- Making 24th start of season and 81st of career. Last pitched on August 15 at Texas, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on seven hits, three walks and three strikeouts...it was his first career outing at Globe Life Field. Ranks second among qualified pitchers since June 16 with a 1.87 ERA (67.1 IP, 14 ER).

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on August 15 at Texas...did not factor into the decision despite producing a career-best 10th-consecutive quality start...allowed two runs on seven hits, three walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings...it was his first career outing at Globe Life Field.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 9 vs. Cleveland...earned the win...allowed just four base runners through six innings...allowed no runs on two hits, two walks with nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings...tied his career high with a fourth-straight win...has now recorded nine-straight quality starts dating back to June 16 vs. Oakland...106 pitches set a new career high; previous high was 104, done twice.

LAST TEN STARTS: In his last 10 starts since June 16, Ober has gone 7-1, 1.87 ERA (67.1 IP, 14 ER), 16 walks, 75 strikeouts, a 0.82 WHIP and a .166 (39-for-235) opponent batting average. He is tied with Baltimore's Corbin Burnes (10 G, 4/26-6/16) for the longest quality start streak in baseball this season. Since June 16, ranks second among qualified pitchers in ERA and opponent batting average, trailing only Hunter Greene (1.77 ERA, .156 BAA).

VS. SAN DIEGO: Making his first start this season and second of his career vs. San Diego Started vs. San Diego on May 11, 2023 and took a no-decision, allowing three runs on six hits (2 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings; Twins won, 5-3. Making his fourth Interleague start of the season, in his previous three he is 1-0, 3.78 ERA (16.2 IP, 7 ER), five walks, 16 strikeouts, a 1.14 WHIP and a .237 (14-for-59) opponent batting average...in his career he is 4-1, 3.58 ERA (75.1 IP, 30 ER), 22 walks, 67 strikeouts a 1.10 WHIP and a .221 (61-for-276) opponent batting average in 14 starts. Making his first career start at Petco Park.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Making his 14th road start of the season today...in the previous 13, he's gone 5-4 with a 4.04 ERA (75.2 IP, 34 ER), 20 walks, 75 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .212 (58-for-274) opponent batting average...in 10 home starts, he is 7-1, 2.78 ERA (58.1 IP, 18 ER), 14 walks, 65 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .197 (42-for-213) opponent batting average. Has gone 11-12 with a 3.80 ERA (220.0 IP, 93 ER) in 41 career road starts compared to 14-5 with a 3.35 ERA (206.2 IP, 77 ER) in 39 career home starts. The Twins are 7-6 in Ober's 13 road starts this season. Making back-to-back road starts; last start was on August 15 at Texas. Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is third on the Twins in road wins with 11, trailing only Pablo López (13) and Joe Ryan (14).

REVERSE SPLITS: On August 15, Texas left-handed hitters went 1-for-13 with two strikeouts against Ober...right-handed hitters went 6-for-11 with one strikeout. Lefties have a 27.2 percent whiff rate and 86.2 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 29.9 percent whiff rate and 88.8 mph average exit velocity. Through 23 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .178 (40-for-225) with a .568 OPS and 25.9 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .229 (60-for-262) with a .695 OPS and 26.9 percent strikeout rate. Over his career, lefties are batting .229 (171-for-746) with 38 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs and a .665 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .229 (194-for-847) with 33 doubles, seven triples, 41 home runs and a .698 OPS. On May 11, 2023 vs. Ober, Padres left-handed hitters went 3-for-11 with one home run, two doubles and four strikeouts...right-handed hitters went 3-for-13 with a home run, a double and two strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...here's his pitch usage through 23 starts: PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. In his last two starts, hitters have hit .052 (1-for-19) with eight strikeouts against Ober's changeup.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 4-3, 3.77 ERA // CAREER: 4-4, 4.00 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the series and road trip finale at San Diego tomorrow afternoon...last pitched on August 16 at Texas, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), two walks and one strikeout in 5.0 innings; earned his fourth win of the season in Minnesota's 4-3 victory...is facing the San Diego Padres for the first time in his career...making his 12th start this season on the road, in his previous 11 he is 3-2, 4.27 ERA (52.2 IP, 25 ER), 15 walks, 38 strikeouts a 1.31 WHIP and .265 (54-for-204) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3. In 2021, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts. In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota. Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022. Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota. In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season. Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020. Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola. Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961. Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K). In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season. Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston. Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
