THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, dropping a three-game series 2-1 against the Cardinals over the weekend, winning just game two...this evening, the Twins will host the Braves for three games through Wednesday night...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play three against the Blue Jays over the weekend. **☞** The Twins are 65-45 in their last 10 games since April 22, tied with Los Angeles-NL (65-42) for the most wins in baseball since that date...that's a 95-win pace over 162 games.

RARE, LATE LOSS FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Cardinals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2, suffering their first loss of the season when leading after eight innings (59-1)...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (6-7) was issued the loss, allowing two unearned runs in the ninth inning...an Edouard Julien throwing error extended the inning, allowing the Cards to score two later in the inning...the offense recorded six hits, two from Julien...Willi Castro hit his 11th home run of the season and second career leadoff homer.

THE BAILEY SHOW: Since allowing eight runs on nine hits in 1.1 innings pitched in his first start on March 31 at Kansas City, Bailey Ober has gone 12-4, 3.05 ERA (138.2 IP, 47 ER) with 33 walks, 144 strikeouts, a 0.92 WHIP and a .192 opponent batting average in 23 starts since April 8...below are his AL rankings since that date (minimum of 130.0 innings pitched):

QUALITY OBER QUANTITY: Ober enters tonight with an 11-game quality start streak, the longest active run in baseball and longest since Shane Bieber's 11-game streak from July 29-September 22, 2022...the last pitcher with at least 12 was Framber Valdez, with 25, from April 25-September 18, 2022...below are the longest streaks in Twins history (since 1961):

ELEVATORS, ME AND YOU: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times in their history this week...the Twins are 8-14 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-8 in Minnesota and 2-6 in Georgia (4-2 at the Metrodome, 2-6 at Target Field, 2-3 at Turner Field and 0-3 at Truist Park).

☞ The Twins are just 3-12 in their last 15 against Atlanta, dating back to June of 2010...in that span, they have one win in Minnesota, that coming on August 5, 2019, when Miguel Sanó hit a pinch-hit, 443-foot, two-run, walk-off home run to centerfield against Chris Martin, giving the Twins a 5-3 victory.

☞ These two last met for three games at Truist Park from June 26-28, 2023, as the Twins were swept in three games and outscored 3-13.

☞ Minnesota last hosted Atlanta for three games from August 5-7, 2019, as the Twins won just the first of the three games.

INTERLEAGUE, NOT IDEAL: The Twins are 16-21 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego and 1-2 vs. St. Louis...they are just 6-12 against NL opponents since July 14...by comparison, the Twins have gone 56-37 against American League opponents.

☞ The Twins went 25-21 in Interleague Play in 2023.

LEFT SIDE STORY: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter tonight for the 38th time this season, going 21-16 when facing a left-handed starter.

☞ Minnesota enters today with a .264 batting average vs. left-handed pitching, the best in the AL and third-best mark in baseball, trailing Arizona (.279) and Philadelphia (.275)... additionally, they have posted a .440 slugging percentage off lefties, the fourth-best in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (.448), Baltimore (.443) and New York-NL (.442).

☞ In his last 31 games against lefties, Carlos Santana is slashing .344/.417/.703 (1.120 OPS).

☞ Royce Lewis is slashing .310/.391/.586 (.978 OPS) against left-handed pitching this season.

LEE LEE LEE LEE LEE LEE LEE LEE LEE, WE'RE TALKIN' LEE: Brooks Lee played in his second game on rehab assignment yesterday for St. Paul, going 3-for-4 with two doubles...he has now gone 4-for-8 with three extra-base hits and three RBI through two games with St. Paul...Lee has been on the IL since August 9 with right biceps tendinitis.

BEER AND TACOS: Three Twins minor leaguers were named Player or Pitcher of the Week in their respective leagues today.

- ☞** Triple-A St. Paul Outfielder DaShawn Keirsej Jr. was named International League Player of the Week...Keirsej hit a league-best .500 (9-for-18) with two triples, two home runs, eight RBI...he ranked second in both OPS (1.601) and slugging (1.056), and third in on-base (.545).
- ☞** Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Travis Adams was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week...he made the starter on Thursday at Midland, pitching 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts.
- ☞** Low-A Fort Myers Samuel Perez was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week...he made two relief appearances, pitching 5.2 scoreless innings with no hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts.

