YOU READ MY NEWS!!: The Twins have gone 3-1 through four games on their current seven-game roadtrip, winning three straight in Arlington over the Rangers Thursday-Saturday, followed by a loss on Sunday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three against the Padres at Petco Park, then wrap the series on Wednesday afternoon.

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY: The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon at Globe Life Field by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings...the Twins held a 4-0 lead through six innings, but reliever Jorge Alcala allowed five runs to cross in the seventh inning, highlighted by homers from Adolis García (2-run, game-tying) and Josh Jung (solo, go-añead)...Minnesota forced extras with a Carlos Santana solo homer in the top of the ninth, but got walked-off in the 10th...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings, with six hits allowed, three walks and three strikeouts...Ryan Jeffers highlighted the Twins offense, going 2-for-3 with a walk, a home run (19) and three RBI.

HEY EVERYONE! COME AND SEE HOW GOOD I LOOK!: The Twins are 63-41 in their last 104 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date, in front of Houston (60-40) and Los Angeles-NL (60-41).

◆ The Twins' 63 wins over their last 104 games puts them at a 98-win pace over 162.

◆ Through 124 games in 2023, the Twins were just four games over .500 at 64-60 and in first place of the AL Central, 5.0 games ahead of Cleveland.

YOU STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 27th, 28th and 29th time in their history this week...Minnesota is 18-8 all-time against the Padres, posting a .692 winning percentage, its highest vs. any NL opponent...the Twins are 7-3 all-time at Petco Park, 8-2 at Target Field, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium and 1-2 at Metrodome.

♣ Twins are 15-5 against the Padres in their last 20 games, dating back to June of 2008.

♣ These two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from May 9-11, 2023 as the Twins won games two and three.

♣ The last time the Twins played at Petco Park was July 29-31, 2022, winning just the middle game of the three-game series.

♣ Manny Margot made his major league debut for the Padres on September 21, 2016 vs. Arizona...he played three seasons for San Diego from 2016-19, playing in 428 games.

♣ Carlos Santana is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with a 1.071 OPS in 23 career games vs. San Diego...he has hit three home runs in eight career games at Petco, including a two-homer game on July 24, 2023, both off Yu Darvish...also, he homered in his last game here on July 26, 2023, a solo shot off Robert Suárez.

THAT'S HOW I(L) ROLL: The Twins are 14-17 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL and 1-2 at Chicago.

■ By comparison, the Twins have gone 56-37 against American League opponents.

DON'T ACT LIKE YOU'RE NOT IMPRESSED: In 28 games since the All-Star break, the Twins starting staff has combined to go 11-6, 3.10 ERA (151.0 IP, 52 ER) with 19 home runs allowed 40 walks and 145 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .216 batting average...in that span, they rank second in baseball in ERA, fourth in WHIP (1.07) and fourth in opponent batting average.

YOU PLAY JAZZ F-LEW-TE? I DABBLE: Royce Lewis has recorded 14 RBI this month, tied with Zach Neto and Corey Seager for the fourth most in the AL for the month, trailing Vinnie Pasquantino (20), Josh Naylor (15) and Bobby Witt Jr (15)...Twins are 30-19 over Royce's career (116 games) when he drives in at least one run and 17-6 when he drives in multiple runs.
◆Royce Lewis attended JSerra Catholic High School, approximately 70 miles north of Petco.

DON'T KNOW IF YOU HEARD ME COUNTING BUT I DID ALMOST A THOUSAND: Through 124 games in 2023, Iwins batters had struck out 1,273 times, which led baseball...through 124 games this season, they have struck out 995 times and rank 22nd in baseball...Twins posted a 23.0% strikeout rate through games of May 31, but have posted a 19.6% strikeout rate since June 1...league average on the season is 22.4%.

MIRANDA WATCH!!: Jose Miranda is hitting, 349 (45-for-129) with 14 doubles, two triples, two home runs, 22 RBI, a, 390 on-base percentage, a, 535 slugging percentage and a, 925 OPS in his last 36 games since June 20... since that date, he ranks sixth in baseball in average (min. 150 PA), trailing Bobby Witt Jr (.382), Aaron Judge (.369), Xavier Edwards (.358), Jake McCarthy (.346) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr (.341).

GONNA BE HONEST WITH YOU, THAT SMELLS LIKE PURE GASOLINE: Jhoan Duran has converted each of his last seven save opportunities and has converted 18 of 19 on the season for a save percentage of 94.7%, the third-best in baseball among qualified relievers, trailing Josh Hader (96.4%, 27-for-28) and Kirby Yates (95.5%, 21-for-22)...Duran has thrown 177 pitches of at least 100.0 mph this season, fifth-most in baseball, trailing Mason Miller (352), Justin Martinez (281), Emmanuel Clase (208) and Ben Joyce (193).

MADE WITH BITS OF REAL PANTHER, SO YOU KNOW IT'S GOOD: Griffin Jax has gone 3-4, 1.82 ERA (54.1 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 70 strikeouts, a .174 BAA, a 0.85 WHIP and a 11.60 K/9.0 IP ratio in 56 games this season, including eight saves and 20 holds...he is the only pitcher in baseball with an ERA under 2.00, a WHIP under 0.90, a BAA under .180, a K/9.0 IP of at least 11.0, at least five saves, and at least 15 holds...additionally, he ranks in MLB's 99th percentile in xERA (2.30), 97th in whiff% (35.9%) and 96th in both strikeout rate (33.2%) and chase percentage (35.2%).

NEW FAD CALLING JOGGING. I BELIEVE IT'S JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT 'J': After Matt Wallner's sixth inning stolen base yesterday, the Twins have now gone 15-for-16 in steal opportunities since the All-Star break; their 93.8 caught stealing percentage is tied with New York-AL for best since the break...their one caught stealing since the break came on Saturday night at Texas (Jonah Heim caught Willi Castro).

I'M KIND OF A BIG DEAL, PEOPLE KNOW ME: On this day in 2007, Johan Santana set a club record with 17 strikeouts against the Rangers at the Metrodome, allowing two hits (both to Sammy Sosa - one single and one double) and no walks in 8.0 innings as Joe Nathan pitched the ninth inning and the Jwins beat the Rangers 1-0...Michael Cuddyer provided the game's only run with a homer...Santana passed the Twins previous mark of 15, set by Bert Blyleven (1986), Joe Decker (1973) Jerry Koosman (1980) and Camilo Pascual (1961).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for April 2024; made three starts for High-A Cedar Rapids, going 3-0 with a 2.30 ERA (15.2 IP, 4 ER), zero walks and 19 strikeouts...opponents slashed .233/.233/.300 (.533 OPS) in those starts, as Matthews allowed just two extra-base hits - a double and a home run.
