THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-3 through six games on their current seven-game roadtrip,
going 3-1 at Texas against the Rangers over the weekend, followed by consecutive losses in
San Diegotoday, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against
the Padres at Petco Parkafter today's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day
tomorrow, then begin a nine-game, 10-day homestand with three against the Cardinals this
weekend, three against the Braves from Monday-Wednesday, an off day on Thursday, then
three against the Blue Jays (August 29-September 1). The Twins are 63-43 in their last 106 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since

that date, in front of Los Angeles-NL (62-41).

TABLES TURNED ON LATE INNINGS FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Petco Park, dropping their third consecutive game...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Steven Okert (3-2) was issued the loss in relief, allowing four runs in the eighth inning, highlighted by a Jurickson Profar three-run homer...the offense recorded 13 hits and was led by Ryan Jeffers who had two hits, one being his 20th home run of the season...he joined four other catchers in Twins history (since 1961) to reach the 20-home run mark, the others being Mitch Garver (31 in 2019), Joe Mauer (28 in 2009) and Earl Battey (26 in 1963).

TWINS AND PADRES: The Twins are playing the Padres for the 29th time in their history this afternoon...Minnesota is 18-10 all-time against the Padres...the Twins are 7-5 all-time at Petco Park, 8-2 at Target Field, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium and 1-2 at Metrodome.

◆ The Twins are looking to avoid losing three straight to the Padres for the first time ever.

◆ Twins are 15-7 against the Padres in their last 22 games, dating back to June of 2008.

◆ Carlos Santana is hitting .307 (27-for-88) with a 1.033 OPS in 25 career games vs. San Diego...he has hit three home runs in 10 career games at Petco.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 14-19 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago and 0-2 vs San Diego...by comparison, the Twins have gone 56-37 against American League opponents.

MAX PRODUCTION: In his last 37 games, dating back to July 4, Max Kepler is hitting .299 (40-for-134) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, 15 runs scored, a .340 on-base percentage, a .403 slugging percentage and a .743 OPS.

FASHIONABLY LATE: The Twins have scored nine runs in the seventh inning-or-later through the six games on this trip (25 total runs on trip)...they have scored 232 runs in the seventh inning-or-later on the season, the most in MLB, ahead of second-place Arizona (219)... Minnesota has scored 83 runs in the seventh (3rd in MLB), 65 in the eighth (11th in MLB), 61 in the ninth (T-2nd in MLB) and 21 in extras (T-7th in MLB).

ALL HE DOES IS CELEBRATE: Christian Vázquez is celebrating his 34th birthday today... Vaksy has appeared in five games on his birthday (2014, '17, '19, '20 and '21), going 6-for-16 (.375) with one double and one walk...the last game he played on his birthday was in 2021, going 1-for-3 against Texas (playing for Boston)...earlier this trip, he celebrated 10 years of major league service in Arlington while the Twins were playing the Rangers...his wife had a Puerto Rican band play music in the clubhouse pregame for the entire team.

LET'S NOT DO THAT: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the seventh time in 2024...their previous six sweeps were April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games - PPD/weather-short-ened series), April 15-17 at Baltimore (3 games), May 14-16 vs. New York-AL (3 games), May 17-19 vs. Cleveland (3 games), June 4-6 at New York-AL (3 games) and July 20-21 vs. Milwaukee (2 games).

◆ Twins have faced being swept 10 times this season...they have gone 4-6 in those games... the four times they salvaged the finale came on April 3 at Milwaukee, April 10 vs. Los Angeles-NL, June 9 at Pittsburgh and July 31 at New York-NL.

◆ Twins are looking to avoid being swept by the Padres for the first time in their history.

ROTATIONAL PULL: In 30 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 11-7, 3.17 ERA (162.0 IP, 57 ER) with 20 home runs allowed, 42 walks and 151 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .214 batting average...in that span, they rank second in baseball in ERA, third in WHIP (1.07) and fourth in opponent batting average.

SKYROCKETS IN FLIGHT: The Twins have homered in nine of their last 10 games since August 11, hitting 15 total in that span...in fact, since that date, they have also recorded 14 doubles and three triples, while posting a .446 slugging percentage, fifth-best in baseball since that date...also, since that date, they have an average exit velocity of 90.2 mph, ranking third in baseball, and a 40.2 hard hit %, 11th-best.

AFTERNOON DELIGHT: The Twins have played 57 day games this season, the fifth most in baseball...they have gone 35-22 during the day, the most day wins in baseball...they have scored 5.16 runs-per-game during the day, the second-highest mark in baseball...pitchers' .228 opponent batting average in day games ranks second in baseball.

WHAMMY!: Despite going 1-for-his-last-14 (.071) in his last seven games, Matt Wallner is hitting .307 (27-for-88) with 10 doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI, a .425 on-base percentage, a .648 slugging percentage and a 1.072 OPS in hist last 31 games since being recalled on July 7.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Twins today announced details for their presence at the 2024 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (Thursday, August 22 through Monday, September 2).
