TWINS FINISH TRIP STRONG: The Twins beat the Mets on Wednesday afternoon at Citi Field by a score of 8-3, avoiding the three-game sweep...Pablo López (10-7) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts...Randy Dobnak made his return to the major leagues, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning of relief...the offense recorded 10 hits, two from both Matt Wallner and Carlos Santana... Wallner hit his sixth home run of the season and Byron Buxton hit his 13th.

 WINNESOTA: Minnesota has gone 52-35 in its last 87 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...below are the Twins' offensive numbers through April 21 (first 20 games), compared to numbers since April 22 (67 games) and MLB ranks in parenthesis:

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing their final series of the season this weekend...the Twins are 9-1 vs. the Sox this season, going 4-0 at Target Field and 5-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field...these two last met for a three-game series on the Southside from July 8-10 as the Twins won games one and three...Minnesota has gone 16-2 in its last 18 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

© Minnesota's .900 winning percentage against the Sox this season is the highest in their history, in front of their 1966 total of .778 (14-4) and their 2001 total of .737 (14-5).

© Since 2015, the Twins have gone 96-70 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

© Byron Buxton is hitting .359 (46-for-128) with 13 doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 26 RBI, a .781 slugging percentage and a 1.201 OPS in his last 36 games against the Sox.

© Christian Vázquez is hitting .299 (44-for-147) with seven doubles, one home run, 19 RBI, 10 walks, a .344 on-base percentage and a .711 OPS in 47 career games vs. the Sox.

© Carlos Santana is the all-time leader among actives in career walks (117) and games (189) against the White Sox...also, on that list, he ranks second in runs (91), tied for second in home runs (26), and third in hits (151) and RBI (82).

THE MOOSE IS LOOSE: Matt Wallner began the season hitting. 080 (2-for-25) with a .513 OPS in 13 games from March 28-April 15 before being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, he has hit .364 (16-for-44) with five doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, a .451 on-base percentage, an .818 slugging percentage and a 1.269 OPS in 15 games...since that date, he ranks first in baseball in average exit velocity at 99.4 mph (50 PA) and second in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 17.6%.

◆On the season, he has an average exit velocity of 95.9 mph, the second-highest in baseball (min. of 25 batted ball events), trailing only Aaron Judge (96.0 mph)...additionally, on that same list, he has a hard hit percentage of 61.8%, which leads baseball among those qualifiers.

◆In his last 34 games between St. Paul and Minnesota combined, he has slashed .366/.439/.772 (1.211 OPS).

STRIKING COMPARISONS: The Twins finished July with a 21.0 strikeout percentage (190 K/906 PA) in 23 games, the 10-lowest rate in baseball for the month…by comparison, they posted a 24.9% strikeout rate in April, 21.4% in May and 17.5% in June.

◆ Overall, they posted a 23.2% strikeout rate (542 K/2335 PA) in their first 63 games, compared to 18.3% (320 K/1747 PA) in their last 44.

HEART AND HUSTLE: The Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA) yesterday announced the 30 preliminary winners of the 2024 Heart and Hustle Award...this esteemed award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game of baseball and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...the Heart and Hustle Award is also the only award in Major League Baseball that is voted on by former players...the Twins winner is Willi Castro...the 2024 All-Star leads the team in games played, appearing in 106 of the 107 Twins games this season...additionally, he has appeared in 20-plus games at five different positions, playing second base (35 games), shortstop (28 games), third base (23 games), leftfield (23 games) and centerfield (20 games).

BLUE STREAKS: Tonight, the Twins will be wearing their 2024 Nike MLB City Connect Series uniform, a look that embodies this majestic and where the water reflects the sky" and celebrates the 10,000 lakes that shape and unite us...the Nike City Connect Series, which debuted in 2021, celebrates the deep-rooted history, culture and spirit of each city that continues to bring the MLB clubs and their communities together...Minnesota debuted these uniforms on June 14 vs. Oakland...full list of remaining tentative dates these will be worn after tonight: August 9 vs. Cleveland, August 23 vs. St. Louis, August 30 vs. Toronto, September 13 vs. Cincinnati and September 27 vs. Baltimore.

