THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (3-1 at Texas and 1-2 at San Diego), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a split of the first two games against the Cardinals on Friday and Saturday...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against St. Louis...starting tomorrow night, Minnesota will host the Braves for three games from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off day on Thursday, then play three against the Blue Jays next weekend.

⚡ The Twins have gone 37-25 at home this season, the fifth-most home wins in the AL and tied for ninth-most in baseball...they have gone 20-11 at home since June 12 and 9-4 since July 14; in those 13 games, they have outscored opponents 77-43.

⚡ The Twins are 65-44 in their last 109 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...that's a 96-win pace over a 162 games.

⚡ The Twins have gone 12-4 in rubber games this season, including a record of 8-2 in their last 10 chances.

LÓPEZ AND LARNACH LEAD THE WAY: The Twins shut out the Cardinals last night at Target Field by a score of 6-0, evening the series at 1-1...Pablo López (12-8) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...12 wins for Pablo set a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 11, done last season...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Trevor Larnach as he hit his 13th and 14th homers of the season — his first career multi-homer game...Matt Wallner also had three hits, including his ninth home run of the season.

TWINS AND CARDS: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 39th time in their history today...Twins are 20-18 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 12-6 in their last 18...in the regular season, the Twins are 6-2 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 8-7 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 16-20 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego and 1-1 vs. St. Louis...they are just 6-10 against NL opponents since July 14...by comparison, the Twins have gone 56-37 against American League opponents.

⚡ The Twins went 25-21 in Interleague Play in 2023.

RISPY BUSINESS: Twins batters are hitting .377 (20-for-53) with a 1.127 OPS in their last eight games with runners in scoring position...through 22 games this month, they are hitting .291 (46-for-158) with RISP, their highest of any month after hitting .212 (56-for-264) in March/April, .243 (54-for-222) in May, .261 (64-for-245) in June and .231 (50-for-216) in July...additionally, their 2021 RISP average in August ranks third in baseball, trailing only Kansas City (.326) and Detroit (.293).

MASK OFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.186 OPS in his last nine games...Christian Vázquez is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and a .965 OPS in his last 18 games.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win today and the Twins will secure their 25th series win of the season...they enter today 24-13-3 in series play this season, going 12-6-1 at home and 12-7-2 on the road...after starting their season 1-4-2 in their first seven series, the Twins have gone 23-9-1 since April 22.

⚡ Minnesota's last series win over the Cards came last season, taking two of three from August 1-3 at Busch Stadium...the Twins last series win over St. Louis in Minnesota came July 28-29, 2020, sweeping in two.

STRONGMAN COMPETITION: Trevor Larnach had his first career four-hit game on Sunday afternoon in San Diego and followed up with his first two-homer game last night...in his last three games overall, he is hitting .538 (7-for-13) with four extra-base hits...Matt Wallner set a season-high with three hits last night, including a home run...in his last three games overall, he is hitting .364 (4-for-11) with three extra-base hits...they both rank one and two on the club in average exit velocity this season, Wallner first at 94.1 mph, followed by Larnach at 92.4 mph.

ST. PAULI BOYS: First baseman/outfielder Alex Kirilloff was pulled off his rehab assignment at Triple-A St. Paul after having a flare-up in his back...Kirilloff has been on the IL since June 12 with a mild back strain...Brooks Lee played in his first game on rehab assignment last night for St. Paul, going 1-for-4 with a two-run homer as the designated hitter...Lee has been on the IL since August 9 with right biceps tendinitis.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder DaShawn Keirse Jr. and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Travis Adams have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

⚡ Keirse Jr., 27, played in five games for the Saints, hitting .474 (9-for-19) with two triples, two home runs, eight RBI and a 1.500 OPS, including a four-hit game on Thursday vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...on Tuesday, DaShawn became the fifth player in Saints history to reach 100 hits in a season...the San Diego, CA native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Utah.

⚡ Adams, 24, made the starter on Thursday at Midland, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts...the Palm Springs, CA native was selected by the Twins in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of California State University, Sacramento.

⚡ Griffin Jax and Matt Wallner will visit the Experience tomorrow from noon-1:00 pm.

⚡ National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva will be at the Experience tomorrow from 10:15 to 11:00 am.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched August 19 at San Diego, opposite Michael King, and took the loss in Minnesota's 5-3 defeat...allowed five runs (2 ER) on four hits in 5.0 innings, with two walks and one strikeout...allowed two runs on a hit-by-pitch and two singles in the first...allowed three unearned runs on Jackson Merrill's third-inning double (after an EI, dropping a catch at first base).  
 ☞ Induced six whiffs on 42 swings (14.3%)...has a 15.8 percent whiff rate through two starts.  
 ☞ Allowed five hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...has a 41.2 percent hard-hit rate through two starts.  
 ☞ Sixth professional game with two walks (second of 2024) and first professional game with more walks than strikeouts.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Made MLB debut August 13 vs. Kansas City, opposite Seth Lugo, and earned the win in Minnesota's 13-3 victory...allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with no walks and five strikeouts...recorded first MLB strikeout in first inning vs. Bobby Witt Jr....allowed second-inning solo home run to MJ Melendez and fifth-inning RBI double to Michael Massey.  
 ☞ Induced six whiffs on 33 swings (18.2%) and allowed nine hard-hit balls.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through two games vs. Matthews, left-handed hitters have hit .250 (6-for-24) with two doubles, a home run, a walk and two strikeouts, while righties have hit .188 (3-for-16) with a double, a walk and four strikeouts.  
 ☞ In minors vs. Matthews this season, left-handed hitters have hit .211 (36-for-171) with a .298 slugging percentage, .536 OPS, 23.5 percent strikeout rate, 2.8 percent walk rate and 1.8 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .214 (41-for-192) with a .328 SLG, .554 OPS, 36.9 percent strikeout rate, 1.0 percent walk rate and 2.1 percent home run rate.

- Has been named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week three times in 2024: April 14, April 28 and May 12.
- Made Triple-A debut at Toledo on July 21, 2024 and earned the win in St. Paul's 10-3 victory, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings, with no walks and six strikeouts.
- On June 9, 2024 at Northwest Arkansas, threw 7.0 scoreless innings with three hits, no walks and eight strikeouts for Wichita.
- Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in nine-straight starts (4 with Cedar Rapids, 5 with Wichita) to begin the 2024 season...went 4-1 with a 1.38 ERA (52.1 IP, 8 ER) in that span.
