AN URGENT AND HORRIFYING NEWS STORY: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Petco Park by a score of 5-3...Zebby Matthews (1-1) was the starter and was issued his first career loss, allowing five runs (2 earned) on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and one strikeout...Trevor Richards pitched 2.0 perfect innings of relief and Caleb Thielbar pitched 1.0 perfect inning...the offense recorded five hits, including two from Christian Vázquez, who drove in his 25th run of the season...Matt Wallner had the Twins' only extra-base hit of the night, doubling in the first run of the game in the first inning.
