- ☞ Making 22nd start of 2024 and 83rd of career...took his seventh loss in previous start July 27 at Detroit, allowing three runs (2 ER) on three hits in 6.0 innings, with no walks and eight strikeouts.
- ☞ Making his third start vs. Chicago-AL this season...in his previous two starts he is 1-0, 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, 11 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP.
- ☞ Ranks fourth among qualified pitchers with a 6.90 strikeout-to-walk ratio (138 K, 20 BB).

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 27 at Detroit...took his seventh loss of the season allowing three runs (2 ER) on three hits, one walk and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings...allowed an RBI single to Mark Canha in the first inning before tossing four scoreless innings 2-5...allowed two more runs in the sixth inning on a Colt Keith RBI triple and a Mark Canha sacrifice fly before exiting...recorded his first quality start in five starts...made his third start of the season against Detroit; has gone 0-1, 3.12 ERA (17.1 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 26 strikeouts.

☞ Has tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his last 24 starts, since September 18, 2023; is the longest such streak by a Twins pitcher since Michael Pineda also had a 24-start streak from April 23, 2019-September 7, 2020...Ryan's last outing of less than 5.0 innings pitched was on September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay.

☞ The last 21 starts of Ryan's 24-start streak have come this season; his 21-straight starts of 5.0-plus innings is the fourth-longest streak in baseball this year.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on July 21 vs. Milwaukee...didn't factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts; Twins lost, 8-7...retired the first eight batters he faced before Eric Haase's third-inning solo home run...allowed three runs on four hits in the fifth...was his fifth start this season with 6.0-or-more innings and zero walks; has completed 6.0-or-more innings in 13 of 20 starts.

VS. CHICAGO-AL: Facing Chicago-AL for the third time this season and sixth of his career.

☞ In two starts this season vs. Chicago-AL, he is 1-0, 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, 11 strikeouts a 1.00 WHIP and a .227 (10-for-44) opponent batting average...both starts were quality starts.

☞ In five career matchups, he has gone 2-0, 3.54 ERA (28.0 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 31 strikeouts, a 1.07 WHIP and a .223 (23-for-103) opponent batting average.

☞ Third career start at Target Field vs. Chicago-AL...in previous two he is 2-0, 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 7 ER), two walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .234 (11-for-47) opponent batting average...allowed two home runs in each of the two starts.

BACK ON TARGET: Through 10 home starts in 2024, Ryan has gone 4-3 with a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), seven walks, 64 strikeouts and nine home runs allowed, compared to 2-4, 3.26 ERA (66.1 IP, 24 ER), 13 walks, 74 strikeouts and eight home runs in 11 road starts.

☞ In 42 career home starts, he is 18-12, 3.74 ERA (240.1 IP, 100 ER), 55 walks, 280 strikeouts and 19 quality starts...Twins are 23-19 in Ryan's 42 home starts.

☞ Leads all Twins starters in strikeouts at home with 64.

☞ Twins are 4-6 this season at home when Ryan starts.

☞ Since making his debut in 2021, he leads Twins pitchers with 18 home wins...has four home wins this season, only trailing Bailey Ober with five.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .201/.237/.367 with eight home runs, nine walks and 58 strikeouts in 241 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .240/.278/.436 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 80 strikeouts in 266 plate appearances.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .206 (171-for-831) with 32 doubles, six triples, 28 home runs and a .627 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .242 (221-for-915) with 55 doubles, three triples, 45 home runs and a .740 OPS.

☞ This season lefties have a 25.0 percent whiff rate and 88.5 mph average exit velocity vs. Ryan, while righties have a 28.0 percent whiff rate and 88.2 mph average exit velocity.

☞ In his last start against Detroit, left-handed hitters went 1-for-8 with no walks and one strikeout...right-handed hitters went 2-for-13 with one walk and seven strikeouts.

☞ In two games vs. Ryan this season, Chicago-AL left-handed hitters have hit .278 (5-for-18) with one double, one walk and two strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .192 (5-for-26) with one double, two home runs, one walk and nine strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 21 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and sinker the most, combining to throw the two pitches 75.3 percent of the time in his last start against Detroit...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ In his last eight starts since June 13, opponents have hit .183 (17-for-93) with 32 strikeouts against Ryan's 4-seam fastball.

☞ In two starts vs. Chicago-AL this season, hitters have gone 2-for-13 with five strikeouts against Ryan's 4-seam fastball.

☞ At Detroit, his sweeper induced five whiffs on eight swings (62.5%)

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2024: 10-5, 3.76 ERA // CAREER: 23-17, 3.66 ERA)

Bailey Ober is set to start the second of a three-game series vs. Chicago-AL...last started July 28 at Detroit Tigers, a 5-0 Twins win...earned his team-high-tying 10th win, allowing no runs on one hit, two walks and 11 strikeouts in 8.0 innings – his 11 strikeouts surpass 10 from June 22 at Oakland, setting a new career high...has faced Chicago-AL two times this season; is 1-1, 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 7 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in those starts...making his ninth start at home this season; in the previous eight he is 5-1, 3.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 16 ER), 10 walks, 49 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .225 (38-for-169) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.
