THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3 (2-2 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a win over the Rangers in Arlington last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of four at Globe Life Field...after this series, the Twins will travel to San Diego to play the Padres for three games at Petco Park on Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have gone 61-40 in their last 101 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...second-most wins since that date: Arizona (58-41), Baltimore (58-43), Houston (58-39) and Los Angeles-NL (58-40).

EVERYONE LOVES KYLE FARMER: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 3-2, making them 18-14 in one-run games this season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on seven hits, with three walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched; both runs were allowed in the first inning...Griffin Jax (1.0), Jorge Alcalá (W, 1.0) and Joao Duran (S, 1.0) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief, with one hit allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits and were led by Kyle Farmer, who went 2-for-4 with a single, a triple and a run scored...Willi Castro homered, giving him a new single-season high of 10.

CAUTION, HIGH WATER: Minnesota sits at 15 games over .500, matching their high-water mark for 2024...they have been 15 games over now four times this season: through games of August 5 — 63-48, August 9 — 65-50, August 13 — 67-52, and today...the last time they were 16 games over was through games of September 28, 2019, when they were 41 games over (101-60).

DEEP IN THE HEART...: The Twins have gone 3-1 against the Rangers this season, going 2-1 at Target Field from May 24-26, followed by a win last night at Globe Life Field...the Twins are 8-3 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 60-46. ☞ The Twins are 7-3 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023 and 1-0 in 2024...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 17-7 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 11-3 in their last 14.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 20 of 25 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 12 games have been decided by one run.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with an .872 OPS in his last 19 games vs. Texas. ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.017 OPS in 12 career games vs. Texas.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 11-3 all-time in Arlington, going 4-0 at Globe Life Park and 7-3 at Globe Life Field...his .786 winning percentage in this city is his best...next is Toronto (.667 - 10-5).

WEST IS THE BEST: Twins have gone 21-6 against AL West opponents this season, going 3-1 vs. Texas, 3-0 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 4-2 vs. Houston and 6-1 vs. Oakland...their .778 winning percentage against the AL West is their highest since the current divisional format began in 1994; 2019 being second best at .676 (23-11).

☞ 21 wins against the AL West are tied for their fifth-most in the divisional era...27-22 in 1996, 24-12 in 2010, 23-11 in 2019, 22-22 in 1997 and 21-13 in 2007.

10-SPOTS: Willi Castro hit his 10th home run of the season last night in the second inning, giving him a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of nine, done in 2021 with Detroit and 2023 with Minnesota...Twins now have seven players with 10-plus homers (Ryan Jeffers - 17, Byron Buxton - 16, Carlos Santana - 16, Royce Lewis - 15, Carlos Correa - 13, Trevor Larnach - 11), joining Baltimore (8 players), San Diego (7 players), Atlanta (7 players) and Houston (7) as the only teams in baseball with as many players with double digit home run totals...Jose Miranda is next with nine home runs.

STARTER STUFF: In 25 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 10-6, 3.20 ERA (135.0 IP, 48 ER) with 18 home runs allowed, 35 walks and 135 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .212 batting average...in that span, they rank third in baseball in WHIP (1.04) and ERA and fourth in opponent batting average.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Twins are facing three consecutive left-handed starters in Cole Ragans Wednesday, Cody Bradford last night and Andrew Heaney tonight...this stretch marks the first time the Twins have faced three-straight lefties since August 13-15, 2022, when they faced Reid Detmers (LAA), Tucker Davidson (LAA) and Kris Bubic (KC)...Minnesota enters today with a .262 batting average vs. left-handed pitching, the best in the AL and fifth-best mark in baseball, trailing Arizona (.283), Philadelphia (.272), Los Angeles-NL (.266) and San Francisco (.262).

☞ In his last 28 games against lefties, Carlos Santana is slashing .328/.391/.655 (1.046 OPS). ☞ Twins have three left-handed batters in tonight's starting lineup, their most when facing a left-handed starting pitcher this season (had 2 twice, on May 4 and July 14).

MAX EFFORT: Max Kepler has seven hits in his last 16 at-bats over his last four games...in his last 32 games, he is hitting .322 (37-for-115) with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, 14 runs scored and a .798 OPS.

PERFECT CRIMES: The Twins stole two more bases last night (Santana and Wallner) have now successfully stolen 14 bases since the All-Star break, the only team in baseball yet to be caught post-ASG...their last caught stealing came July 13 at San Francisco (Patrick Bayle caught Willi Castro)...after his seventh inning steal of second base last night, Carlos Santana has now successfully stolen 17-straight bases, dating back to his last caught stealing on July 4, 2018 with Philadelphia.

WE TALKIN' 'BOUT PRACTICE: The Twins, in conjunction with MLB, yesterday announced the home schedule for their 2025 Spring Training...the schedule features 32 total games (17 home, 15 road), a slate that begins with the Grapefruit League opener vs. the Braves on Saturday, February 22 at Lee Health Sports Complex...additional highlights of the Twins' 17 home games include three games against the Red Sox (March 8, 16 and 20) as part of the annual Fort Myers 'Chairman's Cup' series; a February 25 visit from the Yankees; three contests vs. the Pirates (February 27, March 13 and March 24); two games apiece against the Braves (February 22 and March 7), Orioles (February 28 and March 5) and Rays (March 2 and 14); and single games vs. the Phillies (March 10), Tigers (March 18) and Blue Jays (March 22).

☞ Minnesota will again participate in MLB's Spring Breakout series, with top prospects from the Twins' minor league system — currently ranked No. 2 in baseball, per MLB Pipeline — squaring off against Blue Jays minor leaguers at Toronto's Dunesin, FL ballpark on March 15.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1975, the Twins set a major league mark with nine batters recording two-or-more hits, in a 9-1, nine-inning victory over Cleveland...in 1990, Kirby Puckett started off in rightfield and moved to shortstop, third base and second base all in the second inning.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making 11th road start of the season...has gone 2-2 with a 4.34 ERA (47.2 IP, 23 ER), 6.99 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 2.45 walks-per-9.0 innings and 1.13 home-runs-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA (54.2 IP, 20 ER), 8.89 K/9, 2.96 BB/9 and 0.82 HR/9 in 10 home starts.
