of those...below are his numbers before July 1 and after:

LONE STAR STATS: The Twins and Rangers last met for a three-game series at Target Field from May 24-26 as the Twins won games one and two...the Twins are 7-3 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 57-44.

☞ The Twins are 6-3 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022 and 2-1 in 2023...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 16-7 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 10-3 in their last 13.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 19 of 24 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 11 games have been decided by one run.

☞ Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.4 runs-per-game in 31 games against the Rangers...marks the second most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.7).

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .344 (21-for-61) with a .904 OPS in his last 18 games vs. Texas.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.017 OPS in 12 career games vs. Texas.

☞ Bench coach Jayce Tingler spent 13 seasons in the Rangers organization as a minor league and major league coach, including serving as the Rangers' bench coach in 2018 and their field coordinator from 2015-16.

☞ Twins have gone 20-6 against AL West opponents this season, going 2-1 vs. Texas, 3-0 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 4-2 vs. Houston and 6-1 vs. Oakland.

LINING UP THE LEFTIES: Twins are facing three consecutive left-handed starters in Cole Ragans yesterday, Cody Bradford tonight and Andrew Heaney tomorrow...this stretch marks the first time the Twins have faced three-straight lefties since August 13-15, 2022, when they faced Reid Detmers (LAA), Tucker Davidson (LAA) and Kris Bubic (KC)...Minnesota enters today with a .262 batting average vs. left-handed pitching, the best in the AL and fourth-best mark in baseball, trailing Arizona (.283), Philadelphia (.268) and Los Angeles-NL (.267).

☞ Carlos Santana is slashing .303/.350/.578 (.928 OPS) vs. lefties this season...in his last 27 games against left-handers he is slashing .345/.410/.691 (1.101 OPS).

MAX EFFORT: Max Kepler has seven hits in his last 13 at-bats over his last three games, including one home run and four RBI...in his last 31 games, he is hitting .330 (37-for-112) with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, 14 runs scored and an .813 OPS.

☞ Kepler's home run on Tuesday night was the 161st of his career and is now within one of tying Miguel Sanó (162) for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...two more and he ties Tom Brunansky (163).

ROYCE'S ROADTRIP: Royce Lewis makes his offseason home in Frisco, Texas, approximately 40 miles north of Globe Life Field...the Twins' next stop, San Diego, is close to where he grew up as he attended JSerra Catholic High School, approximately 70 miles north of Petco Park.

☞ For his career, against the Texas teams (Rangers and Astros), Royce has gone 15-for-49 (.306) with one double, one home run and four RBI...against California teams (which is only Oakland), he has gone 14-for-41 (.341) with four doubles, four home runs, five RBI and a 1.132 OPS.

☞ Royce is slashing .307/.364/.587 (.951 OPS) with 15 home runs in 51 career road games, compared to .286/.354/.576 (.930 OPS) and 17 home runs in 61 career home games...Royce homered in his last road game on August 6 at Wrigley Field.

HBD, TK: Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 74th birthday today...Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1,140)...on his birthday, Kelly held a managerial record of 7-6.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on August 9 vs. Cleveland...earned his team-leading 12th win of the season...allowed just four base runners through six innings...allowed no runs on two hits, two walks with nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings...tied his career high with a fourth-straight win...has now recorded nine-straight quality starts dating back to June 16 vs. Oakland, the longest streak of his career...106 pitches set a new career high; previous high was 104, done twice.

- ☞ Recorded his 13th quality start of the season, tied with Joe Ryan with (13) for most on the Twins.
- ☞ Recorded his team-leading 12th win of the season.
- ☞ Has recorded a quality start in each of his last nine starts, now the longest such streak of his career...had seven-straight quality starts from June 14-July 23, 2023.
- ☞ Recorded his second four-decision winning streak of the season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 3 vs. Chicago-AL...earned the win, allowing two runs on two hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts...allowed zero baserunners through 2.2 innings and zero hits through 4.2 innings; Corey Lee's RBI triple tied the game 1-1 in the fifth...threw thrown 7.0-or-more innings in three-straight starts for the first time in his career.

LAST NINE STARTS: In his last nine starts since June 16, Ober has gone 7-1, 1.76 ERA (61.1 IP, 12 ER), 13 walks, 72 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP and a .152 (32-for-211) opponent batting average...

- ☞ All nine starts have been quality starts, setting a new career-best streak.
- ☞ Since June 16, leads all qualified pitchers in ERA and opponent batting average.

VS. TEXAS: Making his second start this season and third of his career vs. Texas.

- ☞ Started vs. Texas on May 24, and earned the victory, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings; Twins won, 3-2.
- ☞ In two career matchups, he is 1-0, 7.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 7 ER), four walks, nine strikeouts, a 1.44 WHIP and a .250 (9-for-36) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Making his first career start at Globe Life Field.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Making his 13th road start of the season today...in the previous 12, he's gone 5-4 with a 4.13 ERA (69.2 IP, 32 ER), 17 walks, 72 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .204 (51-for-250) opponent batting average...in 10 home starts, he is 7-1, 2.78 ERA (58.1 IP, 18 ER), 14 walks, 65 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .197 (42-for-213) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Has gone 11-12 with a 3.83 ERA (214.0 IP, 91 ER) in 40 career road starts compared to 14-5 with a 3.35 ERA (206.2 IP, 77 ER) in 39 career home starts.
- ☞ The Twins are 6-6 in Ober's 12 road starts this season.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is third on the Twins in road wins with 11, trailing only Pablo López (13) and Joe Ryan (14).

REVERSE SPLITS: On August 9, Cleveland's left-handed hitters went 2-for-18 with nine strikeouts against Ober, its one righty, Lane Thomas, went 0-for-3.

- ☞ Lefties have a 27.8 percent whiff rate and 85.2 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 30.1 percent whiff rate and 88.5 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ Through 22 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .184 (39-for-212) with a .586 OPS and 26.8 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .215 (54-for-251) with a .677 OPS and 27.8 percent strikeout rate.
- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .232 (170-for-733) with 38 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs and a .672 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .264 (188-for-836) with 33 doubles, seven triples, 41 home runs and a .693 OPS.
- ☞ On May 24 vs. Ober, Texas left-handed hitters went 3-for-14 with one home run, two walks and four strikeouts...right-handed hitters went 1-for-5, with one walk and one strikeout.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seam fastball and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties...here's his pitch usage through 22 starts:

- ☞ In his last four starts, hitters have hit .151 (10-for-66) with 14 strikeouts against Ober's 4-seam fastball and cutter.