DEEP FRIED TWINS: The Twins are at the 2024 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (through Monday, September 2).

☞ Griffin Jax, Matt Wallner and National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva were at the Experience earlier today.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on August 20 at San Diego...did not factor into the decision despite tossing a career-best 11th-consecutive quality start...allowed an RBI single to David Peralta in the second inning, would go on to toss four scoreless innings before allowing a two-run home run to Manny Machado in the seventh inning...allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR), no walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

- ☞ Recorded his 15th quality start of the season, tops on the Twins.
- ☞ Has recorded a quality start in each of his last 11 starts, the longest such streak of his career... previously had seven-straight quality starts from June 14-July 23, 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 15 at Texas...did not factor into the decision despite producing a career-best 10th consecutive quality start...allowed two runs on seven hits, three walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings...it was his first career outing at Globe Life Field.

LAST ELEVEN STARTS: In his last 11 starts since June 16, Ober has gone 7-1, 2.09 ERA (73.1 IP, 17 ER), 16 walks, 80 strikeouts, a 0.80 WHIP and a .167 (43-for-257) opponent batting average.

- ☞ All 11 starts have been quality starts, setting a new career-best streak.
- ☞ Surpassed Baltimore's Corbin Burnes (10 G, 4/26-6/16) for the longest quality start streak in baseball this season with 11.
- ☞ Since June 16, ranks second among qualified pitchers in ERA and first in opponent batting average (2.09 ERA, .167 BAA).

VS. ATLANTA: Making his first career start vs. the Atlanta Braves.

- ☞ Making his fifth Interleague start of the season, in his previous four he is 1-0, 3.97 ERA (22.2 IP, 10 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts, a 1.01 WHIP and a .222 (18-for-81) opponent batting average...in his career he is 4-1, 3.65 ERA (81.1 IP, 33 ER), 22 walks, 72 strikeouts a 1.07 WHIP and a .218 (65-for-298) opponent batting average in 15 starts.
- ☞ Making back-to-back consecutive starts against National League opponents.
- ☞ Facing his third National League East team: Washington and Philadelphia.

BACK AT HOME: Making his 11th home start of the season today...in the previous 10, he's gone 7-1 with a 2.78 ERA (58.1 IP, 18 ER), 14 walks, 65 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .197 (42-for-213) opponent batting average...in 14 road starts, he is 5-4, 4.08 ERA (81.2 IP, 37 ER), 20 walks, 80 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .209 (62-for-296) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Has gone 14-5 with a 3.35 ERA (206.2 IP, 77 ER) in 39 career home starts compared to 11-12 with a 3.82 ERA (226.2 IP, 96 ER) in 42 career home starts.
- ☞ The Twins are 7-7 in Ober's 14 home starts this season.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second on the Twins in home wins with 14, trailing only Joe Ryan (19).

REVERSE SPLITS: On August 20, San Diego left-handed hitters went 3-for-15 with two doubles and four strikeouts against Ober...right-handed hitters went 1-for-7 with one home run and one strikeout.

- ☞ Lefties have a 27.0 percent whiff rate and 86.0 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 30.0 percent whiff rate and 89.1 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ Through 24 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .179 (43-for-240) with a .566 OPS and 27.9 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .227 (61-for-269) with a .696 OPS and 28.9 percent strikeout rate.
- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .229 (174-for-761) with 40 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs and a .663 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .228 (195-for-854) with 33 doubles, seven triples, 42 home runs and a .698 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...here's his pitch usage through 23 starts:

☞ In his last three starts, hitters have hit .052 (1-for-26) with 13 strikeouts against Ober's changeup.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 5-3, 3.69 ERA // CAREER: 5-4, 3.91 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the second of a three game series...last pitched on August 21 at San Diego, allowing one run on four hits (1 HR), two walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings; earned his fifth win of the season in Minnesota's 11-4 victory...is facing the Atlanta Braves for the first time in his career...making his 11th start this season at home, in his previous nine he is 1-1, 3.29 ERA (54.2 IP, 20 ER), 18 walks, 54 strikeouts a 1.04 WHIP and .197 (39-for-198) opponent batting average.
