The Twins are 63-40 in their last 103 games at Petco Park from Monday-Wednesday.

♣ The Twins are 63-40 in their last 103 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...no other team since that date has 60 wins as Houston (59-40), Los Angeles-NL (59-41) and Philadelphia (59-42) all have the second-most victories.

♣ The Twins 63 wins over their last 103 games puts them at a 99-win pace over 162.

♣ Through 123 games in 2023, the Twins were 64-59 and in first place of the AL Central, 5.0 games ahead of Cleveland and 8.5 games ahead of third-place Detroit.

FESTA AND HENRIQUEZ LEAD THE CHARGE IN TEXAS: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 5-2, winning in come-from-behind fashion for the third-straight game... David Festa was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Ronny Henriquez pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief and earned his first major league win... Twins pitchers did not walk a batter for the 12th time this season (8-4)... the offense scored three runs in the eighth inning to close a 2-1 deficit... Willi Castro had two of the club's eight hits and drove in two runs in the eighth... Trevor Larnach hit his 12th home run of the season.

The Twins now have 33 come-from-behind wins (3 this series), tied with Kansas City and Milwaukee for second-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (34).

BRINGING BACK PABLO DAYS: Pablo López has gone 5-2, 3.27 ERA (55.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks, 62 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average in his last nine starts since June 23...below are López's ranks among AL starters in a few categories since June 23 (min. 50.0 IP):

RANGER THINGS: The Twins have gone 5-1 against the Rangers this season, going 2-1 at Target Field and 3-0 at Globe Life Field...the Twins are 10-3 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, outscoring them 69-51.

The Twins are 9-3 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023 and 3-0 in 2024...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 19-7 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 13-3 in their last 16.

Since the start of 2021, 22 of 27 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 13 games have been decided by one run.

Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 12-3 all-time in Arlington, going 4-0 at Globe Life Park and 8-3 at Globe Life Field...his .800 winning percentage in this city is his best... next is Toronto (.667 - 10-5).

COWBOY JACKS: After Trevor Larnach's home run last night, the Twins have now homered in 11-straight games at Globe Life Field, which is their second-longest active streak in any ballpark (Rogers Centre - 20)...also their longest in any ballpark in Arlington...their previous high was nine-straight in 1963 at Arlington Stadium.

GO WEST: Twins have gone 23-6 against AL West opponents this season, going 5-1 vs. Texas, 3-2 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 4-2 vs. Houston and 6-1 vs. Oakland...their.793 winning percentage against the AL West is their highest since the current divisional format began in 1994; 2019 being second best at .676 (23-11).

◆23 wins against the AL West this season are tied for their third-most in the divisional era...27-22 in 1996, 24-12 in 2010 and 23-11 in 2019.

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its sixth sweep of the season today...the other five sweeps were four games against Chicago-AL from April 22-25, three games at Los Angeles-AL from April 26-28, three games at Chicago-AL from April 29-May 1, four games vs. Oakland from June 13-16 and three games vs. Chicago-AL from August 2-4... Iwins had six sweeps in 2023.
◆ The Twins' last sweep of the Rangers came in three games from June 18-20, 2021 at Globe Life Field... their last four-game sweep of the Rangers came August 15-18, 2019 across the street at Globe Life Park - which was also the Twins' last four-game sweep of any opponent on the road (they have three four-game sweeps since then, but all were at home - OAK in 2024, CWS in 2024 and DET in 2021).

FOR STARTERS: In 27 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 11-6, 3.23 ERA (145.0 IP, 52 ER) with 19 home runs allowed, 37 walks and 142 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .214 batting average...in that span, they rank second in baseball in ERA, third in WHIP (1.05) and fourth in opponent batting average.

STRIKING COMPARISONS: Through 123 games in 2023, Twins batters had struck out 1,258 times, which led baseball...through 123 games this season, they have struck out 988 times and rank 22nd in baseball...

Twins batters have a swing and miss percentage of 25.5%, which is 18th-highest in baseball...last season, they had a swing and miss percentage of 28.4%, the fifth-highest in MLB.

DAY MAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN: The Twins have played 56 day games this season, the fifth most in baseball...they have gone 35-21 during the day, the most day wins in baseball...they have scored 5.16 runs-per-game during the day, the second-highest mark in baseball...pitchers' .226 opponent batting average in day games leads baseball.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers infielder/outfielder Brandon Winokur and right-handed pitcher Charlee Soto have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Winokur, 19, Dosted a 1.042 OPS with five RBI in six games for the Mighty Mussels, including a three-homer game against Lakeland on Firday...the Newport Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Edison High School in Huntington Beach, CA.

Soto, 18, made the start on Wednesday vs. Lakeland, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with four hits allowed, two walks and four strikeouts...the Philadelphia, PA native was selected by the Twins 34th overall in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Reborn Christian Academy in Kissimmee, FL.