 ♠ Making his third start vs. Chicago-AL this season...in his previous two starts he is 1-0, 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, 11 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP.
 ♠ Ranks fourth among qualified pitchers with a 6.90 strikeout-to-walk ratio (138 K, 20 BB).

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 27 at Detroit...took his seventh loss of the season allowing three runs (2 ER) on three hits, one walk and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings...allowed an RBI single to Mark Canha in the first inning before tossing four scoreless innings 2-5...allowed two more runs in the sixth inning on a Colt Keith RBI triple and a Mark Canha sacrifice fly before exiting...recorded his first quality start in five starts...made his third start of the season against Detroit; has gone 0-1,

- 3.12 ERA (17.1 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 26 strikeouts.

 ◆ Has tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his last 24 starts, since September 18, 2023; is the longest such streak by a Twins pitcher since Michael Pineda also had a 24-start streak from April 23, 2019-September 7, 2020...Ryan's last outing of less than 5.0 innings pitched was on September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay.
- ₱ The last 21 starts of Ryan's 24-start streak have come this season; his 21-straight starts of 5.0-plus innings is the fourth-longest streak in baseball this year.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on July 21 vs. Milwaukee...didn't factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts; Twins lost, 8-7...retired the first eight batters he faced before Eric Haase's third-inning solo home run...allowed three runs on four hits in the fifth...was his fifth start this season with 6.0-or-more innings and zero walks; has completed 6.0-or-more innings in 13 of 20 starts.

VS. CHICAGO-AL: Facing Chicago-AL for the third time this season and sixth of his career

- ₱ In two starts this season vs. Chicago-AL, he is 1-0, 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, 11 strikeouts
- a 1.00 WHIP and a .227 (10-for-44) opponent batting average...both starts were quality starts.

 ♣ In five career matchups, he has gone 2-0, 3.54 ERA (28.0 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 31 strikeouts, a 1.07 WHIP and a .223 (23-for-103) opponent batting average.

 ♣ Third career start at Target Field vs. Chicago-AL...in previous two he is 2-0, 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 7
- ER), two walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .234 (11-for-47) opponent batting average... allowed two home runs in each of the two starts.

BACK ON TARGET: Through 10 home starts in 2024, Ryan has gone 4-3 with a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), seven walks, 64 strikeouts and nine home runs allowed, compared to 2-4, 3.26 ERA (66.1 IP, 24 ER), 13 walks, 74 strikeouts and eight home runs in 11 road starts.

© In 42 career home starts, he is 18-12, 3.74 ERA (240.1 IP, 100 ER), 55 walks, 280 strikeouts and 19 quality starts...Twins are 23-19 in Ryan's 42 home starts.

- ◆Leads all Twins starters in strikeouts at home with 64.
- ₱ Twins are 4-6 this season at home when Ryan starts.
- ₱Since making his debut in 2021, he leads Twins pitchers with 18 home wins...has four home wins this season, only trailing Bailey Ober with five.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .201/.237/.367 with eight home runs, nine walks and 58 strikeouts in 241 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .240/.278/.436 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 80 strikeouts in 266 plate appearances.

- ₱ Over his career, lefties are batting .206 (171-for-831) with 32 doubles, six triples, 28 home runs and a .627 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .242 (221-for-915) with 55 doubles, three
- triples, 45 home runs and a .740 OPS.

 ◆ This season lefties have a 25.0 percent whiff rate and 88.5 mph average exit velocity vs. Ryan, while righties have a 28.0 percent whiff rate and 88.2 mph average exit velocity.

 ◆ In his last start against Detroit, left-handed hitters went 1-for-8 with no walks and one strikeout... right-handed hitters went 2-for-13 with one walk and seven strikeouts.
- ♣ In two games vs. Ryan this season, Chicago-AL left-handed hitters have hit .278 (5-for-18) with one double, one walk and two strikeouts...right-handed hitters have hit .192 (5-for-26)

 with one double, two home runs, one walk and nine strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 21 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and sinker the most, combining to throw the two pitches 75.3 percent of the time in his last start against Detroit...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ₱ In two starts vs. Chicago-AL this season, hitters have gone 2-for-13 with five strikeouts against Ryan's 4-seam fastball.
- ◆ At Detroit, his sweeper induced five whiffs on eight swings (62.5%)
